FIRST AND TEN

It's Week 7 of the American Southwest Conference football season, and that means just four weeks to go in the regular season. Nationally-ranked Mary Hardin-Baylor gained sole possession of first place last week and is the only league team remaining without an ASC loss. The Cru has now won 25 straight conference games. Hardin-Simmons, which is also ranked nationally, has just one league loss along with East Texas Baptist and Mississippi College. UMHB, HSU, ETBU and MC are all unbeaten at home. For the fourth straight week, the ASC slate only contains conference games. Texas Lutheran is the only team on a bye.

-CO-OFFENSIVE-

Justin Feaster, QB, Sr., Hardin-Simmons

Hardin-Simmons senior quarterback **Justin Feaster** (*Glen Rose, TX / GRHS*) threw four touchdowns and ran for another score to lead the nationally-ranked Cowboys in a 40-12 win over East Texas Baptist. Feaster, who takes the league's top offensive award for the second time this season, was 23 of 33 passing for 300 yards. He also became the first player in the ASC this season to account for five TDs in a game.

Tre Mason, WR, Fr., Howard Payne

Howard Payne freshman wide receiver **Tre Mason** (*League City, TX / Clear Creek HS*) had seven catches for 152 yards and three touchdowns to fuel a 45-33 road win over McMurry. Mason also became the first player in the ASC this season to make three TD grabs in a game.

-DEFENSIVE-

Demetrius Cody, LB, Fr., Howard Payne

Howard Payne freshman linebacker **Demetrius Cody** (*Killeen, TX / Early County HS*) had eight tackles, an interception, 1.5 sacks, a forced fumble, a fumble recovery and two pass break-ups to guide a 45-33 road win over McMurry. Cody made 3.5 tackles that went for a loss of 21 yards.

-SPECIAL TEAMS-

Robert Wilson, DL, So., Louisiana College

Louisiana College sophomore **Robert Wilson** (*Shreveport, LA / Southwood HS*) blocked two field goals in a loss to nationally-ranked Mary Hardin-Baylor – one of which set up the Wildcats' only touchdown. Wilson also made four tackles as a defensive lineman.

Texas Lutheran QB **Joel Walson** threw for 255 yards and passed and ran for a TD. . . . Louisiana College QB **Derek Lewis** completed 36 of 51 passes for 295 yards and a TD in a loss to UMHB.

LOUISIANA COLLEGE

The Wildcats have dropped their last three games...LC last beat ETBU in 2005, scoring 20 fourth quarter points to post a 34-30, come-from-behind win... Derek Lewis ranks second among ASC quarterbacks in passing yards per game (237.3 ypg)...Receivers Joardan Rideaux and Jordan Taylor Huffman rank second and third respectively in the ASC in receptions per game...After getting three interceptions in the first two games, cornerback Kendale Rayford is still one pick shy of tying the school career record of 12...The Wildcats continue to lead the ASC in interceptions with 10...LC ranks last in the ASC in rushing average per game (73.0), but second in passing yards per game (243.2)...The Wildcats lead the ASC in penalty yardage per game (99.2), but opponents of the Wildcats lead the ASC as a group in penalty yardage (94.0).

MARY HARDIN-BAYLOR

The Cru has now won 25 straight ASC games. Josh Saenz threw for 137 yards and two touchdowns in the win over LC. He also ran for 28 yards. Ervin Johnson had his first career TD and so did Roger Sanchez. The Cru failed to score on its first drive of the game for the first time this season. Nathan Meyer became the fifth different player to rush for 100 or more yards in a game for the Cru this season.

HOWARD PAYNE

The Yellow Jackets picked up their first ASC win of the season over McMurry 45-33. After being down 0-12 midway through the first quarter the Jackets rallied to be down just 2 at the half, 17-19. Freshman WR Tre Mason amazing for the Jackets with seven catches for 152 yards and 3 TD's. QB Zach Hubbard was 21 of 31 for 337 yards and 3 TD's. Hubbard was perfect in the game till the 10 minutes mark of the quarter.

MCMURRY

McMurry dropped a 45-33 decision to Howard Payne last Saturday to remain winless on the year. McMurry led for most of the first half and took a 19-17 lead into the break — McMurry's first lead at halftime all year. But Howard Payne outscored McMurry 28-14 in the second half to move McMurry to 0-6 overall and 0-4 in ASC play.

