FIRST AND TEN

It's Week 10 of the American Southwest Conference football season and just two weekend slates remain in the regular season. Nationally-ranked Mary Hardin-Baylor can wrap up the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Division III Football Championship and at least a share of the conference title with a home win over Howard Payne. Hardin-Simmons, which is also nationally-ranked, hosts cross-town rival McMurry with hopes to stay in the ASC title picture. Louisiana College will host Texas Lutheran for the second game in the new Wildcat Stadium. LC is also going for a fourth consecutive win. Sul Ross State visits Mississippi College, while East Texas Baptist hits the road to Azusa, Calif., for a non-conference battle with Azusa Pacific. All nine league teams are in action.

ASC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

-CO-OFFENSIVE-

Taylor Huffman, WR, Sr., Louisiana College

Louisiana College senior wide receiver **Taylor Huffman** (*Winnsboro, TX / WHS*) made 10 catches for 181 yards and a touchdown to help the Wildcats to a 28-14 road win over Sul Ross State. Huffman's receiving yardage total is the most in a single game by any player in the ASC this season. His TD catch was for 58 yards.

Desmond Mays, RB, Jr., Mississippi College

Mississippi College junior running back **Desmond Mays** (*Normangee, TX / NHS*) ran for 206 yards and three touchdowns on 34 carries to help the Choctaws collect a 30-14 road win over Howard Payne. Mays' rushing yardage total is the most in a single game by any player in the ASC this season. He also takes the league's top weekly offensive award for the second time this year.

-DEFENSIVE-

Anthony McKnight, CB, So., Hardin-Simmons

Hardin-Simmons sophomore cornerback **Anthony McKnight** (*DeSoto, TX / DHS*) had six tackles, two pass break-ups and intercepted a pass he returned 30 yards for a touchdown to help the nationally-ranked Cowboys to a 52-6 road win over Texas Lutheran. McKnight also spearheaded a unit that did not allow a TD for the first time in 28 games.

-SPECIAL TEAMS-

Alan Munoz, PK, So., Mary Hardin-Baylor

Mary Hardin-Baylor sophomore kicker **Alan Munoz** (*Red Oak, TX / Ferris HS*) nailed field goals of 45 and 22 yards, and was also good on all three of his extra-point attempts to help the nationally-ranked Cru to a 27-6 road win over East Texas Baptist. Munoz, who takes the ASC's top weekly special teams award for the third time this season, is a league-best 35 of 36 on extra points this season.

OFFENSE: Hardin-Simmons QB **Justin Feaster** was 19-for-23 for 276 yards and five touchdowns in a win over Texas Lutheran. . . . Mary Hardin-Baylor RB **Bryson Tucker** ran for 138 yards and a touchdown on 18 carries in his first collegiate action at the position. . . . Howard Payne WR **Tre Mason** had six catches for 158 yards, including an 86-yard touchdown reception.

DEFENSE: Mary Hardin-Baylor LB **John Hamilton** had five tackles – two for loss – and a half sack to help fuel a unit that held East Texas Baptist to only 19 rushing yards. . . . Howard Payne LB **Jake Dezell** had 13 tackles in a loss to MC. . . . Louisiana College LB **Chaz Kuihahi** had eight tackles to lead a win over Sul Ross State.

SPECIAL TEAMS: Texas Lutheran PK **Josh Spaw** connected on field goals from 21 and 35 yards out for the Bulldogs' only points in a loss. . . . Mississippi College P **Chris Lovvorn** averaged 44 yards on three punts in a win.

What to Know: Louisiana College has the second longest current winning streak in the ASC at three, trailing only Hardin-Simmons (four). . . Texas Lutheran leads the league in pass defense at 156.1 yards per game. . . LC is second in the ASC in passing offense, led by QB Derek Lewis's conference-leading 271.6 yards per game. . . TLU DE James Villarreal leads the ASC in tackles for loss (1.36 pg). . . LC's Kendale Rayford leads the ASC with 17 passes defensed.

