FIRST AND TEN

The first round of the 2008 NCAA Division III Football Championship is here. The ASC will be one of six conferences in the country to have more than one representative: Mary Hardin-Baylor and Hardin-Simmons, both of which are ranked in the top 10 of both major national polls. Of the 32 teams in the field, conference champion UMHB and runner-up Hardin-Simmons will be the only teams from the same conference to meet in the first round. The two rivals will square off at noon Saturday (Nov. 22) at Tiger Field in Belton, Texas. A preview of the matchup can be found on Page 4 and the entire bracket can be viewed on Page 14.

-OFFENSIVE-

Desmond Mays, RB, Jr., Mississippi College

Mississippi College junior running back **Desmond Mays** (*Normangee, TX / NHS*) secured the ASC rushing title with a 185-yard, two-touchdown performance to fuel a 52-7 win over Texas Lutheran. Mays, who had 33 carries and caught one pass for 20 yards, finished the season with 1,137 rushing yards – 126.3 per game – and 13 touchdowns. It is his third time this season to be honored as the league's top offensive player of the week.

-DEFENSIVE-

John Hamilton, LB, Jr., Mary Hardin-Baylor

Mary Hardin-Baylor junior linebacker **John Hamilton** (*Temple, TX / THS*) registered nine tackles – 3.5 for a loss of six yards – and also forced a fumble and recovered another in a 42-20 road win over Sul Ross State that clinched the outright league title for the nationally-ranked Cru. Hamilton had five solo tackles.

Mississippi College junior place kicker **Brannon Walls** (*Madison, MS / Ridgeland HS*) tied an ASC record by making four field goals in a 52-7 win on the road against Texas Lutheran. Walls, who ties the mark set by teammate Kyle Kruse in 2006 and East Texas Baptist's Kyle Pope in 2007, connected from 28, 20, 37 and 22 yards out.

Kickoff: Noon Saturday (Belton, TX / Tiger Field – artificial)



What to Know: Only first round game in the NCAA playoffs featuring teams from the same conference. . . . Third time in five seasons that the two teams will meet in the NCAA playoffs (twice in the first round, once in the second). . . . Hardin-Simmons enters the game on a five-game winning streak and comes off a bye week. . . . Mary Hardin-Baylor has won six straight meetings against HSU and dealt the Cowboys their only loss this season. . . . Matchup features the ASC's top offense (HSU) against the top defense (UMHB), top passing offense (HSU) against the top rushing offense (UMHB), best third down conversion team (HSU) against best fourth-down conversion team (UMHB), and best team at making first downs (HSU) against best team at holding opponents from making first downs (UMHB). . . . Only once in the ASC's 13-year history has one of these teams not been a part of the league title (1997, Mississippi College). . . . HSU QB Justin Feaster has thrown for 27 touchdowns and only seven interceptions. HSU WR Mychal Carrillo has caught 11 of those and averages 100.2 yards per game. . . . UMHB has had six different players rush for over 100 yards this season (Quincy Daniels, Matt Hurst, Roger Sanchez, Josh Saenz, Nathan Meyer and Bryson Tucker). UMHB DB Derrick Williams averages 6.2 tackles per game and LB Eric Henri has made 10.5 tackles for loss.

Last Regular Season Meeting: UMHB 20, HSU 18 (10/04/08, in Belton, TX)

– *Mary Hardin-Baylor built an early lead and then held off a furious Hardin-Simmons rally for a 20-18 victory in front of a program-record crowd of 7,522 at Tiger Field. UMHB QB Josh Saenz scored on a 10-yard run to make it 20-6 in favor of the Cru in the fourth quarter. The Cowboys struck on the very next offensive play when Mychal Carrillo hit ZaVious Robbins with a 68-yard TD pass on a double pass. Josh Fields missed his second extra point and UMHB led 20-12 with 14:17 remaining. Josh Stephens ran for a three-yard TD to cap an 11-play, 92-yard drive and pull HSU to within 20-18 with 1:57 remaining. Feaster's two-point conversion pass was no good and UMHB's Rocky Vaclavick recovered HSU's onside kick attempt. Saenz ran for 162 yards and two TDs on a career-high 31 carries. Matt Warnasch had 22 tackles to lead the HSU defense*

Last NCAA Playoff Meeting: UMHB 33, HSU 21 (11/18/06, in Belton, TX)

– *Mary Hardin-Baylor held off a third-quarter Hardin-Simmons rally and the Cru controlled the fourth quarter to post a 33-21 victory. UMHB led 17-7 at halftime and the Cru stretched the lead to 24-7 when Jarvis Thrasher raced 65 yards for a TD on the opening possession of the second half. The Cru rolled up 371 yards rushing and finished with 407 yards of total offense while controlling the ball for 33:31. HSU threw for 288 yards, but ran for just 14 more to post 302 total yards. Freddie Rollins ran for 158 yards and a TD on 27 carries and Thrasher added 132 yards on 16 carries. HSU QB Jordan Neal finished with 288 yards and three TDs. Mychal Carrillo caught seven passes for 80 yards and a score. Elliot Barcak and Ricky Lopez led the Cru defense with eight tackles apiece. Chris Jones and Rob Galusha had 10 tackles each for the Cowboys.*

