FIRST AND TEN

Sul Ross State and Texas Lutheran will meet for the second time this season, only this time the result counts in the league standings. TLU won the meeting back in September, 34-27 in overtime. Howard Payne travels to Abilene, Texas, to meet McMurry. Both squads are looking for that first ASC win of the season. Mississippi College is on its bye week.

ASC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Games of Oct. 4

-CO-OFFENSIVE-

Josh Saenz, QB, Sr., Mary Hardin-Baylor

Mary Hardin-Baylor senior quarterback Josh Saenz (McAllen, TX / MHS) ran for a career-high 162 yards and a pair of touchdowns on 31 carries to guide a 20-18 win over fellow nationally-ranked Hardin-Simmons. Saenz, who also passed for 34 yards and helped UMHB control the ball for 39:15, had a 10-yard scoring scamper early in the fourth quarter to give the Cru a 20-6 lead.

Joel Waldon, QB, Sr., Texas Lutheran

Texas Lutheran senior quarterback **Joel Waldon** (*San Antonio, TX / Converse Judson HS*) accounted for all of the Bulldogs' four touchdowns – three passing, one rushing – in a 28-21 road win over Howard Payne. Waldon threw for 247 yards, including a 92-yard scoring toss – the longest in the ASC this season – to open the scoring and a 9-yard TD pass with 6:21 remaining to break a 21-21 tie and seal the victory.

-DEFENSIVE-

Matt Warnasch, S, Sr., Hardin-Simmons

Hardin-Simmons senior safety **Matt Warnasch** (*Frisco, TX / FHS*) had 23 tackles – the highest total by six in the ASC this season – and blocked a field goal attempt in a narrow loss to fellow nationally-ranked Mary Hardin-Baylor. Warnasch had 14 solo take downs and his overall total of 23 had only been achieved by one other player in the nation entering the week.

-SPECIAL TEAMS-

Brandon Stephens, P, Sr., East Texas Baptist

East Texas Baptist senior punter **Brandon Stephens** (*Willis Point, TX / WPHS*) averaged 43.5 yards on six booms to help guide a 31-7 win over McMurry. Stephens, who had a long punt of 51 yards in the victory, currently leads the ASC with a 44.2 yard average on 18 punts and led the nation entering the week with a 44.58 average.

OFFENSE: East Texas Baptist's offensive line of LT **Doug Carlton**, LG **Stephen Nicasio**, C **Jonathan Council**, RG **Winston Ives** and RT **Michael Colvin** paved the way for 249 rushing yards and a 6.1 yard-per-carry average in a win over McMurry. . . . Hardin-Simmons WR **ZaVious Robbins** caught four passes for 134 yards and a touchdown in a loss to Mary Hardin-Baylor. . . . Howard Payne WR **Tre Mason** had back-to-back touchdown catches to help rally from a 21-7 deficit in a loss to Texas Lutheran.

DEFENSE: Mary Hardin-Baylor FS **Derrick Williams** had 10 tackles and an interception – the game's only turnover in a win over HSU. . . . Mississippi College DE **Brannon Willisson** had a career-high five tackles for loss and a sack in a win over Louisiana College. . . . Texas Lutheran LB **Jack Moses** had 11 tackles and a fumble recovery in a win over HPU. . . . East Texas Baptist S **Colby Jackson** had four tackles forced and recovered a fumble in a win over McMurry. . . . Howard Payne LB **Kevin Reyna** had nine tackles a sack in a loss to TLU.

SPECIAL TEAMS: Texas Lutheran P **Frank Vera** averaged 30.5 yards on four punts and downed one on the HPU 1-yard line that eventually led to a fumble and a score. . . . Howard Payne P **Cote Scharcherl** averaged 40.8 yards on six punts. . . . Mississippi College P **Chris Lovvorn** averaged 40 yards on five punts and downed three inside the 20.

