OFFENSIVE

Niki Calverley, S, So., Texas-Dallas

Texas-Dallas sophomore setter **Niki Calverley** (*Wylie, TX / WHS*) averaged 11.65 assists over five matches, including helping the Comets to a 3-1 record at the ASC cross division matches. Calverley, who takes the division's top offensive honor for the second time this season, also chipped in 38 digs, nine kills, seven blocks and three service aces.

DEFENSIVE

Megan McCarty, LIB, Sr., Texas-Tyler

Texas-Tyler senior libero **Megan McCarty** (*Kaufman, TX / KHS*) had 117 digs over 22 sets – an average of 19.5 per match – to help the Patriots to three wins. McCarty, who takes the division's top weekly defensive award for the second time this season, also chipped in eight kills, seven service aces and five assists.

Cambra Hughes, MB, So., Hardin-Simmons

Hardin-Simmons sophomore middle blocker **Cambra Hughes** (*Abilene, TX / Abilene Christian HS*) had 50 kills and hit .419 to help the Cowgirls to a 3-1 week. Hughes also chipped in 13 blocks, nine digs and two service aces.

DEFENSIVE

Sarah Anding, LIB, So., McMurry

McMurry sophomore libero **Sarah Anding** (*Pflugerville, TX / PHS*) had 55 digs to help her squad to a 3-0 showing at the ASC cross division matches. She totaled a match-high 24 digs to help McMurry to a sweep of Texas-Dallas. Anding, who takes the division's top weekly defensive honor for the second time this season, added four service aces, three kills and one assist on the week.

IN THE ROTATION

CONCORDIA TEXAS

The Concordia University Texas volleyball team picked up two wins over the weekend at the ASC Cross-Over at LeTourneau University. Sophomore Carrie Fisk led the Tornados offensively with 49 kills, six service aces and 45 digs. Senior Defensive Specialist Sara Keithley continues to add to her career digs total as she finished with 112 digs.

SUL ROSS STATE

Libero Melissa Espinosa posted 38 digs in last week's crossover in Belton. Setter Binca Espinoza added 54 assists. Terry Quinones and Erica Aeschleman supplied 16 and 12 kills in matches with UT-Tyler and UT-Dallas respectively.

TEXAS-TYLER

UT Tyler went 3-3 on the week and kept itself in the ASC East playoff race. The Patriots picked up wins at LeTourneau and UMHB and beat Sul Ross at the crossover. This week UT Tyler will host UMHB on Saturday.

MCMURRY

McMurry joined fellow ASC West Division member Texas Lutheran as the only squads to go undefeated in round two of the ASC Crossover Tournament. On Friday, McMurry first swept perennial ASC East power UT-Dallas before knocking off host-school UMHB, 3-1. Then On Saturday McMurry swept UT-Tyler to complete the perfect showing in round 2. McMurry is now 15-6 on the year and 9-4 in ASC play.

MARY HARDIN-BAYLOR

The Cru went 1-4 last week with all five of those matches played at home. UMHB will play two of its final three matches at home this season. The Cru will play at U.T.-Tyler this Saturday before returning home to host East Texas Baptist and Mississippi College next weekend to close out the regular season.

HARDIN-SIMMONS

Hardin-Simmons' women's volleyball went 3-1 in the week and finished ASC Crossover play with a record of 5-1. Cambra Hughes and Kaela Parnell are 1-2 on the HSU career hitting percentage charts. Hughes is a .331 hitter for her career in Parnell hits .318. Amanda Mace has moved to third all-time in service aces in HSU history. She is 10 behind former teammate Amanda Curry.

TEXAS LUTHERAN

Texas Lutheran pushed its ASC record to 15-0 with wins East Texas Baptist, LeTourneau and Mississippi College at the ASC Crossover Tournament. TLU produced a 6-0 record in the two ASC Crossover tournaments against ASC East Division opponents this season. The Bulldogs have not lost an ASC regular season game since Sept. 22, 2007. The ASC regular win streak is up to 32 for the Bulldogs after a win over Concordia Texas on Tuesday. With the victory, TLU also wrapped up at least a share of the West Division title.

TEXAS-DALLAS

UTD went 3-1 at the ASC Crossover #2 beating Schreiner, Hardin-Simmons, and Sul Ross while losing to McMurry. The Comets sit a game out of first in the ASC East with 4 more important division matches left to play. Sophomore setter Niki Calverley is ranked 6th in the nation in assists per set with 10.93. Head Coach Marci Sanders is seven wins shy of one hundred career victories (93-58), all with UTD.

HOWARD PAYNE

The Lady Jackets went 4-2 at ASC crossovers this season with their only loses coming to ASC East top teams UT-Dallas and East Texas Baptist. Howard Payne is close to securing their first winning season since 2001 with 6 regular season games remaining. Tamika Helene recored 52 kills and 51 digs over this pass week.

MISSISSIPPI COLLEGE

The Lady Choctaws went 0-3 at ASC Crossover #2 over the weekend in Longview. MC did pick up a win, 3-1, over Alcorn State on Wednesday night in Lorman, MS. The Lady Choctaws have three matches remaining on the season, and will look to qualify for their first conference tournament in school history.

West Rules East Again in Round 2 of Cross Division

RICHARDSON, TX – The West Division – paced by McMurry and Texas Lutheran – again won bragging rights over the East Division by totaling a 14-7 record in the second and final installment of the 2008 American Southwest Conference volleyball cross division matches, held over the weekend (Oct. 17-18) in Belton, Texas and Longview, Texas. The West compiled a 12-9 mark in the first go-round, giving it a 26-16 advantage on the season.

All 13 of the league’s teams played between three and four matches against opposite division opponents only and the results counted toward the conference standings.

TLU and McMurry were the only squads to not suffer a lost, compiling 3-0 marks. TLU completed a perfect 6-0 run over the two cross divisions – the only league team to do so.

Concordia Texas, Hardin-Simmons, Howard Payne and Schreiner all went 2-1 to also fuel the West. Texas-Dallas (3-1) and East Texas Baptist (2-1) led the East.

The six-team ASC Championship Tournament is slated for November 7-8 at the site of the West Division champion and an automatic berth into the NCAA Division III Women’s Volleyball Championship will be on the line.
