## PLAYERS OF THE WEEK (Oct. 21-25)

### EAST DIVISION

#### OFFENSIVE

#### **Niki Calverley, S, So., Texas-Dallas**

Texas-Dallas sophomore setter **Niki Calverley** (*Wylie, TX / WHS*) broke the Comets' single-season assist record with a 41-assist performance in a sweep of Texas-Tyler. Calverley, who takes the division's top offensive honor for the second straight week and third time this season, leads the conference with 982 assists this year. She also added four digs, two blocks and one service ace on the week.

#### DEFENSIVE

#### **Krissy Seaman, LIB/MB, Sr., Texas-Dallas**

Texas-Dallas senior libero/middle blocker **Krissy Seaman** (*Mansfield, TX / MHS*) totaled 15 digs and added two service aces and two assists in a conference sweep of Texas-Tyler.

### WEST DIVISION

#### OFFENSIVE

#### **Terah Brown, MB, Jr., McMurry**

McMurry junior middle blocker **Terah Brown** (*Abilene, TX / AHS*) totaled 30 kills, hit .473 and posted five blocks – two solo – to help fuel a 2-0 week against conference competition, including the first win over rival Hardin-Simmons since the 2004 season. Brown, who takes the division's top offensive weekly award for the second time this season, added six service aces and four digs. She leads the conference this season with 113 blocks.

#### DEFENSIVE

#### **Sarah Anding, LIB, So., McMurry**

McMurry sophomore libero **Sarah Anding** (*Pflugerville, TX / PHS*) averaged 5.38 digs per set over a pair of conference wins, including the first win over rival Hardin-Simmons since the 2004 season. Anding, who takes the division's top defensive honor for the second straight week and third time this season, added a service ace and an assist on the week.

**OFFENSIVE:** Texas-Tyler OH **Liz Bartelson** averaged 7.5 kills over two matches and hit .450 in a win over Mary Hardin-Baylor. . . . Texas Lutheran OH **Jessica Stetler** was named to the Trinity National Invitational all-tournament team after collecting 38 kills and 70 digs over four matches. . . . Concordia Texas OH **Carrie Fisk** had 25 kills and 15 digs over two matches.

**DEFENSIVE:** Texas-Tyler LIB **Megan McCarty** averaged 14.5 digs over two matches with four service aces. . . . Concordia Texas DS **Sara Keithley** averaged 4.88 digs over eight sets. . . . Howard Payne LIB **Kristin Hammond** averaged 4.4 digs over 10 sets.

**TEXAS LUTHERAN**

TLU went 1-0 in the ASC but 0-4 out of the conference last week...TLU dropped all four matches at the Trinity National Invitational in San Antonio, Texas...Jessica Stetler was named to the All-Tournament Team at the Trinity tournament...TLU had two matches points against 11th-ranked Trinity but could not pull out the road win...The Bulldogs also lost in four to No. 9 Ohio Northern, in four to MIT, and in three (in a non-conference affair) to Hardin-Simmons.

**CONCORDIA TEXAS**

Concordia University Texas dropped two more American Southwest Conference matches to Texas Lutheran and McMurry University. The Tornados were again led by Carrie Fisk with 25 kills and Sara Keithley finished with 39 digs. Senior Keithley is now ranked #1 in total digs for the 2008 season.

**MARY HARDIN-BAYLOR**

The Cru will close out the season with home matches against ETBU and Mississippi College this weekend. It will be the final matches for UMHB's Kayla Skorbarczyk and Jana Foster as they close out their careers. The Cru will miss the ASC Tournament for the first time since 2005. UMHB had made back-to-back appearances in the ASC Tournament for the first time in school history.

**TEXAS-DALLAS**

UTD Sophomore setter Niki Calverley broke the single season assist record against UT Tyler. Juniors Kyleigh Irish and Patricia Allen are 1 and 2 respectively in the Comets' Career Record Books in kills. UTD closes in on 100 victories as a program, and as of the end of last week the Comets are 94-58 all-time, 64-24 the last three years.

**MCMURRY**

The McMurry volleyball team continued to be one of the hottest teams in the ASC as they won two more matches this past week to push their winning streak to five. McMurry first got revenge against cross-town rival Hardin-Simmons on Wednesday as McMurry knocked off the Cowgirls 3-1 at Kimbrell Arena. That was McMurry's first win over HSU since Oct. 12, 2004, as the Cowgirls had an eight-match winning streak over McMurry. McMurry also topped Concordia Texas 3-1 on Friday in another ASC West Division match. McMurry is now 17-6 overall and 11-4 in ASC play.

**HOWARD PAYNE**

The Lady Jackets with a win over the University of Dallas secured their first winning season since 2001 and one of only 13 seasons in the program's 34 year history. Outside hitter Tamika Heline had her 12th double/double (kills/digs) on the season in a 3-1 win against Schreiner. Kristin Hammond had 27 digs (6.75 digs/s) in the win against Schreiner. In our loss to Southwestern Assemblies of God, Hammond had her 22nd match in which she had 10 or more digs; averaged 4.40 digs/s for the week; had 63 serve reception attempts and only 2 errors in our three matches this week.

**TEXAS-TYLER**

The UT Tyler volleyball team went 1-1 on the week, falling to UT Dallas, but beating UMHB. The Patriots also raised over \$1000 in their "Dig for a Cure" even on Saturday versus the Lady Cru. This week the Patriots will close out their regular season with a tri-match on Friday against LeTourneau and Austin.