Mississippi College 52 Texas Lutheran 7

SEGUIN, TX - Mississippi College piled up 473 rushing yards on 62 carries as they rolled over Texas Lutheran 52-7. The Choctaw offensive line put two players over 100 yards rushing with Desmond Mays going for 185 yards on 33 carries and quarterback Tommy Reyer adding 113 yards on 12 carries. The starting offensive line for the Choctaws was Jacob Mattina, Jonathan Shaw, Nelson Craddock, Cody Wright and Stephen Andero. Mays finishes the season with 1,137 yards and 13 touchdowns, both tops in the American Southwest Conference this season. The Choctaw defense dominated all afternoon forcing the TLU offense into five turnovers and just 236 yards of total offense. Seventy-seven of those yards came on one play in the first half as Steven Thrash hauled in a touchdown pass from Joel Sheldon.

#7/8 Mary Hardin-Baylor 42 Sul Ross State 20

Alpine, TX - Mary Hardin-Baylor dominated the first half and then cruised to a 42-20 victory over Sul Ross State. UMHB clinches its fourth straight outright ASC title with the win and stretches its streak of consecutive ASC victories to 29 in a row. Bryson Tucker led the Cru offense with 128 rushing yards on 16 carries and Pi'Dadro Davis caught three passes for 114 yards and two touchdowns. SRSU's Jermaine Swearington finished with 81 yards on 14 carries Eric Henri led the Cru defense with 10 total tackles and he added three tackles for loss. John Hamilton added nine tackles and five tackles for loss. UMHB rolled up 305 rushing yards and 456 yards of total offense. The UMHB defense forced three turnovers.

East Texas Baptist 35 Howard Payne 21

BROWNWOOD, Texas - The Gordon Wood Stadium gorilla is finally off ETBU's back. The Tigers closed out the 2008 season with their first win over Howard Payne in Brownwood's Gordon Wood Stadium in five tries Saturday, scoring touchdowns in all three phases of the game on the way to a 35-21 victory. The Tigers gave up 244 passing yards to the Yellow Jackets and were limited to just 65 passing yards offensively. But ETBU churned out 226 yards on the ground and scored touchdowns on offense, defense and special teams to cap the win. Jair Stover finished with 152 yards on 23 carries for ETBU, while Corey George added 78 yards on 19 totes with the three TDs. The Tigers ground game was so effective, ETBU attempted just one pass the entire second half.

Louisiana College 17 McMurry 14

ABILENE, TX - On a cold afternoon at McMurry, Louisiana College pulled out a come-from-behind win, 17-14. The win pushes LC's record to 7-3 overall, which is the first winning season since the Wildcats revived football in 2000. It is also the best record since the 1958 season when LC went 9-2 and won the Rice Bowl. LC did not field a football team from 1969-1999. Overall, LC, which had -32 yards of offense at the end of the first quarter and under 40 yards of offense at the half, finished with 226 total yards of offense. Quarterback Derek Lewis finished with 220 yards passing. LC's defense also forced four turnovers (two int.'s and two fumble recoveries). Defensive tackle James Fowler led the team in tackles with 10.

The Weekly Recap:

Mary Hardin-Baylor secured the outright American Southwest Conference title for the fourth straight season with a road win on Saturday (Nov. 15). The Cru (9-1, 8-0 ASC) has now won six league titles overall and will be making its fifth straight trip and sixth overall to the NCAA Division III Football Championship. East Texas Baptist, Mississippi College and Louisiana College also ended the regular season with a victory to tie for third place in the standings. Hardin-Simmons (9-1, 8-1 ASC), which has won five straight games, was on its bye week and finished in second place. The Cowboys will hope for an at-large bid to the NCAA playoffs when the brackets are announced at 2 p.m. CST Sunday on ESPNNews. UMHB made it 29 straight wins against conference competition with a 42-20 victory against Sul Ross State (3-7, 2-6 ASC). The Cru got over 100 yards on the ground from running back Bryson Tucker and through the air from wide receiver Pi'Dadro Davis. East Texas Baptist (5-5, 5-3 ASC) got its first win over Howard Payne (2-8, 1-7 ASC) in Brownwood in five tries, 35-21. The Tigers utilized 152 rushing yards from Jair Stover and three touchdowns from Corey George. Mississippi College (5-5, 5-3 ASC) used 185 rushing yards from running back Desmond Mays and 112 from quarterback Tommy Reyer to collect a 52-7 road win over Texas Lutheran (4-6, 3-5 ASC). Mays won the ASC rushing title with 1,137 yards (126.3 yards per game). Louisiana College (7-3, 5-3 ASC) had to battle from behind to edge out a 17-14 road victory over McMurry (0-10, 0-8 ASC). It was the fifth straight win for the Wildcats, who forced four turnovers and got 10 tackles from defensive lineman James Fowler. Saturday capped the 13th regular season in ASC football history.