All-Time Series: Louisiana College leads, 9-6

Last Meeting: LC 31, TLU 26 (11/10/07, in Seguin, TX)

– A 31-26 win over Texas Lutheran ensured Louisiana College the first time since reviving football in 2000 that the Wildcats have won three games in a row. LC Quarterback Ben McLaughlin finished 20-of-35 for 367 yards with two TDs. Both scores were 40-plus yard passes to WR LaMarcus Preston. TLU's Anthony Smith finished with 21 carries for 116 yards and a TD. LC's Justin Johnson had 130 yards on five catches. Defensively, LC recorded a season-high six sacks, led by Donovan Williams' two.

Howard Payne is the last ASC team to defeat UMHB, doing so 24-20 at home on Oct. 8, 2005. . . UMHB leads the league in rushing defense (80 ypg), while HPU is managing just 74.5 ypg on the ground. . . UMHB has had six different players reach 100 rushing yards in a game this season: Quincy Daniels, Matt Hurst, Roger Sanchez, Josh Saenz, Nathan Meyer and Bryson Tucker. . . LOUISIANA COLLEGE

With one more win, LC will secure their first winning record since reviving football in 2000...Senior quarterback Derek Lewis went over the 2,000 yard mark in passing for the season, marking the fifth straight season that an LC quarterback has thrown for at least 2,000 yards...Senior cornerback Kendale Rayford's interception against Sul Ross gives him 12 for his career, which ties him with two other former Wildcats for the career record...The win over Sul Ross was LC's third win in a row. That marks the second season in which LC has put together a three-game winning streak.

MISSISSIPPI COLLEGE

The Mississippi College offense has continued to roll this season despite the loss of quarterback Adam Shaffer to injury in the second game. The Choctaws have used a bruising rushing offense where they average 197.5 yards per game, good for 2nd in the ASC. The Choctaws are 3rd in total offense averaging 392.4 yards per game. The Choctaws 3-5 record this season is primarily due to a poor turnover margin. The Choctaws are last in the ASC in turnover margin where they are -12 this season. Junior tailback Desmond Mays retook the league's rushing league this week with a 200-yard effort against Howard Payne. Through eight games, Mays has rushed for 952 yards on 183 carries and has a league-high eleven rushing touchdowns.

SUL ROSS STATE

Louisiana College scored all of their 28 points in the first half and soured the Lobos' homecoming in a 28-14 ASC victory over Sul Ross Saturday. The Wildcats shouldered 387 yards of total offense while Sully mustered 233. The Lobos outpaced the visitors on the rush, 113-66 but the Sul Ross defense could not stop one of the top passing offenses in the league as Louisiana College stacked up 321 yards through the air. Both teams combined for 16 penalties for 153 yards. Jermaine Swearington collected 21 carries for 61 yards and a score. Marfa sophomore Monte Morales connected on 14 of 33 pass attempts with one interception. Morales was also sacked once. Ricardo Vera led receivers with 3 catches for 24 yards. Senior linebacker Fernie Acosta led the Pack defense with 10 tackles with one stop for a loss of four yards. Devin Hudson posted 8 tackles and dug up a pair fumbles.

HOWARD PAYNE

The Yellow Jackets were only down 7-10 to Mississippi College at halftime but gave up 29 second half points. Jake Dezell led all tacklers with 13, Ronald Wright also had 12 with an interception.

#9/8 Mary Hardin-Baylor 27 East Texas Baptist 6

Marshall, TX --- Mary Hardin-Baylor bounced back from its first loss of the season with a dominating performance on both sides of the ball as the Cru posted a 27-6 victory over East Texas Baptist. The Cru also extends its ASC winning streak to 27 straight games. Bryson Tucker finished with 138 yards and a touchdown on 18 carries in his first action at running back. Tucker became the sixth different player to rush for 100 or more yards in a game for the Cru this season. Kyle Noack started at quarterback and went 7-10 passing for 110 yards. The Cru ran for 298 yards and totaled 410 yards of total offense while holding the Tigers to just 19 yards rushing and 140 yards of total offense. UMHB fumbled seven times and lost four of those, but intercepted three passes.

