**-OFFENSIVE-**

**Mychal Carrillo, SB, Sr., Hardin-Simmons**

Hardin-Simmons senior slotback **Mychal Carrillo** (*Sweetwater, TX / SHS*) paced a 29-22 win over Linfield by catching nine passes for 87 yards and two touchdowns. Both of Carrillo's scores came in the second quarter to give the Cowboys an early lead they would never relinquish. Nine catches is an ASC-high this season.

**Kendale Rayford, CB, Sr., Louisiana College**

Louisiana College senior cornerback **Kendale Rayford** (*Houston, TX / Cy Springs HS*) had two interceptions in a 14-3 win over Rhodes – returning one back 78 yards for a touchdown with six minutes left in the game to seal the victory and a 2-0 start to the season. Rayford, who also had three pass break-ups, paced a unit that set a modern day team record by giving up only 87 yards.

Sul Ross State junior kicker **Michael Van Wagner** (*Bandera, TX / BHS*) was good on three field goals – from 26, 25 and 27 yards – and hit 3 of 3 extra-point tries to help the Lobos secure a 30-14 win over Southwestern Assemblies of God.

**TEXAS LUTHERAN**

TLU dropped 1-1 overall with a non-conference loss Thursday night at No. 22 Trinity. The Bulldogs fell 24-0 to the Tigers. The last time the Bulldogs were shut-out came last year, Sept. 22, 2007, at home against Mary Hardin-Baylor. The Bulldogs face UMHB this week, in Belton, at Belton's Tiger Field. The game with UMHB will be the Bulldogs' second straight contest against a Top 25 program. TLU's last win over a Top 25 program came on Sept. 9, 2006 when the Bulldogs defeated Trinity 14-9. TLU has defeated UMHB just one time, in 1999, since the rivalry started in 1998. UMHB holds a 9-1 edge in the series, and the Cru has out-scored TLU 321 to 143 in those 10 prior meetings. The game with Trinity was moved to Thursday because of Hurricane Ike. The Thursday game was TLU's first non-Saturday game of the school's NCAA DIII-era, which began in 1998.

**HOWARD PAYNE**

The Yellow Jackets opened their 2008 campaign at home against Texas College. Steve Fanara in his HPU head coaching debut got the 20-13 win. The Howard Payne defense held Texas College to just 142 yards of total offense.

**LOUISIANA COLLEGE**

LC's defense set a modern day team record by giving up only 87 yards in a 14-3 win over Rhodes. LC's defense has picked off three passes in each of their first two games. Kendale Rayford has 3 picks on the year. Freshmn RB Lee Jones scampered 20-yards for a TD on his first ever collegiate carry Saturday against Rhodes. This is the first time since the 2003 season that LC has started 2-0.

**MARY HARDIN-BAYLOR**

The Cru opened the season with a 30-7 victory over Southern Nazarene to improve to 5-2 all-time against NAIA programs. Quincy Daniels ran for 100 yards and 2 touchdowns on 21 carries. It was the eighth 100-yard rushing day of his career and he moved into fourth-place on UMHB's career list in that category. Tariekus Ellis led the Cru with five catches for 37 yards in his first collegiate game. 24 different players had a tackle for UMHB in the win. The Cru is now 8-3 all-time in season openers.

**McMURRY**

McMurry lost a double-overtime thriller to Austin College, 21-14, last Saturday in Sherman, Texas. Despite outgaining Austin College in total offense and having a plus-four turnover advantage (McMurry forced five turnovers, four fumble recoveries and one interception, while Austin College only forced one turnover on a fumble recovery), McMurry faltered down the stretch and the Kangaroos capitalized to pull off a come-from-behind victory. McMurry sophomore RB Evan Hearn ran for 105 yards and two TDs in the loss to Austin College. McMurry will look to get its first win of the season on Sept. 20 when they travel to Clinton, Miss., to start ASC play against Mississippi College at Robinson-Hale Stadium.

**SUL ROSS STATE**

Freshman Jermaine Swearington netted 156 yards off of 17 carries and a TD to lead Sul Ross to a 30-14 non conference victory over visiting SW Assemblies of God Saturday at Jackson Field. Sophomore QB Monte Morales completed 50 percent of his passes (13 of 26) for 162 yards and a score. Eddie Tovar led receivers with four grabs for 87 yards and a TD. SAGU's Jason Rice led Lion rushers with 13 carries for 104 yards while QB Joseph Garcia completed 16 of 28 passes while being picked off once. Garcia was also credited with a scoring strike late in the fourth period. A pair of freshman led the Lobo defense as David Coe and Devin Hudson saddled 12 tackles each while senior Fernie Acosta added 11. Johnnie Williams and Shawn O'Leary each posted an INT in the win. Junior place kicker Michael Van Wagner was perfect on extra points and connected on 3 of 4 FG attempts for the evening. Sul Ross dominated the first half putting up 16 unanswered points.

