**Kyleigh Irish, OH, Jr., Texas-Dallas**

Texas-Dallas junior outside hitter **Kyleigh Irish** (*San Antonio, TX / O'Connor HS*) led the Comets to a 3-1 showing at the first Cross Division matches of the season by totaling 45 kills and 49 digs over 12 games. Irish, who hit .304, also had five service aces, three blocks and one assist.

**Courtney Bird, LIB, Fr., Texas Lutheran**

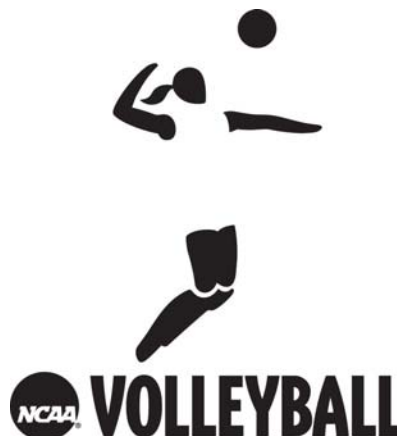

Bird, who takes the division's top weekly defensive honor for the second time this season, had a career-high 27 digs in a five-game win over Texas-Dallas. She also added two service aces on the week.

**Amanda Mace, OH, Jr., Hardin-Simmons**

Hardin-Simmons junior outside hitter **Amanda Mace** (*Garland, TX / Sachse HS*) recorded 44 digs and added 25 kills to help the Cowgirls to a 4-0 week, including a 3-0 showing at the first Cross Division matches of the season. Mace had only one receiving error and also chipped in eight service aces and two blocks.

**TEXAS LUTHERAN**

The Bulldogs rolled to a 4-0 record in the ASC last week with victories over Concordia-Texas, Mary Hardin-Baylor, Texas-Dallas and Texas-Tyler. TLU dropped just two games in the four matches. The Bulldogs came from behind (2 game to 0) and defeated UT-Dallas in five games at Susan Duke Court. The Bulldogs fought off a match point with a kill by sophomore outside hitter Sarah Black. Jessica Stetler had 17 kills against Concordia Texas and 14 kills against Texas-Dallas. She also had 15 digs against Texas-Tyler.

**TEXAS-TYLER**

The UT Tyler volleyball team went 1-2 in the first ASC crossover of the season. The Patriots fell to Howard Payne and Texas Lutheran, but were able to stave off a late rally from Concordia to pick up a win. This week the Patriots will travel to Dallas on Tuesday, Mississippi College on Thursday and East Texas Baptist on Friday.

**TEXAS-DALLAS**

UTD finished the first cross-over with a 2-1 record beating Concordia 3-1 and Howard Payne 3-0. The Comets lost to Texas Lutheran in 5 as 4 players for UTD recorded double-doubles. UTD finishes the first half of ASC play one game behind ETBU for the East Division lead.

**CONCORDIA TEXAS**

Concordia Texas volleyball finished a 0-4 week after dropping games to Texas Lutheran, Mary Hardin Baylor, UT Dallas and UT Tyler. To highlight the week, senior Sara Keithley picked up a total of 73 digs during Saturdays matches of the American Southwest Conference Cross-Over in Seguin, TX.

**MISSISSIPPI COLLEGE**

The Lady Choctaws finished 1-3 at the first ASC Crossover in Abilene, TX. MC opened with a win over Sul Ross St., before dropping matches to Schreiner, McMurry, and Hardin-Simmons. The Lady Choctaws will host LeTourneau and UT-Tyler this week in two conference matches to try to qualify for the ASC Tournament.

**MARY HARDIN-BAYLOR**

The Cru won a pair of matches last week to snap a seven-match losing streak. UMHB will now hit the road for matches at U.T.-Dallas and LeTourneau this week. The Cru will return home to host U.T.-Tyler and then the second ASC Cross-Over Tournament the following weekend.

**HARDIN-SIMMONS**

Hardin-Simmons has now won 13 straight American Southwest Conference matches at home.

**HOWARD PAYNE**

After dropping a 0-3 match to Schreiner earlier in the week the Lady Jackets recovered to take two of three matches at the ASC Crossover Tournament in Seguin. Sydney Bryant recorded 25 kills in 4 matches with a .242 hitting pct. Sydney's 4 services aces and 10 total blocks help the Lady Jackets to ASC Crossover Tournament wins against UT-Tyler and Mary Hardin-Baylor.

# *West Beats East in Round 1 of Cross Division*

RICHARDSON, TX – The West Division – paced by hosts Hardin-Simmons and Texas Lutheran – won bragging rights over the East Division by totaling a 12-9 record in the first installment of the American Southwest Conference volleyball cross division matches of the 2008 season, held over the weekend (Oct. 3-4) in Abilene, Texas and Seguin, Texas.

All 13 of the league’s teams played between three and four matches against opposite division opponents only and the results counted toward the conference standings.

HSU and TLU were the only squads to not suffer a lost, compiling 3-0 marks. HSU dropped just one game (to East Texas Baptist), while TLU faltered only twice (both to Texas-Dallas).

Howard Payne, McMurry and Schreiner all went 2-1 to also help fuel the West Division. ETBU (3-1) and Texas-Dallas (2-1) led the East.

The next set of cross division matches will be on Oct. 17-18, hosted by LeTourneau University and the University of Mary Hardin-Baylor in Longview, Texas, and Belton, Texas, respectively.
