Mary Hardin-Baylor Picked To Win Fourth Straight ASC Title; MC's Shaffer, UMHB's Henri, ETBU's Pope Named Top Preseason Players

RICHARDSON, Texas — The University of Mary Hardin-Baylor has been predicted to win its fourth straight American Southwest Conference football title after a vote by the league's head coaches, sports information directors and selected media members, the ASC office announced on Monday (July 28). Earning preseason player of the year honors were Mississippi College's Adam Shaffer, UMHB's Eric Henri and East Texas Baptist University's Kyle Pope.

Mary Hardin-Baylor, which went 12-2 overall (8-0 in ASC) and reached the national semifinals of the NCAA Division III playoffs last season, totaled 240 points – the highest amount in the annual poll's history – and collected 24 of the possible 27 first-place votes. Head coach Pete Fredenburg's Cru has won at least a share of the ASC title in five of the last six seasons, going 48-3 over that time frame in conference games. UMHB also holds a 21-game winning streak against league opponents.

Hardin-Simmons University and Mississippi College, which tied for second place last season with 6-2 league marks, were picked to finish second and third, respectively, by just one point. HSU totaled 197 points and garnered one first-place vote, while MC had 196 points and the final two top-spot votes.

East Texas Baptist (154 pts.), which had a 5-3 ASC record last season, was picked to finish fourth. Louisiana College (125 pts.) was selected in the fifth spot, followed by Texas Lutheran University (97 pts.), Howard Payne University (85 pts.), Sul Ross State University (61 pts.) and McMurry University (60 pts.).

Shaffer (*Brandon, MS / Jackson Academy*), a junior quarterback, was named ASC Preseason Offensive Player of the Year. Last season, the 6-2, 205-pound Shaffer paced MC with a league-leading 3,497 yards passing and 31 touchdowns opposed to just 13 interceptions.

Henri (*Lake Dallas, TX / LDHS*), a senior linebacker, was named ASC Preseason Defensive Player of the Year. The 6-1, 205-pound Henri posted 86 tackles for UMHB in 2007 and ranked in the ASC's top 10 in sacks (5.5) and tackles for loss (14.5).

Pope (*Longview, TX / Spring Hill HS*), a junior place kicker, was selected as ASC Preseason Special Teams Player of the Year. Pope notched 12 field goals – creating a league-leading 1.20 average per game – and was good on 21 of 22 point-after attempts for ETBU.

Shaffer and Henri were first team all-ASC selections last year, while Pope was an honorable mention pick.

The 2008 ASC season – the 13th in league history – opens September 6, with seven league members in action (East Texas Baptist, Hardin-Simmons, McMurry, Mississippi College, Sul Ross State and Texas Lutheran). Howard Payne and Mary Hardin-Baylor begin their slates on September 13. The NCAA Division III Football Championship playoffs are scheduled for a November 22 start, with the Amos Alonzo Stagg Bowl championship game on tap for December 20.

EAST TEXAS BAPTIST

2008 marks the ninth season for football at ETBU since the university resurrected the program after a 50-year absence in 2000. It's arguably the highest-profile opener the Tigers have ever had in those nine years as well. ETBU opens on the road against highly-touted and tradition-rich St. John's, which is coached by the legendary John Gagliardi who begins his 56th season as coach of the Johnnies. St. John's is ranked as high as No. 6, in the D3football.com preseason Top 25, and the Johnnies are coming off a 2007 season that saw them finish 10-2. ETBU was 5-5 last season in its first season under head coach Mark Sartain, with all five wins coming against American Southwest Conference opponents.

TEXAS LUTHERAN

Senior Joel Waldon will start at quarterback for the Bulldogs on Saturday and will face the team against which Waldon's season ended a year ago. Waldon sustained a season-ending knee injury against Sul Ross state in the 2007 season-opener. Waldon and the bulldogs again open with Sul Ross in a non-conference season-opener, but this time the locale is Alpine, Texas. Junior running back Anthony Smith was fifth in the nation in 2007 for all-purpose yards per game. Smith led the ASC in all purpose yards (a school-record 1,989) and finished fifth in NCA Division III in all-purpose yards per game (198.9). Smith rushed for a TLU NCAA Division III-era record 1,066 yards and scored a team-best 66 points. He scored six rushing TDs, four receiving TDs and had a 92-yard kickoff return for a touchdown on the opening kickoff of the 2007 season (against Sul Ross State). The Bulldogs are slated to start three freshmen in Saturday's season-opener. Sean Doherty will start at center, and first-year players Joshua Poyer and Roton Stevens will start at defensive tackle and strong safety, respectively.

MARY HARDIN-BAYLOR

The Cru will take another week off before opening the season on September 13th. UMHB will face a first-time opponent in Southern Nazarene University. It will be the first time the Cru will have played an NAIA school since beating Belhaven 20-6 in the 2001 season opener. UMHB is 4-2 all-time against NAIA schools.

SUL ROSS STATE

The Lobos will sport several new faces on the roster this year. Top returners include stong safety Jamal Johnson, corner back Johnny Williams, linebacker Fernie Acosta and place kicker Michael Van Wagner. A 2007 ASC Honorable Mention choice, Johnson led Sul Ross with 459 and 120 yards in kick and punt returns respectively. Johnson recorded a career and season best 86-yard kickoff return for a touchdown in Sully's 46-36 homecoming loss to Hardin-Simmons in 2007. Williams tallied a third team-best 67 tackles and led Sul Ross with 36 solo stops in 2007. A team leader on and off the field, Fernie Acosta will see his final action in a Sul Ross uniform in 2008. Acosta led the Lobos with 74 tackles including a team-best 42 assists. Junior kicker Michael Van Wagner added a pair of 2007 game-winning field goals to his impressive collegiate resume. Van Wagner hit a game-tying 36-yard field goal with under 2 minutes left in regulation to force overtime with Howard Payne last year in Brownwood. He then was good from 28 yards away for the game-winner in double overtime.
