FIRST AND TEN

It's the final week of the regular season for the 2008 American Southwest Conference football slate. Nationally-ranked Mary Hardin-Baylor has already locked up the league's automatic bid into the NCAA playoffs and currently holds at least a share of the conference title. With a win on the road against Sul Ross State this week, the Cru would wrap up the outright title. If the Lobos nab the victory, nationally-ranked Hardin-Simmons would get to share the first-place hardware. The Cowboys already wrapped up their regular season last week with a win over rival McMurry and are hoping for an at-large bid to the postseason with a 9-1 overall record. There are three teams locked up for third place with 4-3 league marks: Louisiana College, Mississippi College and East Texas Baptist. None of them play each other this week, so placing third is in the hands of each squad. LC takes its four-game winning streak into McMurry, MC travels to Texas Lutheran, and East Texas Baptist hits the road for Howard Payne.

Louisiana College sophomore **Jordan Rideaux** (*Carencro, LA / CHS*) caught seven passes for 155 yards and a touchdown and also threw a 21-yard TD strike to help the Wildcats beat Texas Lutheran 29-7 for their fourth straight win. Rideaux also returned three punts for 72 yards and one kickoff for 16 yards to give him 242 all-purpose yards.

Mary Hardin-Baylor sophomore defensive end **Brenson Bristow** (*Richardson, TX / JJ Pierce HS*) had seven tackles – including two for a loss of 15 yards – and a sack to help the nationally-ranked Cru shut out Howard Payne 67-0 and wrap up the league's automatic bid into the NCAA playoffs. Bristow, whose sack went for a loss of 13 yards, spearheaded a unit that allowed just 29 rushing yards and 100 yards of total offense.

Mary Hardin-Baylor junior **Bryson Tucker** (*Caldwell, TX, CHS*) returned a punt 81 yards for a touchdown to help the nationally-ranked Cru defeat Howard Payne 67-0 and wrap up the league's automatic bid into the NCAA playoffs. Tucker, who had another return for 23 yards, added 89 yards rushing with one touchdown.

MCMURRY

After a closely contested game in the first half, No. 11 Hardin-Simmons outscored McMurry 21-6 in the second half as the Cowboys knocked off McMurry, 45-20, in an American Southwest Conference game Saturday afternoon at Shelton Stadium. The loss drops McMurry to 0-9 overall and 0-7 in ASC play. McMurry will finish its 2008 campaign when it hosts Louisiana College for a 1 p.m. game next Saturday at Wilford Moore Stadium.

HARDIN-SIMMONS

Hardin-Simmons won its 21st straight game over McMurry. HSU's nine wins are the most in the regular season since going 10-0 in 2004. Justin Feaster broke the school record with his ninth career 300-yard passing game.

MARY HARDIN-BAYLOR

The Cru posted a 67-0 victory over Howard Payne as UMHB won its 28th consecutive ASC game. The shutout was the 12th in school history. UMHB ran for 371 yards and posted 479 yards of total offense. The UMHB defense held Howard Payne to 29 yards of total offense in the final three quarters of Saturday's win. The Cru has now clinched at least a share of a fourth straight ASC title and a sixth league crown overall.

LOUISIANA COLLEGE

With the win over TLU, LC clinched their first winning season since reviving football in 2000. It's the school's first winning season in football in 15 seasons (1962-68, 2000-07)...Cornerback Kendale Rayford picked off his fifth pass of the season in LC's win over TLU. IN doing so, he set an LC career record for picks with 13...Quarterback Derek Lewis needs just one touchdown pass to get to 20 for the season...Lewis has spread his passes around, completing at least one pass to 13 different players.

SUL ROSS STATE

Mississippi College utilized a bruising offensive attack and coasted to a 41-10 ASC victory over visiting Sul Ross Saturday at MC's Robinson-Hale Stadium. The Choctaws managed 436 yards of offensive real estate while limiting the Lobos to 187. Sul Ross chewed up 159 yards of turf, minus the presence of Jermaine Swearington, but mustered a mere 28 yards through the air as sophomore quarterback Monte Morales connected on only 3 of 14 attempts with one interception. Dominique Carson netted 163 yards off of 31 grabs including a long of 44. LeNeiman Kennedy and Devin Hudson notched 14 and 10 tackles respectively to lead the defense. Kerry Lampkin recorded a sack for a 7-yard loss while Brandon Harris posted a breakup in the effort.

