FIRST AND TEN

Week 5 of the American Southwest Conference football season is here. Only three teams remain without a conference loss: Mary Hardin-Baylor, Hardin-Simmons and East Texas Baptist. Two of those squads -- UMHB and HSU, who are both nationally-ranked -- square off this week in a game that has produced an ASC champion every year since 1998. The Cru and Cowboys kick off at 2 p.m. on Saturday at Tiger Field in Belton, Texas. ETBU, which has won two straight since dropping its opener on the road to nationally-ranked St. John's, will host McMurry in Marshall, Texas. Louisiana College travels to Mississippi College for another installment in a series that has produced one-possession outcomes the last two times out. Texas Lutheran and Howard Payne will duke it out in Brownwood, Texas, for that first conference win of the season.

ASC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Games of Sept. 27

-OFFENSIVE-

Desmond Mays, RB, Jr., Mississippi College

Mississippi College junior running back **Desmond Mays** (*Normangee, TX / NHS*) rushed for 189 yards – the most in the ASC this season – on 30 carries and scored four touchdowns in a loss to Hardin-Simmons. He also caught three passes for 21 yards to account for 210 yards of offense, which is the second-highest total in the league this year. Mays’ four scores tie him for the league high.

-DEFENSIVE-

Johnnie Williams, CB, Jr., Sul Ross State

Sul Ross State junior cornerback **Johnnie Williams** (*Hempstead, TX / HHS*) made seven tackles – six solo, two for loss – and had an interception that set up a Lobo’s touchdown in a 17-0 win over Howard Payne. Williams also had a pass break-up in SRSU’s first shutout since the 1997 season.

-SPECIAL TEAMS-

Alan Munoz, PK, So., Mary Hardin-Baylor

Mary Hardin-Baylor sophomore kicker **Alan Munoz** (*Red Oak, TX / Ferris HS*) nailed a 48-yard field goal – the longest in the ASC this season – and notched five extra-points in the Cru’s 46-0 road win over McMurry. He also averaged 57.9 yards on kickoffs.

OFFENSE: East Texas Baptist RBs **Corey George** and **Jair Stover** combined to rush for 247 yards and three TDs in a win over Texas Lutheran. . . . Hardin-Simmons QB **Justin Feaster** was 29-for-43 for 363 yards and three TDs in a win over Mississippi College. . . . Mary Hardin-Baylor QB **Josh Saenz** threw for 210 yards and three TDs and ran for another score in a win over McMurry. . . . Sul Ross State RB **Jermaine Swearington** ran for 157 yards on 24 carries in a win against Howard Payne. . . . Texas Lutheran WR **Kash Greathouse** caught seven passes for 84 yards in a loss to East Texas Baptist.

DEFENSE: Hardin-Simmons S **Matt Warnasch** made a career-high 15 tackles in a win over MC. . . . Mary Hardin-Baylor DB **Bryson Tucker** made six tackles to lead a unit that allowed just 27 yards of total offense. . . . Texas Lutheran LB **Jarrad McAdams** made 13 tackles, forced a fumble and blocked a field goal in a loss to ETBU. . . . McMurry DB **Cody Collins** registered 15 tackles and had a pass break-up in a loss to UMHB.

What to Know: Winner of this game has gone on to win at least a share of every ASC championship since the 1998 season. . . . Only one season has Hardin-Simmons or Mary Hardin-Baylor not been a part of the ASC title (1997, Mississippi College). . . . UMHB has won five straight in the series and six of the last seven. . . . UMHB has won 23 straight ASC games. HSU holds the all-time record for consecutive wins in conference games with 34. . . . HSU has won seven straight games, it's longest run since claiming 12 from 2003-2004. . . . HSU's Jimmie Keeling (19 years) and UMHB's Pete Fredenburg (11 years) are the longest-tenured head coaches in the ASC. . . . UMHB leads the league in rushing offense (260.3 ypg), while HSU leads in passing offense (292.5 ypg). . . . HSU has not allowed an opponent to convert on fourth down, while UMHB has converted all of its tries. . . . UMHB leads the league in kickoff and punt return average. . . . HSU QB Justin Feaster has thrown nine TDs opposed to just one INT. . . . HSU WR Mychal Carrillo leads the ASC in receiving (106 ypg, nine catches pg). . . . UMHB RB Matt Hurst leads the conference in scoring at 12 points per game. . . . HSU S Matt Warnasch leads the ASC in tackles (10.8 pg). . . . UMHB LBs Ben Beckworth (five tackles for loss) and Bryson Tucker (6.3 tackles pg) lead a unit that hasn't allowed more than one TD in three games. . . . UMHB is 12-for-12 scoring in the red zone.

Last Meeting: UMHB 47, HSU 14 (10/06/07, in Abilene, TX)

– *Mary Hardin-Baylor used a smothering defensive effort and a dominating offensive performance to roll over 21st-ranked Hardin-Simmons 47-14. The Cru, ranked 2nd in the nation, took a 7-0 lead when Jarvis Thrasher went 37 yards on the first offensive play. Joel Munoz added a 28-yard field goal to make it 10-0 and Josh Welch hit Patrick Oliver with a 16-yard scoring pass at the 12:02 mark of the second quarter. Justin Feaster found a wide-open Justice Baker for a 52-yard TD pass for HSU to cut the lead to 17-7, but UMHB answered with a 13-play, 91-yard drive capped by Thrasher's one-yard run to push the lead to 24-7. UMHB held the Cowboys to just 223 yards of offense, with 201 of those coming in the first half. Daniels ran for 142 yards and two TDs on 25 carries and Thrasher added 113 yards and three scores on 19 lates. Oliver caught a career-high six passes for 137 yards and a TD. Feaster finished 17-29 passing for 188 yards and he had two passes picked off. The Cowboys ran for just 35 yards.*

