FIRST AND TEN

It's Week 8 of the American Southwest Conference football season and all nine league teams are in action. Nationally-ranked Mary Hardin-Baylor will put its undefeated season on the line by traveling to Ashland, Oregon, to face NAIA team Southern Oregon. On the conference slate, nationally-ranked Hardin-Simmons looks to remain in sole possession of second place in the standings by hosting Sul Ross State. East Texas Baptist and Mississippi hook up in Clinton, Miss., in a clash between two teams with just two conference losses. Texas Lutheran aims to move over the .500 mark when it hits the road to face McMurry, while Louisiana College debuts its new stadium against Howard Payne. Only four weekends remain in the regular season.

Hardin-Simmons Offensive Line

Hardin-Simmons's offensive line – composed of senior tackle **Aaron Nolte** (*Crawford, TX / CHS*), senior guard **Glenn Revell** (*Austin, TX / Westwood HS*), senior center **Ryan Hunter** (*Gatesville, TX / GHS*), sophomore guard **Cody Honeycutt** (*Round Rock, TX / RRHS*) and senior tackle **Brian Fitzgerald** (*Spring, TX / Oak Ridge HS*) – paved the way for a school-record 499 rushing yards and 692 total yards of offense in a road win over Howard Payne. Both totals are tops in the ASC this season and entering the week, no NCAA Division III team had put together more than 665 yards of total offense. The line fueled an average of 10.6 yards on 47 carries and did not allow a sack.

-DEFENSIVE-

Lance Stone, FS, Jr., Louisiana College

Louisiana College junior free safety **Lance Stone** (*Van Vleck, TX / VVHS*) made a game-high 13 tackles – six solo, one for loss – and recorded an interception to help the Wildcats defeat East Texas Baptist 27-20 on the road. Stone's interception came in the endzone on a potential game-tying pass with just over 5 minutes to play. LC converted the turnover into a TD to help seal the win.

-SPECIAL TEAMS-

Alan Munoz, PK, So., Mary Hardin-Baylor

Mary Hardin-Baylor sophomore kicker **Alan Munoz** (*Red Oak, TX / Ferris HS*) nailed a 47-yard field goal and was a perfect 3-for-3 on extra-points to help the nationally-ranked Cru defeat Mississippi College 26-14 and remain alone in first place in the league standings. Munoz, who becomes a two-time winner of the conference's top weekly award this season, now has the longest two field goals in the league this year at 48 and 47 yards.

What to Know: It will be the 500th career game to coach for Hardin-Simmons' Jimmie Keeling. He has a combined record of 351-137-11 in 50 seasons at the high school and college levels. . . . HSU is unbeaten at home this season, while Sul Ross State has yet to win on the road. . . . HSU QB Justin Feaster (16 TDs, four INTs) and WR Mychal Carrillo (91.1 ypg) are the top performers in the league at their positions. . . . Howard Payne's defense ranks the highest in the ASC in holding opponents on third-down tries (27.8%). . . . McMurry is the only ASC team still looking for its first win of the season. . . . McMurry has not missed an extra point all season. . . . TLU's Anthony Smith leads the conference in all-purpose yardage (136.3). . . . McMurry LB Joe Alexander is making 7.9 tackles per game. . . . TLU QB Joel Waldon has not thrown more than one INT in a game all season. . . . All of TLU's wins have been decided by 10 points or less.

MARY HARDIN-BAYLOR

The Weekly Recap:

Mary Hardin-Baylor, Hardin-Simmons, Louisiana College and Sul Ross State all came away with victories during Week 7 of American Southwest Conference play on Saturday (Oct. 18). Nationally-ranked UMHB (6-0, 5-0 ASC) maintained its first place status by defeating Mississippi College 26-14 at home. The Cru trailed for the first time this season, 7-0, against the Choctaws (2-4, 2-2 ASC) but stormed back with 26 consecutive points to push its conference winning streak to 26. UMHB's Brian Scott caught three passes for 103 yards and also ran for a 30-yard touchdown. MC's Desmond Mays ran for 145 yards on 22 carries, making the junior running back the first player to go over the century mark against UMHB since September 10, 2005. Nationally-ranked Hardin-Simmons (6-1, 4-1 ASC) remained in sole possession of send place in the standings by cruising past Howard Payne 60-13 on the road. The Cowboys racked up 692 yards of total offense against the Yellow Jackets (2-4, 1-3 ASC) – just 57 yard shy of their own record set in 1998. Steven Rockwell and Derrick Grant each ran for more than 120 yards and scored at least two touchdowns. Louisiana College (3-3, 1-3 ASC) earned its first league win of the season by prevailing 27-20 and spoiling homecoming for East Texas Baptist (3-3, 3-2 ASC). The Tigers rallied back from down 20-0, but in the end, Derek Lewis (382 yards passing, three TDs), Jordan Rideaux (eight catches, TD), Taylor Huffman (eight catches, TD) and company along with two turnovers in the endzone were too much to overcome. Sul Ross State (3-3, 2-2 ASC) won a back-and-forth game against McMurry, 21-17, at home. McMurry (0-7, 0-5 ASC) led 3-0 at halftime, but was doomed by second-half turnovers. MCMURRY

For the second week in a row, McMurry squandered a second-half lead as Sul Ross State came back in the fourth quarter to hand McMurry a 21-17 ASC loss. McMurry held a 17-14 advantage until the Lobos' Jermaine Swearington scored on an 11-yard touchdown scamper with just four minutes remaining, which proved to be the game-winning score. Despite the loss, McMurry's running-back tandem of Keenan Alford and Charvis Nash had a solid game. Alford finished the game with his second consecutive century-mark performance as he tallied 106 yards on 19 carries and one touchdown run. Meanwhile, Nash finished with 88 yards on 10 carries and one score. The loss drops McMurry to 0-7 on the year and 0-5 in ASC play. McMurry will vie for its first win of the year next Saturday when they host Texas Lutheran for Homecoming at Wilford Moore Stadium.

AFCA WILL NOT PARTICIPATE IN 2008 AZTEC BOWL

Due to a last-minute change in the AFCA's long-standing agreement with Mexico's college football federation (ONEFA) the AFCA will not be sending its Division III national team to the Aztec Bowl this year. The AFCA was informed last week that ONEFA would not honor its long-standing financial obligations as the host country. Without sufficient time to secure funding to cover the additional costs ONEFA demanded the AFCA take responsibility for the decision has been made not to send a squad to Mexico this year. The Aztec Bowl concept was brought to the AFCA by Global Football President Patrick Steenberge who, for the last 11 years, has managed the AFCA's relationship with ONEFA and coordinated the team's movements within Mexico each year. His efforts on the AFCA's behalf were instrumental in the event's success. The United States is 10-1 in its 11 meetings with Mexico's college national team in the Aztec Bowl, including a 37-19 win in Chihuahua in 2007. Mexico's lone win was a 34-31 victory in 2003 in Cancun. The AFCA was founded in 1922 and currently has more than 10,000 members around the world, ranging from the high school level to the professional ranks. According to its constitution, the AFCA was formed, in part, to "maintain the highest possible standards in football and the coaching profession" and to "provide a forum for the discussion and study of all matters pertaining to football and coaching."
