Games of Nov. 24-Dec. 1

CO-EAST DIVISION

Satara Harrell, F, Jr., East Texas Baptist

East Texas Baptist junior forward **Satara Harrell** (*Cedar Hill, TX/CHHS*) averaged 18 points, 17.5 rebounds and 2.5 steals over two games. In a win over Sul Ross State, Harrell had 21 rebounds to go along with 23 points. That number of rebounds has been reached just three times in an ASC game since the 2003-04 season.

Melissa Thomas, G, So., Texas-Tyler

Texas-Tyler sophomore guard **Melissa Thomas** (*Austin, TX/Lake Travis HS*) averaged 32 points and seven rebounds over two conference wins. Thomas' 33 points against Schreiner is the most by an ASC player in a game this season. Thomas, who added a combined three blocks, two assists and one steal, was 8-for-9 from the free-throw line.

WEST DIVISION

Amber Horton, G, Sr., McMurry

McMurry senior guard **Amber Horton** (*Mansfield, TX/Mansfield Summitt HS*) averaged 24.5 points to pace conference wins over Louisiana College and Mississippi College – both of which were the first victories against them this season. Horton shot 50 percent from the floor and added three steals, one rebounds and one assist. She committed just four turnovers.

TEXAS-DALLAS

Texas-Dallas is 4-1 with its only blemish an overtime loss to nationally-ranked St. Benedict (MN). UTD started the conference schedule with road wins over UMHB and Concordia. The Comets are consistently holding opponents to a .379 shooting percentage, and have been winning the rebounding battle, 44.2-35.0 per game. UTD has four players averaging in double-figure scoring, led by junior guard Chelsea Edwards' 16.4 ppg. Junior post Rachel Addison has emerged as a force, posting two double-doubles while averaging 12.0 points and 7.6 rebounds per game. Lauren Hale and freshman Lyndsey Smith are both hitting more than 41 percent of their three-point attempts and are combining for 22.6 ppg.

MARY HARDIN-BAYLOR

The Cru women posted their first win of the season in a victory over Ozarks. The UMHB women will now travel to ETBU and LeTourneau this weekend before taking three weeks off. The Cru women will return to action with a pair of games at the Trinity University Tournament on December 29th and 30th.

TEXAS-TYLER

The UT Tyler Patriots won two ASC road games on the week, beating Texas Lutheran and Schreiner. Melissa Thomas averaged 32 points a game, while Becky Taylor notched her fourth and fifth consecutive double-doubles. This week the Patriots will host Hardin-Simmons and McMurry.

OZARKS

Sophomore guard Ally Goddard is having a breakout season, as she has scored in double figures twice already, including pumping in a career-high 14 against Concordia Saturday. Goddard has hit 8-of-19 from behind the three-point arc. Senior forward Olivia Fisher recorded her second double-double of the season (11 points, 17 rebounds) Saturday against Concordia. Fisher, who won the league's rebounding title last season, is snagging 8.5 boards per game this season. A number of freshmen have played key roles thus far, including the team's leading scorer - Sabrina Goddard (11.3 ppg).

Howard Payne is using a well balanced attack on offense with 5 players averaging 8 or more points per game. CONCORDIA TEXAS

New CTX Head Coach Steve Cochran picked up a win in his first game at the helm of the Tornado program against the Ozarks, 73-72. Senior Preseason West Player of the Year Kassandra Bills led the Tornados with 22 points, four rebounds and three steals.

SCHREINER

Monica Enriquez was everywhere in SU's first conference game of the season against UT-Tyler. In a game where the Lady Mountaineers fought back hard (only to come up short), she had 23 points, seven rebounds, seven assists, two blocks, and four steals.