TEXAS LUTHERAN

TLU improved to 3-3 overall and to 2-2 in the American Southwest Conference with its second victory of the season over Sul Ross State. The Bulldogs defeated the Lobos on Sept. 6, in Alpine, 34-27 in overtime in each team's 2007 season-opener. The first meeting was a non-conference affair...TLU took a 17-7 lead into the fourth quarter and appeared well on its way to the conference win after Joel Waldon connected with Kash Greathouse on a 31-yard TD pass at the 3:26 mark of the third quarter...On Sul Ross's late drive that ended in the Mark Alvarado interception, the Bulldogs' defense pushed Sul Ross State back to the TLU 32 with the help of three consecutive incomplete passes and a holding penalty. The 4th-and-20 play from the TLU 32 resulted in the Alvarado interception, the third of the night for the TLU secondary against Morales...The Bulldogs did not commit a turnover against the Lobos. Waldon threw for 255 yards by completing 13 of 27 passes. The 255 yards from Waldon off-set a poor night of running the ball by the Bulldogs. TLU managed just 12 yards on 38 carries, and leading rushing Anthony Smith was held to 18 yards on 17 carries. (Smith did break free for three receptions for 83 yards.)...After playing Sul Ross to a 7-7 tie in the first half, the Bulldogs put 10 points on the board in the third quarter with a Josh Spaw 27-yard field goal and the Greathouse TD reception from Waldon...The field goal by Spaw was the first successful field goal of the season by a Bulldog kicker...Kash Greathouse finished with four grabs for 72 yards, and fellow receiver Steven Thrash collected four grabs for a game-high 83 yards...Sul Ross sacked Waldon four times for 40 yards in losses, and the Lobos registered a grand total of 14 tackles for losses...TLU was led in tackles by first-year linebacker Dantrelle Anderson, who made a game-high 12 stops. Anderson had three tackles for loss, two pass break-ups, and a sack...TLU senior defensive end James Villarreal posted two tackles for loss, and senior free safety Dwight Bonner and senior cornerback Robert Bonner each had three pass break-ups...Villarreal returned to action Saturday after missing the game against Howard Payne a week earlier due to injury...TLU has an open date for Saturday, Oct. 18 and returns to action on Oct. 25 with a road game at McMurry University in Abilene, Texas.

HARDIN-SIMMONS

HSU moved to 9-0 all-time against East Texas Baptist. The Cowboy defense did not allow a point to ETBU in the second half. ETBU's safety came on a snap that went out of the end zone. HSU had more than twice the number of yards that ETBU was allowing going into the game. The Cowboys had four interceptions from its defense in the game.

SUL ROSS STATE

Texas Lutheran had the upper hand taking advantage of costly opponent turnovers which led to a 24-14 Bulldog victory over Sul Ross Saturday evening in Seguin. Saturday's conference loss marked the second defeat for the Lobos at the hands of TLU as the Bulldogs posted a 34-27 non conference overtime win in the season opener at Jackson Field on September 6. The Lobos dominated in the rushing battle recording 109 yards while holding Texas Lutheran to 12. Sully also outpaced the Bulldogs in first downs, 21-18. Texas Lutheran tallied 255 yards of passing with the Lobos mustering 140. Jermaine Swearington led the ground assault with 18 carries for 70 yards and a score. Monte Morales struggled throughout the evening completing 15 of 34 pass attempts for 134 yards and a touchdown but was picked off three times. Freshman Travis Woods led defenders with seven tackles, all solo including a pair of sacks. Johnnie Williams and Fernie Acosta also tallied seven stops each in the effort.

The Weekly Recap:

Mary Hardin-Baylor, Hardin-Simmons, Texas Lutheran and Howard Payne all prevailed during Week 6 of American Southwest Conference play on Saturday (Oct. 11). Nationally-ranked UMHB (5-0, 4-0 ASC), which was without its top two running backs, jumped out to a 21-point lead in the first quarter and went on to collect a 35-10 victory on the road over Louisiana College (2-3, 0-3 ASC). The Cru took over sole possession of first place in the ASC because of the East Texas Baptist-Hardin-Simmons result from Abilene, Texas, later in the day. Host HSU (5-1, 4-1 ASC), which is also nationally ranked, held ETBU's rushing duo of Jair Stover and Corey George each under 100 yards on its way to dealing the Tigers (3-2, 3-1 ASC) their first conference loss of the season, 40-12. Texas Lutheran and Sul Ross State met for the second time this season – only this time it was held in Seguin, Texas, and it counted toward the conference standings. TLU (3-3, 2-2 ASC) used a late interception returned for a touchdown by Mark Alvarado to make it a season sweep of the Lobos (2-3, 1-2 ASC) with a 24-14 victory. Howard Payne (2-3, 1-2 ASC) used 337 yards through the air to defeat McMurry (0-6, 0-4 ASC), 45-33, on the road and earn its first ASC victory of the season.
