FIRST AND TEN

One week of American Southwest Conference football is in the books. Hardin-Simmons, Louisiana College and Texas Lutheran all started their seasons with non-conference victories. Nationally-ranked Mary Hardin-Baylor and Howard Payne get their first chances for wins this week after being on their bye weeks to open the season. With the impending arrival of Hurricane Ike, a few games have been rescheduled. Texas Lutheran's game with Trinity has been moved up to Thursday night at 7 p.m. in San Antonio, Texas. The game was originally scheduled for Saturday in Seguin, Texas. UMHB's tilt with Southern Nazarene will now be played at 6 p.m. on Friday night. The matchup, originally slated for Saturday, will still take place in Belton, Texas. Hardin-Simmons' battle with Linfield has been pushed up four hours on Saturday to 2 p.m. Eight games are on the slate this week -- the highest number of any week this season. Only East Texas Baptist will be on a bye. There is just one more week before conference play begins.

LOUISIANA COLLEGE

Defeated NAIA Bacone College, 17-16. Overcame a 9-point fourth quarter deficit to gain win. Overcame adversity all week as Hurricane Gustav forced LC to practice and stay in Shreveport Monday and Tuesday. They came back to no power Tuesday night, practiced at Northwestern State Wednesday and Thursday, and left for Muskogee Friday. LC's revamped offensive line gave up no sacks, which is a marked improvement over the 2007 line which gave up 37.

MCMURRY

McMurry lost its season opener at No. 20 Trinity University last Saturday, 48-28. McMurry struggled with ball control as they turned the ball over five times (four interceptions and one lost fumble). McMurry sophomore quarterback Taylor Penn completed 10 of 25 passes for 170 yards and two touchdowns in his collegiate starting debut. McMurry will look to rebound next weekend (Sept. 13) against Austin College, another Southern Collegiate Athletic Conference school.

HARDIN-SIMMONS

Hardin-Simmons overcame a 21-0 point deficit for its first win of the season. The Cowboys allowed only 303 yards to UWL after allowing 662 to them last season. Jimmie Keeling earned his 150th win at Hardin-Simmons. Mychal Carrillo moved to second on the HSU touchdown reception list.

SUL ROSS STATE

Three late-game scoring strikes, including a 2-yard scamper in overtime, gave Texas Lutheran a 34-27 season opening victory over the Sul Ross Lobos Saturday night at Jackson Field. The Bulldogs rallied from a 27-14 deficit midway through the fourth quarter and ended the game with 372 total yards of offense while the young Lobos tallied 333. TLU also sported a ground attack of 175 yards with Sully finishing with 159. Former Marfa standout Monte Morales took to the air 27 times for the evening completing 14 passes for 159 yards and three touchdowns. Morales also led the Lobo ground attack with 22 carries for 104 yards. Westley Miller led receivers with 7 completions for 80 yards and a pair of scores. TLU's Anthony Smith led Bulldog rushers with 22 carries for 123 yards and a touchdown. Defensively, senior Fernie Acosta posted a team high 13 tackles while TLU's Dwight Bonner and Jack Moses recorded double figures with 10 stops each.

MARY HARDIN-BAYLOR

The Cru will kickoff the 2008 season at home against Southern Nazarene this Friday. It will be the first time UMHB has played an NAIA school since the 2001 season opener. Kyle Noack or Matt Hurst will start at quarterback and will become only the fourth player to start at that position for UMHB since the start of the 2000 season. Cody Fredenburg, Andy Padron and Josh Welch all won their first varsity starts for the Cru. UMHB has won 15 of its last 16 regular season home games with a 7-3 loss to Wisconsin-Whitewater in 2006 the only loss in that span.

HOWARD PAYNE

The Yellow Jackets open their season at home versus Texas College. Howard Payne lost on the road last season to the Steers 27-33 in overtime. The Jackets will be very young this season on the defensive side of the ball having to replace all 11 starting positions. HPU does bring back some experience in the offensive line with several returners who saw action last season. The talented freshman class head coach Steve Fanara and his staff have brought in will see plenty of action this season in all positions.