**HARDIN-SIMMONS**

Hardin-Simmons has won consecutive games with a score in its final offensive possession. HSU has not turned the ball over in the first two games and has six takeaways. Cornerback Anthony McKnight has produced a turnover in each game. He had an interception at La Crosse and then had a hard hit on an option play that caused a fumble against Linfield. HSU has allowed only 45 points in the first two games against UWL and Linfield and both resulted in wins. Last year the Cowboys lost the first two games to those two teams and allowed a combined 99 points. HSU has turned six opponent turnovers into 28 points this season. For the first time since the second week of the 2007 season, the Hardin-Simmons football team is in the D3football.com weekly poll, checking at No. 24.

SAN ANTONIO, TX – The 22nd-ranked Trinity Tigers put 24 points on the scoreboard in the first half and cruised to 24-0 shutout victory over Texas Lutheran. Trinity (2-0) received two first-half TD passes and a scoring run from senior QB Bryant Wilson and a Peter Licalzi 19-yard field goal. The Cowboys seemed to be in control of the game leading, 21-10 heading into the fourth quarter. However, Linfield scored 12 straight points to take a 22-21 lead with 4:57 to play. Hardin-Simmons junior quarterback Justin Feaster calmly led the Cowboys 80 yards in eight plays to take the lead 27-22, when Josh Stephens capped off the run with a 2-yard run.

### #na/4 Mary Hardin-Baylor 30 Southern Nazarene 7

BELTON, TX - Mary Hardin-Baylor rode the arm of Kyle Noack and the legs of Quincy Daniels to a 30-7 victory over Southern Nazarene in the Cru's season opener. The Cru took the game's opening possession 69 yards in seven plays, capped by a 20-yard Daniels TD run. Noack finished the night 16-23 passing for 196 yards and a TD. He fell just four yards short of becoming just the third QB in UMHB history to throw for 200 or more yards. Noack added 13 yards rushing and a TD on the ground. Daniels ran for 100 yards and a pair of scores on 21 carries.

### Sul Ross State 30 SW Assemblies of God 14

### Cumberlands (Ky.) 49 Mississippi College 28

WILLIAMSBURG, KY – Mississippi College (0-2) turned the ball over eight times as they lost to Cumberlands 49-28. Junior QB Adam Shaffer had a tough night throwing seven interceptions including three returned for scores. Shaffer connected on 30-48 pass attempts for 230 yards and two touchdowns. The Choctaws managed to stay in the game despite the turnovers and tied the score at 21-21 midway through the third quarter when Shaffer found Brent Thompson for an 18-yard score.

### Austin College 21 McMurry 14 (2 OT)

SHERMAN, TX– Austin College scored a late fourth-quarter TD to send the game into overtime and then punched another one in the end zone during the second overtime frame en route to handing McMurry a heartbreaking 21-14 loss. Despite outgaining Austin College in total offense and having a plus-four turnover advantage (McMurry forced five turnovers – four fumble recoveries and one interception), McMurry faltered down the stretch. McMurry entered the fourth quarter with a seven-point lead, 14-7.

### Louisiana College 14 Rhodes 3

PINEVILLE, LA – In a defensive struggle on a field that resembled a swamp more than a football field, Louisiana College came away with a 14-3 victory over Rhodes College. The LC defense held Rhodes to 87 yards, which is the lowest total for an LC defense in the modern era. The LC defense was the story. Besides allowing only 87 yards, they had three INTs and limited Rhodes QBs to just six completions on 28 attempts. They also allowed only 49 yards on 35 Rhodes rushing attempts.

## The Weekly Recap:

HSU never trailed in a 29-22 win over Linfield in Abilene, Texas. It was a battle between two teams each receiving votes in the D3football.com national poll. Louisiana College rode its defense that set a modern day team record of allowing just 87 yards in a 14-3 win over Rhodes in Pineville, Texas. Sul Ross State gave Wayne Schroeder his first head coaching victory with a 30-14 victory against Southwestern Assemblies of God in Alpine, Texas. Howard Payne also gave its head coach, Steven Fanara, his first win as boss with a 20-13 triumph of Texas College in Brownwood, Texas. Mary Hardin-Baylor proved worth of its top 5 national ranking with a 30-7 win in Belton, Texas, against NAIA ranked team Southern Nazarene. The Cru's defense shut out SNU over the first three quarters and allowed just 37 rushing yards. Texas Lutheran (1-1) dropped its first game of the season, 24-0, to nationally-ranked Trinity in a game switched to San Antonio, Texas, earlier in the week. McMurry dropped a 21-14 heartbreaker in double overtime on the road against Austin College, while Mississippi College suffered a 49-28 defeat at Cumberlands and lost QB Adam Shaffer, the ASC Preseason Offensive Player of the Year, to a season-ending knee injury.
