**Texas-Tyler Earns Right to Host**  
**2008 ASC Men's Soccer Championship Tournament**  
*Live Statistics Available for All Games; Audio for Championship*

RICHARDSON, Texas — The University of Texas at Tyler won its last three games to secure the regular season championship by one point and earn the right to host the 2008 American Southwest Conference Men's Soccer Championship Tournament, to be held Nov. 7-9 at Citizens 1st Bank-Perkins Soccer Complex in Tyler, Texas.

The entire six-team, single elimination event will be available for fans through live statistics, while Sunday's championship game will also have live audio. All links can be found on the conference's website, [www.ASCsports.org](http://www.ASCsports.org).

Head coach Kenny Jones' Patriots (10-3-3), which compiled 30 points with a 9-1-3 record in conference play, also earned a first-round bye as the No. 1 seed. UT Tyler will be serving as host of the ASC men's soccer tournament for the first time in program history. Hardin-Simmons University (10-5-4), which has won two of the last three ASC titles and six overall, locked up the No. 2 seed because of a tie-breaker with No. 3 seed and defending ASC champion University of Texas at Dallas (11-5-2). Both HSU and UTD totaled 29 points with 9-2-2 marks in league play.

Texas-Tyler senior midfielder **Adam McAlpine** (*Kingswood, TX / KHS*) helped the Patriots clinch the regular season title and the right to host the ASC Championship Tournament by recording a goal against tourney teams Texas-Dallas and Ozarks. McAlpine scored the third goal in a 3-0 win over UTD and notched the only goal in a 1-0 win over Ozarks.

### CO-DEFENSIVE

#### Tony Bowles, D, Sr., Texas-Tyler

Texas-Tyler senior defender **Tony Bowles** (*Mesquite, TX / MHS*) helped lead the Patriots to the regular season title and the right to host the ASC Championship Tournament by pacing a unit that recorded shutouts against tourney teams Texas-Dallas and Ozarks. Bowles also assisted on a goal against UTD on a corner kick.

#### Chris Gerhardt, GK, Sr., Texas Lutheran

Texas Lutheran senior goalkeeper **Chris Gerhardt** (*New Braunfels, TX / NBHS*) posted two shutouts with a combined six saves in wins against Hardin-Simmons and McMurry. Gerhardt's performance was key as the Bulldogs needed to win their final two games to clinch an ASC tournament berth.

## PAST THE GOALIE

*From notes submitted by ASC Sports Information Directors*

### TEXAS-DALLAS

Texas-Dallas is hoping it shook off a late-season slump with a 5-0 win in its final. The Comets, who were leading the standings and in line to host the tournament just a week ago, dropped back-to-back 3-0 shutout losses to ETBU and UT-Tyler. The Comets are the defending ASC champions and return to the ASC Tournament for the seventh consecutive season.

### TEXAS LUTHERAN

The Bulldogs qualified for their first ASC Championship Tournament since 2002...TLU was the 200 ASC Champion...TLU needed two wins on the final weekend to qualify, and they received the victories in 5-0 and 2-0 decision over McMurry and Hardin-Simmons.

### MISSISSIPPI COLLEGE

The Choctaws clinched the #4 seed in the ASC Tournament with a 2-0 win over East Texas Baptist on Saturday. Senior forward Phillip Buffington tied the ASC career record for goals scored of 54 with three on the weekend. Buffington will look to break the record in the conference tournament as the Choctaws open against Ozarks on Friday in Tyler, TX.

### OZARKS

Ozarks enters the ASC championship tournament for the ninth straight year under head coach Dave De Hart. Five of De Hart's teams have made it to the championship match during that eight year run. His 2003 won the ASC title and advanced to the NCAA III tournament in Atlanta, Georgia. It is also De Hart's ninth straight winning season. Ozarks will face Mississippi College in the post-season tournament, a team they also faced last year in the playoffs. Junior forward Matt Engelman finished the regular season as the team's leading scorer (7 goals, 8 assists). Freshman forward Guido Salas was second with 6 goals and 7 assists. Goalkeeper Brian Sarber recorded 7 shutouts in the regular season.

### MARY HARDIN-BAYLOR

The Cru men finished the season at 5-7-3 overall and 4-6-3 in ASC play. UMHB will miss the ASC Tournament for the first time under head coach Brad Bankhead. Eleven of the Cru's 15 matches were decided by one goal or less and the UMHB men played five overtime matches.

### HOWARD PAYNE

The Yellow Jackets finished their third season of competition with a 2-1 victory over Mary Hardin-Baylor. Freshman Shane Cazad scored the game-winning goal in the 85th minute. The Jackets do not have a single senior and will return everyone next season.

### TEXAS-TYLER

The UT Tyler men's soccer team clinched its third ASC regular season title in four year by going 2-0 on the week. The Patriots shutout UT Dallas on Thursday and won a defensive battle against Ozarks, 1-0, on Saturday. This week UT Tyler will host the ASC tournament and will play the winner of the Mississippi/Ozarks game on Saturday at 11 a.m.

Mississippi College (11-3-3) will be the No. 4 seed after getting the tie-breaker edge over fifth seed and 2003 ASC champion University of the Ozarks (13-3-3). MC and UO each went 8-3-2 in ASC action. Texas Lutheran University (8-6-3) secured the No. 6 seed after a tie-breaker advantage.

Friday's first-round matchups include MC against UO at 11 a.m., with the winner getting UT Tyler in Saturday's 11 a.m. semifinal. UTD and TLU will duel on Friday at 2 p.m., with the victor going against HSU at 2 p.m. on Saturday in the semifinals. The championship game is slated for 1 p.m. Sunday.

Returning All-Tournament selections are senior forward Kevin White, senior midfielder Bruno Alonso and junior defender Coleman Cochran of UTD, Ozarks junior defender Jason Owens, MC senior defender Keith Armstrong, and senior midfielder Michael Kendall and senior midfielder Rudy Galvan of UT Tyler. White was the Most Valuable Player.

The ASC tournament winner earns an automatic berth in the NCAA Division III Men's Soccer Championship.
