## ASC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

*Games of Sept. 20*

### **-OFFENSIVE-**

#### **Justin Feaster, QB, Jr., Hardin-Simmons**

Hardin-Simmons junior quarterback **Justin Feaster** (*Glen Rose, TX / GHS*) threw for 352 yards and two touchdowns and ran for another two scores to lead the nationally-ranked Cowboys to a 36-28 road win over Louisiana College. Feaster, who was 26-for-41 passing, recorded two of his scores in the fourth quarter to break open a game that was tied 20-20.

#### **Matt Hurst, RB, So., Mary Hardin-Baylor**

Mary Hardin-Baylor sophomore running back **Matt Hurst** (*Whitney, TX / WHS*) ran for 186 yards on just 14 carries and tied a school record with four rushing touchdowns in a 63-7 win over Texas Lutheran. Three of Hurst's scoring scampers were from more than 20 yards out. His yardage and TD totals are highs in the ASC this season. It was Hurst's first collegiate action as a running back as he took over the load for preseason all-American Quincy Daniels, who left after the first play with an injury.

### **-DEFENSIVE-**

#### **Austin Sturrock, DE, Jr., East Texas Baptist**

East Texas Baptist junior defensive end **Austin Sturrock** (*Sour Lake, TX / Hardin-Jefferson HS*) posted a team-high eight tackles – three for a loss of 22 yards – and two sacks and forced a fumble to pace a 35-21 win over Sul Ross State. Sturrock now leads the ASC with four sacks on the season.

### **-SPECIAL TEAMS-**

#### **Aerttrail Robinson, KR, So., Mary Hardin-Baylor**

Mary Hardin-Baylor sophomore kick returner **Aerttrail Robinson** (*Austin, TX / LBJ HS*) set a new American Southwest Conference record with a 100-yard kickoff return for a touchdown to open the second half as the nationally-ranked Cru defeated Texas Lutheran. Robinson broke the old mark of 98 yards, shared by Louisiana College's Justin Charles (2001), and UMHB's Shaun Rochon (2001) and Jarvis Thrasher (2006).

Mississippi College QB **Tommy Reyer** led the Choctaws to a win in his first start by throwing for 209 yards and recording a TD through the air and on the ground. . . . McMurry WR **Simeon Neal** made nine catches for 126 yards in a loss to MC. . . . East Texas Baptist RB **Jair Stover** ran for 99 yards and a TD to pace a win over Sul Ross State.

**DEFENSE:** Louisiana College LB **Stephen Jackson** made 17 tackles in a loss to Hardin-Simmons. . . . Mary Hardin-Baylor CB **Josh Goode** made a team-high 13 tackles and forced a fumble in a win over Texas Lutheran. . . . Hardin-Simmons DE **Hank Hornsby** made six tackles and a sack in a win over LC. . . . Mississippi College LB **Quartez Ashmore** made nine tackles and a half sack in a win over McMurry.

The Choctaws then scored on two straight possessions to tie the game at 42-42 on a Blanton 10-yard TD run. ZaVious Robbins returned the kickoff 45 yards to give the Cowboys the ball at the MC 41.

## INSIDE THE HUDDLE

Notes compiled from ASC Sports Information Directors' Reports

### EAST TEXAS BAPTIST

ETBU's defense held an opponent to under 100 rushing yards for the second game this season, allowing just 70 yards on 28 carries against Sul Ross. Freshman running back Trevor Cavness returned the opening kickoff 51 yards and then scored his first career touchdown, a 25-yard scamper in the first quarter to give ETBU a 7-0 lead. Cavness had 122 all-purpose yards in the first half before having to leave the game with an injury.