Last Meeting: Rhodes 43, LC 33 (09/03/05, in Memphis, TN)

– Rhodes posted 14 points in the fourth quarter to rally for a win over visiting LC. A Mark Oliver 5-yard TD run gave the Lynx the lead for good, 36-31, with just under 6 minutes to play. A 34-yard fumble return by Chris Lomas on the Wildcats' next drive sealed the win. LC QB Wesley Cooper threw for 429 yards and four TDs without an interception. COLLEGEVILLE, MN. -- ETBU had fifth-ranked Saint John's on the ropes for three quarters Saturday, but it was the Johnnies' experience over the 12 minutes that proved to be the difference in a hard-fought 29-15 win over the Tigers before 7,963 fans at Clemens Stadium. ETBU (0-1) held a one-point lead, 15-14, over Saint John's (1-0), the winningest program in NCAA Division III history, with under 12 minutes to play in the fourth quarter. But the Johnnies put together a 12-play, 77-yard drive capped by a 29-yard touchdown pass from Michael Crees to Jeff Schnobrich that allowed SJU to regain the lead they would not give up again. For ETBU, the loss is a bitter pill in that the Tigers put themselves in position to upset the Johnnies on their home field but didn't cash in on several opportunities that may have put the game away earlier.

Millsaps 42 #na/25 Mississippi College 6

CLINTON, MS - After losses each of the last two seasons, the Millsaps College Majors reclaimed the Backyard Brawl Trophy with a convincing 42-6 victory over the 25th-ranked Mississippi College Choctaws. The Majors piled up 293 first half yards as they took a 28-3 lead into halftime. The only points for the Choctaws came on their opening possession when Kyle Kruse knocked through a 32-yard field goal. The Majors scored on four consecutive possessions during the half, with three scores coming on Juan Joseph touchdown tosses. In the second half, the Majors tacked on two more touchdowns while Kruse was good on a 22-yard field goal for the Choctaws to end the game 42-6. Choctaw quarterback Adam Shaffer completed 26-53 passes for 208 yards and one interception. The leading receiver was Renard Ellis with five catches for 62 yards. Brian Richardson added five catches for 59 yards.

Texas Lutheran 34 Sul Ross State 27 (OT)

ALPINE, TX - The Texas Lutheran Bulldogs overcame a 13-point deficit in the fourth quarter and defeated the Sul Ross State Lobos 34-27 in overtime Saturday evening at Jackson Field. Joel Waldon's 2-yard quarterback keeper in the first overtime gave TLU its first lead since the third quarter, and the Bulldog defense stopped Sul Ross State on four consecutive plays inside the 10-yard line to complete the comeback victory. Waldon's scoring run was set-up by Anthony Smith's 23-yard rush down to the Sul Ross 2. The game was the season-opener for both squads, and it counted as a non-conference contest between the two American Southwest Conference schools. TLU (1-0) and Sul Ross (0-1) play the conference game at 6 p.m. on Oct. 11 in Seguin's Matador Stadium. The Bulldogs forced overtime by scoring 13 points in the fourth quarter.

Louisiana College 17 Bacone College 16

MUSKOGEE, OK - Louisiana College opened up their 2008 football season with an exciting, come-from-behind victory, over NAIA member, Bacone College. LC scored 10 fourth quarter points and had two interceptions on BC's last two drives to pull out a 17-16 win. Overall, the LC defense had three interceptions, and the LC offense, although sluggish at times, churned out 344 yards. LC came out hot, scoring a touchdown on their first drive. The score came on a 32-yard pass from Derek Lewis to Jordan Rideaux. After that score, the LC offense went cold, not scoring again until the fourth quarter. Trinity tacked on its second TD of the day with three minutes left in the first quarter as Caleb Urban caught an 18-yard touchdown strike from Wilson to give the Tigers a 14-0 lead. McMurry first got on the scoreboard with 11:36 in the second quarter when sophomore Josh Neaves nailed a 30-yard field goal to cut McMurry's deficit to 18 (21-3).

However, on the first play the Cowboys mishandled the shotgun snap and recovered it in the end zone for a safety to give UWL a 23-21 lead with 3:49 to play. HSU came right back with a 10-play 62-yard drive that including a fourth-down conversion. The drive set up Fields field goal. Josh Stephens got the Cowboys on the scoreboard with seven seconds left in the third. Newcomer Josh Stephens had a 5-yard TD run.