MARY HARDIN-BAYLOR

The Cru extended its ASC winning streak to 24 in a row with the win over Hardin-Simmons. UMHB controlled the ball for 39:15 of the game. Ben Beckworth added 10 tackles for UMHB. The game was played in front of 7,522 people, the largest home crowd in UMHB football history.

MCMURRY

The McMurry football team dropped a 31-7 decision to East Texas Baptist last Saturday. McMurry is now 0-5 on the year and 0-3 in ASC play. Despite the loss, sophomore wide receiver Simeon Neal had a stellar game as he reeled in a game-high six catches for a game-high 120 receiving yards. McMurry will attempt to get its first win of the season next Saturday as they host Howard Payne for a 7 p.m. kickoff at Wilford Moore.

HARDIN-SIMMONS

HSU held UMHB to 20 points, marking the first time in 16 games the Cowboys held anyone to 20 or fewer points. The Cowboys will play their 200th game since reviving football on Saturday against ETBU. HSU is the only team in the league that ETBU has never beaten.

TEXAS LUTHERAN

The Texas Lutheran Bulldogs withstood a fourth-quarter rally by the Howard Payne Yellow Jackets and posted a 28-21 American Southwest Conference victory Saturday at Gordon Wood Stadium. TLU junior wide receiver Steven Thrash caught a career-best two touchdowns, including the game-winner with 6:21 to play. TLU's winning drive was kept alive by a 3rd-and-7 completion of 42 yards from QB Joel Waldon to RB Anthony Smith. Smith motioned out of the backfield and caught the pass near the HPU 17 and stumbled down to the HPU 10. The Bulldog victory spoiled the HPU Homecoming game for 2008. The win was TLU's third straight victory over Howard Payne at Gordon Wood Stadium. The Bulldogs opened the game's scoring with a 92-yard TD pass from Waldon to Chris Freeman. The play is the longest TD pass of Waldon's career, the first TD pass reception in Freeman's career and the Bulldogs' longest play from scrimmage since Jason Trahan's 95-yard TD pass from Sean Salinas on Sept. 24, 2005 against McMurry. Trahan and Salinas have the school-record 98-yarder (against ETBU in 2004). The TD pass was also Freeman's first-ever reception as a Bulldog. Freeman leaked out of the backfield and went uncovered down the right sideline. He caught the ball near the 30 and rumbled into the endzone. The Bulldogs took advantage of two Yellow Jacket fumbles. TLU was +2 in the turnover margin. TLU's Anthony Smith went over the 100-yard rushing mark for the second time this season. TLU returns to Seguin's Matador Stadium for next Saturday's 6 p.m. game against Sul Ross State. TLU defeated Sul Ross State 34-27 (OT) in a non-conference game in Alpine, Texas on Sept. 6. This Saturday's game will count as the conference contest.

HOWARD PAYNE

The Yellow Jacket comeback came up short against Texas Lutheran. Howard Payne was down 7-21 when HPU freshman receiver Tre Mason had back to back TD catches to tie the game 21-21. TLU scored in the closing minutes to secure their win. It was the best performance for the HPU receiver this season with three catches for 53 yards.

Sul Ross State returns from their open week to face Texas Lutheran in a 6:00 p.m. bout in Seguin. The Lobos dropped a 34-27 non conference loss to the Bulldogs in overtime in the season opener for both schools. This Saturday's contest will count as an American Southwest Conference game.

ETBU running backs Corey George and Jair Stover rushed for over 100 yards apiece for the second straight week, making it the first time in the history of the program two backs have eclipsed the 100-yard mark in back-to-back games.

Mary Hardin-Baylor and East Texas Baptist moved to 3-0 in ASC play, while Mississippi College and Texas Lutheran also picked up league wins during Week 5 of the American Southwest Conference football season on Saturday (Oct. 4). Mary Hardin-Baylor (4-0) became the only unbeaten team in the ASC after holding on for a 20-18 win at home over rival Hardin-Simmons (4-1), which also entered the contest unbeaten.
