### **EAST DIVISION**

#### **Marzetta Shepard, G, Sr., Texas-Tyler**

Texas-Tyler senior guard **Marzetta Shepard** (*Atlanta, TX/AHS*) averaged 23.7 points, 7.3 rebounds and 5.3 steals over three games, including the Patriots' first-ever win over Hardin-Simmons. Shepard, who also added three assists and shot 51 percent from the floor, poured in a career-high 30 points against HSU and recorded a double double in a victory against Jarvis Christian.

### **WEST DIVISION**

#### **Kassandra Bills, G, Sr., Concordia Texas**

Concordia Texas senior guard **Kassandra Bills** (*Pflugerville, TX/PHS*) averaged 22 points, 8.5 rebounds and three assists over conference wins against East Texas Baptist and LeTourneau. Bills, who added a combined four steals and two blocks, shot 58 percent from the floor and hit all five of her free-throw attempts. She committed just one turnover.

Louisiana College G **Christy Pantallion** averaged 21 points and went 21-for-21 from the free-throw line over a 2-1 week. . . . Ozarks C **Sabrina Goddard** averaged 16 points and 8.5 rebounds over a 1-1 week. . . . LeTourneau G **Brittany Adams** averaged 10 points and hit four 3-pointers over two losses. . . . McMurry G **Amber Horton** scored 18 points and grabbed eight rebounds in a win over Texas-Tyler. . . . Texas Lutheran G **Kimberly Hagan** averaged 12.7 points and 4.7 rebounds over three games.

### LOUISIANA COLLEGE

Preseason ASC East Player of the Year, Tillisha Givens is averaging nearly a double-double for the year, posting a 17.5 point per game average and a 9.2 rebounds per game average... The LC defense has forced opponents into an average of 25.3 turnovers per game... Junior guard Krystle Hunter leads the team in steals with 25... LC is still a very young team as there are no seniors on the roster and only two juniors. Four of LC's top five leading scorers are either freshmen or sophomores.

### OZARKS

Freshman center Sabrina Goddard averaged 16.0 points and 8.5 rebounds during UO's 1-1 week. Goddard posted her first collegiate double-double when she scored 20 points and grabbed 12 rebounds in a win against Sul Ross State. Goddard has reached double figures in scoring five times this season. Senior forward Olivia Fisher collected her third double-digit rebound effort of the season this week. So far her rebounds high this season are 17, 15 and 11. Freshman guard Lacey Phillips has hit three three-pointers against two different opponents this season and has hit at least two three's in all but two games thus far.

### HOWARD PAYNE

The Lady Jackets 39 game winning streak came to an end with a 55-77 loss to UT-Dallas on Saturday. The 39 game streak with the longest active streak in the nation and any level. The loss also ended HPU's 31 conference game win streak. The Lady Jackets still have an active 38 home game win streak. The last time HPU had loss by double digits was January 12 of 2006 to McMurry 48-64, and the last conference loss for Howard Payne came on January 14, 2006 to Hardin-Simmons, 48-51.

### CONCORDIA TEXAS

Concordia women's basketball finished with a very successful road trip picking up two wins over LeTourneau and East Texas Baptist. Kassandra Bills led the Tornados with 44 points, 17 rebounds and 5-5 from the free throw line.

**MISSISSIPPI COLLEGE**

The Lady Choctaws moved into a tie for second in the ASC East with wins over Schreiner and Texas Lutheran. MC's offense exploded for an average of 95.0 points per game, including 101 against Schreiner. The defense was also stout, holding the opponents to only .328 shooting from the floor. MC will host Piedmont on Saturday before hitting the road to face Howard Payne and Sul Ross St. next week.

**LETOURNEAU**

LETU dropped a pair of hard-fought games this week to fall to 1-3 in ASC play.

**TEXAS-DALLAS**

Texas-Dallas is no longer flying under the radar after improving to 6-1 with a dominating 77-55 win over defending national champion Howard Payne. The victory, which snapped a national-best 39-game win streak, moved the Comets to the top of the ASC East standings with a 4-0 start. Juniors Chelsea Edwards (15.7 ppg) and Lauren Hale (12.4 ppg, 7.3 rb) continue to lead the Comets, but four other players are averaging between 8.3-10.3 ppg, including freshmen Lyndsey Smith and Lauren Jiles. Smith, Hale, Jiles and junior Rachel Addison are all averaging over 5.0 rebounds per game as UTD has dominated the boards in seven games, 43.7-34.1.

**TEXAS-TYLER**

The UT Tyler women's basketball team went 2-1 on the week and 1-1 in ASC play. On Thursday, the Patriots beat Hardin-Simmons for the first time in school history on the back of a 30-point performance and a school record 22-rebound performance from Becky Taylor. On Saturday, the Patriots dropped their first ASC game of the season, by one, to McMurry. The on Monday, the Patriots rebounded by taking down Jarvis Christian, 73-69. UT Tyler will play one game this week, an ASC road game at Concordia.

**TEXAS LUTHERAN**

TLU's 71-64 win over Texas College last Tuesday snapped a 31-game losing streak...TLU had not won since Feb. 3, 2007 - in an American Southwest Conference road win over Concordia Texas...The victory also was the first collegiate win for TLU's first-year head coach Roxanne Long.

**MCMURRY**

McMurry remained undefeated in ASC play as they knocked off UT-Tyler last Saturday. McMurry is 4-1 on the year and 3-0 in conference play. They return to action on Monday, Dec. 15, when they travel across town to take on Hardin-Simmons in another ASC contest.
