Louisiana College sophomore guard/forward **Tillisha Givens** (*Monroe, LA / Ouachita Parish HS*) averaged 16 points, nine rebounds and five steals over conference road games against Sul Ross State and Howard Payne. Givens, who takes the division's top weekly honor for the second time this season, added one assist and one block. She went 4-for-4 from the free throw line.

Howard Payne sophomore guard **Katy Sarem** (*Helotes, TX / O'Connor HS*) averaged 15.5 points and added four steals to help the nationally-ranked Lady Jackets extend their home winning streak at Brownwood Coliseum to 41 games with wins over ASC teams Mississippi College and Louisiana College. Sarem, who added a combined three rebounds and three assists, went 7-for-9 from the free throw line.

Hardin-Simmons C **Lindsey Newcombe** won MVP honors at the Bahamas Shootout by averaging 14 points and 11.5 rebounds. . . . Concordia Texas G **Cassandra Bills** had 18 points and 12 rebounds in an overtime loss to NCAA Division I Texas State. . . . Texas Lutheran F **Courtney Haskell** had 14 points – including two free throws with four seconds left – and 10 rebounds to fuel a one-point win over Schreiner.

CONCORDIA TEXAS

Concordia Texas lost in overtime to Division I Texas State Sunday afternoon, 68-58. Kassandra Bills and Kerrie Carter each finished with a double-double. Bills compiled 18 points and 12 rebounds while Carter finished with 15 points and 12 rebounds. Concordia will be back in action on January 3 as they are scheduled to take on Wheaton College.

MISSISSIPPI COLLEGE

The Lady Choctaws have started the 2008-09 season with an 8-2 record after beginning last year, 2-6. The only two losses this season have come by a combined seven points and were both on the road. MC leads the ASC in scoring margin, averaging defeating teams by 23 points. The offense has been clicking this year, leading the conference in field goal percentage (.471) and three-point field goal percentage (.374), while taking second in scoring offense (80.5 ppg). Three players are averaging in double-figures this season: Anesia McBride (12.4 ppg), Rosemary Green (11.0 ppg), and Brittany Dukes (10.5 ppg). The Lady Choctaws will play Hendrix on December 20th before getting back into conference play on January 8th at home against Concordia Texas.

TEXAS LUTHERAN

The Texas Lutheran women's basketball team overcame a 14-point deficit with 11:22 to play and defeated Schreiner 84-83 Thursday night in TLU's Memorial Gymnasium...The Bulldogs took their first lead of the second half on a three-pointer by Pearl Kafoa with 1:41 on the clock...TLU improved to 3-5 overall and to 2-4 in the American Southwest Conference under first year head coach Roxanne Long, who inherited a winless team. TLU was 0-and-25 in 2007-08, but Long and the Bulldogs already have more overall wins (3) and conference wins (2) than the previous two seasons combined...The Bulldogs' victory marked the first time since Feb. 19, 2005 that the Bulldogs claimed a second consecutive victory. TLU defeated LeTourneau 72-48 on Monday...In addition to Haskell, the Bulldogs had three other players score in double figures. Tamisha Timpson added 11 points, eight rebounds, three assists, and four steals...Jennifer Munoz and Madilyn Caran each scored 10. Caran also grabbed 10 rebounds...Kim Hagan and Amy Doyle each scored nine points. Hagan contributed five rebounds, and Doyle collected four rebounds, three assists and two steals...The Bulldogs hit 14-of-17 free throws in the second half and finished the game 27-of-35 (77.1 percent)...TLU's next game is set for Jan. 3 against St. Edward's University. Game time is 2 p.m. in Austin.

MARY HARDIN-BAYLOR

The Cru women are in the midst of three weeks off. UMHB will return to action with a pair of games at the Trinity University Tournament on Dec. 29th and 30th.

HARDIN-SIMMONS

The Cowgirls have won three straight games heading into the break. HSU has four players averaging double figures and one more at 9.8 points per game.

TEXAS-TYLER

The UT Tyler women's basketball team, at 7-2, is off to the best start in school history. The Patriots started off their their season by knocking off then-20th ranked St. Benedict. Another milestone for UT Tyler came when they picked up their first ever win over Hardin-Simmons. So far this season the Patriots have notched three Player of the Week honors. Sophomore Melissa Thomas has produced three 30-plus point performances this season and is currently fourth in the ASC in scoring. Senior Marzetta Shepard has also become a member of UT Tyler's 30-point club and is averaging 19.8 points per game, which is second in the ASC. Junior Becky Taylor, who recorded just five double-doubles in her previous two seasons, has opened the season by posting a double-double in eight of nine contests. She leads the ASC with 13.2 rebounds per game and is 10th in scoring. The Patriots have one contest left in 2008, when they host NAIA-member Loyola (La.) on Dec. 30. UT Tyler will resume ASC play on Jan. 2, when it travels to Mary Hardin-Baylor.

HOWARD PAYNE

The Lady Jackets now at 9-1, 7-1 on the year have had their consecutive win streak broken by UT-Dallas by still have their home win streak intact. With wins this last week over Mississippi College and Louisiana College HPU's home streak now stands at 41 consecutive games. Katy Sarem had big games for the Lady Jackets against MC and LC averaging 15.5 points per game. She was followed closely by Hope Hohertz with 14 points per game. HPU is set to play in the University of Dallas Tournament on Dec. 29-30 against Nebraska Wesleyan and St. Joseph's (Brooklyn). Elaine Hobbs and Hope Hohertz each average 6.5 rebounds per game for Howard Payne.

LOUISIANA COLLEGE

All three of LC's losses have come on the road to ASC West teams that, at the time, were ranked in the top 25. LC is still a very young team, starting one freshman, two sophomores, and two juniors. They have no seniors on the team. Sophomore guard, Christy Pantallion continues to be a spark as the sixth woman. Last week, she averaged 14 points, including 25 points against HPU, and is averaging 16.8 points per game for the year.

TEXAS-DALLAS

Texas-Dallas enters the holiday break with five straight wins and its best start in program history (7-1), but faces three big challenges ahead. The Comets meet Div. I Texas State in San Marcos on Dec. 30, then travel to Abilene to face ASC West powers McMurry and Hardin-Simmons. The trio of juniors Chelsea Edwards and Lauren Hale, along with freshman Lyndsey Smith, are all averaging in double figures; but UTD is also getting solid contributions from Rachel Addison, Kori Joyce and Lauren Jiles, who are all averaging around 8 points and 5 rebounds per game.

OZARKS

Ozarks has shown dramatic improvement from last season. The scoring load is being distributed by a number of players, with only freshmen Sabrina Goddard and Lacey Phillips averaging in double figures. Senior forward Olivia Fisher continues to climb the school record books in the rebounding department. Fisher is now sixth all-time with 662 career boards. She is again among the top rebounders in the league this year, averaging 7.7 per game.