TEXAS LUTHERAN

The Bulldogs dropped their second consecutive game with a 29-7 loss at Louisiana College...TLU has scored one touchdown in its last two games and scored a combined 13 points...Senior RB Roderick Batson scored his first TD of the season on a 3-yard run in the third quarter...Turnovers again hurt the Bulldogs. Louisiana College 29 Texas Lutheran 7

PINEVILLE, LA – Louisiana College secured its first winning season since reviving the program in 2000. The Wildcats triumphed over fellow ASC member Texas Lutheran, 29-7. LC got a total team effort, rolling up 466 yards of offense while holding the Bulldogs to just 251 yards. Late in the fourth quarter, the LC offense got back on track, scoring two touchdowns in the game's last five minutes. The first one came with exactly five minutes left when Derek Lewis, who finished 28-of-44 with three TDs, found Jordan Rideaux for a 53 yard touchdown pass. Rideaux led all receivers with 155 yards on seven catches. LC's last score, which sealed the win, came on yet another trick play when Jordan Rideaux hit Taylor Huffman, who had seven catches for 96 yards, for a 21 yard TD pass. Defensively, LC caused four Bulldog turnovers and sacked TLU quarterback Joel Waldon four times.

#7/8 Mary Hardin-Baylor 67 Howard Payne 0

BELTON, TX - Mary Hardin-Baylor dominated from the opening kickoff and the Cru rolled to a 67-0 victory over Howard Payne. UMHB also clinches at least a share of the ASC title and claims the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Division III national championships. UMHB also stretches its ASC winning streak to 28 consecutive games. The Cru rolled up 479 yards of total offense in the game with 371 of those coming on the ground. UMHB also forced three turnovers and posted two sacks. Howard Payne managed just 100 yards of total offense and 29 yards rushing. The Yellow Jackets had 71 yards of offense at the end of the first quarter and managed just 29 offensive yards in the next three quarters. Tucker led the UMHB offense with 89 rushing yards and he added 104 return yards. Josh Saenz ran for a pair of touchdowns.

Mississippi College 41 Sul Ross State 10

CLINTON, MS - Mississippi College senior running back Kevin Robinson rushed for a career high 163 yards and three touchdowns to lead the Choctaws (4-5, 4-3 ASC) over Sul Ross State University (3-6, 2-5 ASC) by a score of 41-10. Robinson scored on runs 24, 14 and 12 yards in his final game on the MC campus. His final scoring run was a 12-yard rush with 9:51 remaining in the third quarter that gave the Choctaws a commanding 38-10 lead. The Choctaw offensive line controlled the game as MC churned out 303 rushing yards on 55 carries. Zach Fowler added 30 yards on six rushes and Gerald Brown finished with 28 yards on five carries including a two-yard scoring run that gave MC a quick 7-0 lead. The only offense from the Lobos came from Dominique Carson who gained 163 yards on 31 carries.

#11/11 Hardin-Simmons 45 McMurry 20

ABILENE, TX -- Hardin-Simmons has done all it can do and now it sits a week and wait to see if a 9-1 record is enough to put the Cowboys into the NCAA playoffs. The Cowboys started off slow but rebounded for a 45-20 win over crosstown rival McMurry to retain the Wilford Moore Trophy for the 11th straight year. HSU has now won 21 straight over McMurry. Mycal Carrillo caught 10 passes for 137 yards and two touchdowns. He now has 1,002 yards for the season. Feaster became the Cowboys all-time leader in 300-yard games with nine as he went 26-for-38 for 305 yards and three TDs and two interceptions. HSU turned the ball over four times, but still managed 516 yards of offense. The defense held McMurry to 322 yards. Matt Warnasch had eight tackles to give him 100 for the season and Michael Tracy had 10 tackles to lead the defense.

Azusa Pacific 33 East Texas Baptist 21

AZUSA, CA – Three turnovers, a blocked punt and an inability to get off the field on third down were a dangerous combination against ETBU on Saturday, as the Tigers dropped a 33-21 non-conference loss to Azusa Pacific Saturday here in southern California. Azusa Pacific, a member of the NAIA, completed its season with only its second win of the year. Both wins for the Cougars (2-8) this season came against NCAA Division III opponents. The Cougars scored what would be the permanent go-ahead touchdown with six seconds left in the first half to go up 13-7 at the break. Azusa then added two quick second-half touchdowns to go up 26-7, and the Tigers were fighting uphill the entire second half. The Wildcats (6-3, 4-3 ASC), who got a passing and rushing touchdown from Jordan Rideaux, won for the fourth straight game. East Texas Baptist (4-5) went on the road and fell to NAIA Azusa Pacific 33-21 in the week's only non-conference game. The Tigers committed three turnovers and had a punt blocked.