### MISSISSIPPI COLLEGE

Mississippi College rebounded from an 0-2 start with a commanding 44-7 win over visiting McMurry. The Choctaws started a true freshman at quarterback, Tommy Reyer, who led the Choctaw offense to their best performance of the season...MC freshman wide receiver Brian Richardson ranks 5th in the ASC in receiving yards with 204 yards and 4th in receptions with 15. MC sophomore wide receiver Corey Laidlaw ranks 8th in the ASC in all purpose yardage averaging 90.3 yards per game. MC freshman punter Chris Lovvorn is 2nd in the ASC averaging 44.7 yards per punt. The former USA Today Second Team All-American averaged 44 yards on three punts vs McMurry last week. MC has used a balanced offense this season ranking 2nd in the ASC in rushing offense and passing offense. The Choctaws have averaged 152 yards on the ground and 227 yards through the air. The Choctaw offensive line has surrendered the fewest sacks in the ASC, just one in the first three games.

### MARY HARDIN-BAYLOR

The Cru stretched its ASC winning streak to 22 in a row with the win over Texas Lutheran. Matt Hurst and Roger Sanchez both ran for 100 or more yards after Quincy Daniels went out with an injury on the first offensive play of the game. Josh Saenz accounted for three touchdowns in his first collegiate start at quarterback. Pi'Dadro Davis caught two passes for 107 yards and a TD.

### MCMURRY

Mississippi College rolled past McMurry, 44-7, Saturday to move McMurry to 0-3 on the year. Despite the lopsided loss, sophomore receiver Simeon Neal had a solid game as he caught nine passes for 136 yards. McMurry will look to rebound against No. 3 Mary Hardin-Baylor next Saturday. The game is slated to start at 6 p.m. from Wilford Moore Stadium.

### TEXAS LUTHERAN

Third-ranked Mary Hardin-Baylor scored five touchdowns in its first six possessions and rolled to a 63-7 victory over Texas Lutheran in Saturday's American Southwest Conference opener for both squads. TLU fell behind 28-0 before breaking a five-quarter scoring drought that began with last week's 24-0 loss to Trinity. On fourth-and-1 from the TLU 48, senior quarterback Joel Waldon hit junior receiver Steven Thrash on a 52-yard TD strike. Thrash lined up to the far left and was left uncovered. Waldon hit Thrash five yards past the line of scrimmage, and Thrash out-ran the UMHB defense for the TLU touchdown. TLU's Waldon threw for a career-high 254 yards by completing 21 passes in 38 attempts. He had the one touchdown toss and did not toss an interception. The Bulldogs did not commit a turnover against UMHB. Anthony Smith rushed 15 times for 81 yards, and TLU as a team gained 126 yards rushing on 31 carries. TLU became just the fourth team in the last 40 games to hit the 100-yard team rushing mark against a UMHB defense. The Bulldogs had 380 yards of total offense on 72 plays. Kash Greathouse led TLU receivers with nine grabs for 98 yards, and Thrash added seven catches for 85 yards. TLU safeties Dwight Bonner and Rolton Stevens combined for 27 tackles. Bonner collected 15 tackles and broke up a pass. Stevens had 12 tackles and a sack for eight yards. John Jackson had a team-high two tackles for loss to go with his nine total tackles. TLU continues American Southwest Conference play at 6 p.m. next Saturday against East Texas Baptist (1-1, 1-0 ASC). The match-up with ETBU will mark TLU's first home game of the season. ETBU defeated Sul Ross State in Marshall, Texas on Saturday by a count of 35-21.

### HARDIN-SIMMONS

The Cowboys rolled up a season-best 581 yards of offense in the win. HSU allowed only 39 rushing yards on 18 attempts by Louisiana College. HSU ran 91 plays in the game and through in the 10 offensive penalties and that is 101 plays the offense was on the field. HSU had the ball for 42:25 in the game. Josh Stephens had his first career 100-yard game with 135 yards on 20 carries.

### LOUISIANA COLLEGE

For the second year in a row, the LC-Hardin-Simmons game ended with a pass in the end zone that fell to the ground. Sophomore wide receiver Jordan Rideaux had career high's in both receptions (8) and yards (113). QB Derek Lewis had a career high, four touchdown passes against HSU. On defense, linebacker Stephen Jackson had a career high, 17 tackles. Senior cornerback Kendale Rayford is still one pick shy of tying the school record of 12 for a career.