Louisiana College 28 Sul Ross State 14

ALPINE, TX --- Louisiana College notched its third win in a row with a 28-14 victory over Sul Ross State. The Wildcats scored all 28 of their points in the first half, and overall, the LC defense held the Lobos to just 233 total offensive yards. The Wildcats first touchdown came with just over 10 minutes remaining in the first quarter when fullback Brock Grazeadei scampered into the endzone on a five-yard run. LC's next score came on a 58-yard pass from Derek Lewis to Taylor Huffman. Huffman finished the game with a game-high 10 catches for 181 yards. In the second half, LC squandered several opportunities with turnovers and penalties. In all, the Wildcats had four turnovers and 10 penalties. Kendale Rayford tied the school career record with 12 interceptions when he picked off a pass in the third quarter.

Mississippi College 30 Howard Payne 14

BROWNWOOD, TX - Mississippi College forced four turnovers and used a bruising ground game, led by junior tailback Desmond Mays' 206 yards, to pick up a road victory over Howard Payne. The Choctaw offensive line was dominating as they paved the way for 347 rushing yards on 62 carries. Desmond Mays, the ASC's leading rusher, needed 34 carries to go over the 200-yard mark for the first time this season and added three touchdown runs. Gerald Brown netted 63 yards on nine carries. The Choctaw defense picked off three passes with Ryne Davison, Blake Rowell and Nolan Willisson each grabbing one. The Choctaw defense was credited with eight tackles for loss. Jimmy Sampson collected a team high nine total stops.

#13/12 Hardin-Simmons 52 Texas Lutheran 6

ABILENE, TX -- Hardin-Simmons continued its late season roll with a 52-6 win over Texas Lutheran. The Cowboys forced seven turnovers in the game and took advantage of several short field opportunities. HSU picked off five passes in the game. The six points are the fewest the Cowboys have allowed in 27 games. After the teams exchanged field goals to tie the game at 3-3, HSU scored a pair of quick touchdowns to end the first quarter. Feaster threw for two more touchdowns in the second quarter to make it 31-6 at halftime. Feaster found Jerrad Grisham on a 3-yard touchdown and then found Carrillo on a 15-yard touchdown. Feaster finished 19-of-23 for 276 yards and five touchdowns. Carrillo had seven catches for 114 yards and two touchdowns. Carrillo moved to second on the career receiving charts.

The Weekly Recap:

Mary Hardin-Baylor, Hardin-Simmons, Mississippi College and Louisiana College all prevailed on the road in Week 9 of American Southwest Conference football action on Saturday (Nov. 1). Nationally-ranked Mary Hardin-Baylor (7-1, 6-0 ASC) took on East Texas Baptist (4-4, 4-3 ASC) and overcame seven fumbles to collect a 27-6 victory and remain the conference's only unbeaten team in league play. The Cru did churn out 410 yards of offense – led by first-time running back Bryson Tucker's 138 yards on 18 carries – while holding the Tigers to only 19 rushing yards. Nationally-ranked Hardin-Simmons (8-1, 6-1 ASC) stayed alone in second place in the ASC standings by defeating Texas Lutheran 52-6. The Cowboys forced seven turnovers and got five touchdown passes from Justin Feaster, two of which went to Mychal Carrillo. HSU and TLU (4-4, 3-3 ASC) both entered the game with three-game winning streaks. Mississippi College (3-5, 3-3 ASC) got 206 rushing yards from Desmond Mays to rack up a 30-14 win over Howard Payne (2-6, 1-5 ASC). It was the highest single-game rushing total in the ASC this season for Mays, who found the end zone three times. Louisiana College (5-3, 3-3 ASC) only scored in the first half, but it was enough as the Wildcats went on to a 28-14 win over Sul Ross State (3-5, 2-4 ASC).
