OFFENSIVE

Allie Mullins, S, Fr., Mississippi College

Mississippi College freshman setter **Allie Mullins** (*The Woodlands, TX / TWHS*) paced two conference wins by dishing out 66 assists and hitting .324 with 13 kills. Mullins also chipped in 23 digs, one block and a service ace in the wins over LeTourneau and Texas-Tyler.

DEFENSIVE

Amber Wetz, OH, So., Texas-Dallas

Texas-Dallas sophomore outside hitter **Amber Wetz** (*San Antonio, TX / Madison HS*) had a career-best 28 digs in a five-game loss to Austin College and tallied 33 overall on the week. Wetz, who also won the division's top weekly offensive award earlier this season, added 13 kills and one assist over the two matches.

Kaela Parnell, MB, Jr., Hardin-Simmons

Hardin-Simmons junior middle blocker **Kaela Parnell** (*Carrollton, TX / Hebron HS*) had a pair of double-digit kills in conference wins over McMurry and Concordia Texas. Parnell, who becomes a two-time winner of the division's weekly offensive award, had a combined 22 kills and hit .395 with eight digs and eight blocks.

DEFENSIVE

Gracen Harris, LIB, So., Hardin-Simmons

Hardin-Simmons sophomore libero **Gracen Harris** (*Austin, TX / Westwood HS*) had a season-high 27 digs in a win over McMurry and added six in a victory over Concordia Texas. Harris also posted five service aces and two kills on the week.

OFFENSIVE: Texas-Dallas MB Jessica Nassau had a career-best 18 kills and hit .429 in a give-game loss to Austin College. . . . Texas Lutheran OH Jessica Stetter had nine kills and 10 digs in a win over Schreiner. . . . Sul Ross State OH Erica Aeschleman posted 47 kills over a five-match stretch.

DEFENSIVE: Mississippi College LIB Amanda Greene had 24 digs over two conference wins. . . . Sul Ross State DS Melissa Espinosa had 67 digs over a 2-3 week. . . . Texas Lutheran MB Jamie Lassiter had four blocks and two digs in a sweep of Schreiner.

Second ASC Cross Division Matches Slated for Weekend

RICHARDSON, Texas -- The second American Southwest Conference Cross Division volleyball matches of 2008 will take place this weekend (Oct. 17-18) in Belton, Texas, and Longview, Texas. All 13 league teams will again be in action and all matches still count toward ASC standings.

During the first Cross Division matches held October 3-4, the West Division earned bragging rights with a 12-9 advantage.

Mary Hardin-Baylor (5-16, 3-6) will serve as host in Belton. Matches at UMHB will be played at Mayborn Campus Center. Joining the Cru from the East Division will be Texas-Dallas (15-6, 7-2) and Texas-Tyler (9-11, 3-6). West Division schools in attendance will be Hardin-Simmons (13-6, 10-1), McMurry (12-6, 6-4), Schreiner (10-10, 7-5) and Sul Ross State (2-19, 0-12).

LeTourneau (4-13, 1-10 ASC) play host in Longview, with all matches being played at Solheim Center. Joining the YellowJackets from the East will be first-place East Texas Baptist (18-6, 10-1) and Mississippi College (13-9, 5-7). Representing the West Division will be first-place Texas Lutheran (15-2, 12-0), which is the only team without a league loss this season, along with Howard Payne (11-10, 4-8) and Concordia Texas (7-14, 3-9).

Matches on Friday will begin as early as 2 p.m. in Belton and 4:30 p.m. in Longview, with start times in both locations slated for 9:30 a.m. on Saturday.

NOTES: TLU and HSU are the only two teams that are unbeaten in Cross Division play this season, both going 3-0 against East competition. . . Admission will be \$5 for adults, \$3 for students at UMHB, and \$5 for adults, \$3 for students at LETU. No complimentary passes will be accepted at either location.

MISSISSIPPI COLLEGE

The Lady Choctaws took two big steps to clinching their first-ever conference tournament berth with wins over LeTourneau and UT Tyler. After a straight set win over the YellowJackets, MC came back from two games down to defeat the Patriots.

HARDIN-SIMMONS

HSU pushed its home winning streak to 15 with a win over McMurry. The win over McMurry was the eighth straight for the Cowgirls.

TEXAS LUTHERAN

The Bulldogs played only one match last week. The Bulldogs traveled to Kerrville, Texas and defeated Schreiner handily in three games - 25-13, 25-18, 25-18 - on Oct. 7... TLU won its 10th consecutive match overall and improved to 15-2... The Bulldogs are now 12-0 in the ASC and have not lost an ASC regular season match since Sept. 22, 2007 (a three-game loss to Hardin-Simmons in Abilene)... TLU has won 25 consecutive ASC regular season matches (13 to end 2007 and 12 to start 2008)... Counting ASC Championship Tournament matches, the Bulldogs have won 28 consecutive matches against teams in the ASC... TLU held Schreiner to a negative hitting percentage of -.028. Schreiner produced 26 kills with 29 errors... TLU is in the middle of a 10-day break before its next conference action. TLU's next matches will be played at the second round of ASC Crossover matches, to be played at LeTourneau University in Longview, Texas, on Oct. 17-18.

TEXAS-DALLAS

UTD split two matches on the week losing in five sets to Austin College then rebounding to defeat UMHB in three sets. For the week, MB Patrica Allen and Jessica Nassau led the way in kills with 29 and 28 respectively, while OH Kyleigh Irish added 27.

SUL ROSS STATE

The Sul Ross volleyball team picked up its first season wins with a pair of non conference victories over Paul Quinn College and Greensboro College (North Carolina).