### SUL ROSS STATE

East Texas Baptist held off a third quarter rally by Sul Ross State and claimed a 35-21 win over the Lobos Saturday in Marshall. The Tiger offense produced 384 yards of total offense while holding Sully to 225. ETBU's ground attack tallied 260 yards while Sul Ross, with freshmen at almost every skilled position, posted a mere 70. The Lobos had the edge in the passing category netting 151 yards through the air while holding the Tigers to 124. Individually, Jermaine Swearington netted 87 yards on the ground off of 15 carries with 3 touchdowns. Sophomore quarterback Monte Morales converted 14 of 32 pass attempts for 149 yards but suffered 3 interceptions in the effort. Dominique Carson led receivers with 6 catches for 53 yards. Johnnie Williams, Fernie Acosta and David Coe led Lobo defenders with 13, 10 and 9 tackles respectively while Odessa's Jamal Johnson supplied a fumble recovery, an interception and a break up.

Belton, TX - Mary Hardin-Baylor scored on its first possession and never looked back as the Cru, ranked 3rd in the nation by d3football.com, rolled to a 63-7 victory over Texas Lutheran. Aerttrail Robinson took the opening kickoff of the second half an ASC-record 100 yards for a touchdown to make it 42-7. The Cru finished with 437 yards rushing and 121 passing for 558 yards of total offense. The Bulldogs ran for 126 yards to become just the fourth team to rush for 100 or more yards against the Cru in the last 40 contests. TLU finished with 380 yards of total offense. Matt Hurst ran for 186 yards and tied a UMHB single-game record with four rushing touchdowns. UMHB lost All-ASC running back Quincy Daniels to an injury on the Cru's first offensive play of the game.

### **Mississippi College 44 McMurry 7**

CLINTON, MS - Mississippi College freshman quarterback Tommy Reyer completed 12-16 passes for 209 yards and a touchdown, and also rushed for another 47 yards and a touchdown in his first career start as the Choctaws rolled over McMurry 44-7 Saturday night in Robinson Hale Stadium. Junior tailback Desmond Mays added his first career 100-yard game finishing with 107 yards and two touchdowns on 18 carries. Reyer scored the Choctaws' first touchdown of the game on a 14-yard rush early in the first quarter. The Choctaws tacked on another touchdown with 3:23 remaining in the first quarter when Reyer found freshman receiver Brian Richardson from 43 yards out. The extra point was blocked making the score 13-0. Richardson led all Choctaw receivers with 98 yards on four receptions.

### **#na/24 Hardin-Simmons 36 Louisiana College 28**

PINEVILLE, LA - Hardin-Simmons went into the fourth quarter tied with Louisiana College, but the Cowboys executed for 16 points in the fourth quarter and held on for a 36-28 win. HSU retook the lead with 13:59 to go in the game. Justin Feaster found Justice Baker on a broken play on a 26-yard touchdown pass. The Cowboys came right back and forced a punt from Louisiana College. HSU drove it inside the 10-yard line, but settled for Matt Fields' third field goal of the game, this time from 25 yards out with 8:54 to play to make it 30-20. LC came back quickly to make it 36-28 Jordan Rideaux scored from Lewis on a 19-yard pass. The two-point conversion was made at the 2:08 mark. HSU recovered an onside kick attempt by LC.

### **East Texas Baptist 35 Sul Ross State 21**

MARSHALL, TX - ETBU couldn't have asked for a better beginning to its conference opener Saturday in Ornelas Stadium. Or an ending, for that matter - the Tigers held off the Lobos for a 35-21 win in front of 1,820 fans on a warm, sunny day in East Texas. But what happened in-between gave the Tigers some pause - six turnovers, costly penalties, etc. - to not be totally satisfied with their first victory in a home opener since 2001.