All-Time Series: Howard Payne leads, 19-13-1

Last Meeting: TLU 55, HPU 48 (10/06/07, in Seguin, TX)

– *Texas Lutheran gave Dennis Parker his first win as TLU's head coach and thrilled a homecoming crowd with a wild 55-48 victory over Howard Payne. Back-up QB Bryant Villa hit senior wide receiver Jerry Clouse for a 27-yard TD with 20 seconds to play in the game. The scoring drive, which covered five plays and 71 yards in 1:15, was kept alive by a roughing the kicker penalty at the TLU 33. Villa took advantage of the roughing the kicker penalty to hit Steven Trash for 27 yards and then connect with Clouse for the game-winner.*

MCMURRY

McMurry was blanked in its home-opener last Saturday against No. 3 Mary Hardin-Baylor as the Crusaders rolled past McMurry 46-0 at Wilford Moore Stadium. The loss pushes McMurry to 0-4 on the year. McMurry will vie for its first win of the season Saturday against East Texas Baptist in Marshall.

EAST TEXAS BAPTIST

ETBU's defense has not allowed a 100-yard rushing day by an opponent this season, limiting TLU to 86 yards and a 2.9 yards-per-rush average. Quarterback Stephen Oehlschlaeger completed passes to seven different receivers in Saturday's win at Texas Lutheran.

MARY HARDIN-BAYLOR

The Cru held McMurry scoreless and to just two yards rushing and 27 yards of total offense. The 27 yards of offense is the lowest mark allowed in school history and McMurry only completed two passes to match the lowest opponent total in school history. Pi'Dadro Davis posted his second straight 100-yard receiving day with 106 yards and two touchdowns on his two grabs.

TEXAS LUTHERAN

The Bulldogs dropped to 0-2 in the ASC with a 26-14 home loss to ETBU. The Bulldogs allowed 277 yards and four touchdowns on the ground. Anthony Smith rushed for a net 57 yards and 45 of those yards came on one play - a TD run in the first quarter. Kash Greathouse caught seven passes for 84 yards. TLU QB Joel Waldon was sacked five times by ETBU. The Bulldogs punted seven times against the Tigers. Jarrad McAdams, TLU's sophomore LB, had a game-high 13 tackles in the loss. He also forced a fumble and blocked a field goal attempt.

HARDIN-SIMMONS

HSU went over 500 yards for the second straight game. Justin Feaster has thrown for over 350 yards in back-to-back games. Derrick Grant became the second HSU runner to go over 100 yards this season. He had 129 yards on 13 carries and scored his first two TDs of the season. HSU had three players in double figures in tackles. Matt Warnasch had 15, Ricky Poe 14 and Michael Tracy had 12. Mychal Carrillo has at least nine catches in nine straight games. He had 10 catches for 130 yards and a touchdown.

SUL ROSS STATE

Monte Morales saddled 13 of 25 pass completions for 133 yards and helped lead Sul Ross to a 17-0 ASC shut out over visiting Howard Payne. Morales also punched in a score off the run while Jermaine Swearington continued his impressive freshman career netting 157 yards off of 24 carries including a game-long 53-yard rush. Eddie Tovar posted 4 receptions for 18 yards while Dominique Carson holstered a pair of catches for 68.

LOUISIANA COLLEGE

The Wildcats, for the first time since reviving the football program in 2000, are among others receiving votes in a major national poll. LC received one vote in the current AFCA national NCAA III Poll. LC cornerback Kendale Rayford remains one interception shy of tying the school record for interceptions in a career (12). DE/LB Stephen Jackson collected 17 tackles against Hardin-Simmons in LC's last game, earning him a spot on D3football.com's National Team of the Week. The LC defense already has six sacks this season, while they only totaled 17 all of last season. QB Derek Lewis had personal game highs in yards (325) and TDs (4).

HOWARD PAYNE

The Howard Payne football team despite being 1-2 so far on the season, rank second in the ASC in Scoring Defense only allowing 14.3 points per game and third in Total Defense allowing 268 total yards per game. Linebacker Kevin Reyna is in the top 10 in the ASC in Tackles averaging 8.0 tackles per game. Dustin McClure is fourth in the ASC in Sacks with 2.5 on the season.

MISSISSIPPI COLLEGE

Mississippi College freshman quarterback Tommy Reyer started his second career game Saturday and passed for 159 yards while also adding 80 rushing yards on the ground. Reyer completed 13-22 passes for 159 and one touchdown, and also rushed 16 times for the 80 yards. The Choctaw offensive line has emerged the last few weeks to lead an MC offense switching to a ground attack. MC rushed for 296 yards on 53 carries against Hardin-Simmons last week. The line returns the top seven players from a year ago. The line also has surrendered an ASC low three sacks this year. Despite the loss of record-setting QB Adam Shaffer, the Choctaw offense still ranks 3rd in the ASC in total offense averaging 398.5 yards per game.

The Cru took the opening kickoff and marched 62 yards in six plays, capped by a 24-yard TD pass from Josh Saenz to Pi'Dadro Davis. UMHB picked up a safety on a bad snap and Alan Munoz nailed a 48-yard field goal as time ran out to make it a 39-0 UMHB lead at halftime. The Cru held McMurry to -35 yards of total offense in the first half and -60 yards rushing in the first half. The shutout is the 11th in the 11-year history of UMHB football. Saenz finished 10-18 passing for 214 yards and three scores. UMHB rolled up 375 yards of total offense with 236 of those coming through the air.
