Reese, who scored 31 points in a win over Sul Ross State, made a combined 12 of 13 attempts from the free throw line and turned the ball over just four times. He added one blocked shot.

McMurry senior point guard **Robert Moreno** (*Brownsville, TX / Homer Hanna HS*) averaged nine assists, five rebounds and 2.5 steals over a 2-0 week that included going on the road and handing LeTourneau its first conference loss of the season. Moreno, who leads the ASC in assists and steals per game, dished out 10 assists in the win over the YellowJackets.

AROUND THE RIM

Notes compiled from ASC Sports Information Directors' Reports

MCMURRY

McMurry went 2-0 last week on its East Texas road swing as they handed LeTourneau its first ASC loss of the year on Thursday before also knocking off ETBU on Saturday. McMurry is now 8-4 overall and 7-1 in conference play with at least a three-game lead over everybody in the West Division.

MARY HARDIN-BAYLOR

The Cru wrapped up its longest road trip of the season and now the UMHB men will turn around and hit the road for the long swing to Alpine and Brownwood. Elmo Williams averaged 13 points and six rebounds a game in his first starts of the season. He also dished off 3.5 assists per game. F Ervin Johnson also earned his first start of the season against Mississippi College. Williams and Johnson joined the Cru at the semester break.

OZARKS

Head coach Matt O'Connor notched his 88th career win at Ozarks. O'Connor ranks second all-time in career wins behind Johnny Johnson who won 173 games. With a 2-0 record during the week, the Eagles remain undefeated at home (6-0) this season. Both Chris Williams and Tony Daniels had their second straight double-doubles. Daniels averaged 19 points and 10.5 rebounds during that span and Williams averaged 19.5 points and 14.0 rebounds over the last two games. For the fourth the straight game, Tony Brock has led the team in assists. Brock has been the team leader in that category in all but two games.

TEAXS LUTHERAN

TLU sophomore point guard Malcolm Dotson had four steals against UT-Dallas and four more against University of the Ozarks. Dotson is tied for the ASC lead in steals per game, at 2.7 per contest.

HARDIN-SIMMONS

HSU has lost six straight games, the longest losing streak for the Cowboys since losing seven in a row in a 5-20, 2003 season. HSU averaged 10 3-pointers made in its two games this week and is second in the ASC with 8.4 makes per game.

LOUISIANA COLLEGE

LC has hit a rough patch, winning only one of their last seven games. Josh Johnson continues to have a strong season, averaging 18.0 ppg.

MISSISSIPPI COLLEGE

The Choctaws extended their ASC-leading active winning streak to five games with wins over Belhaven, Concordia (TX), and Mary Hardin Baylor. The three home wins also extended MC's streak in the Golden Dome to 34 games, with the last loss coming in the first game of the '06-'07 season. All three games on the week were decided by six points or less. MC came from six behind in the final four minutes to defeat UMHB in overtime, 89-85. The Choctaws will travel to Louisiana College on Tuesday before heading to UT Tyler on Saturday.

TEXAS-DALLAS

Texas-Dallas went through the ASC West schedule with just one loss (the only loss of the season for the 12-1 Comets), but enters the ASC East Division schedule this week as part of a three-way tie at top of the standings. The Comets have used a balanced offensive attack and stingy team defense to get off to the hot start. UTD has five players averaging between 9.3-13.0 ppg and is still shooting over 50 percent as a team through 13 games. Defensively, UTD is holding the opposition to just 38.4 percent shooting for the season and holds a 38.0-31.0 rebounding advantage.

CONCORDIA TEXAS

Concordia Texas men's basketball program split their weekend dropping an 87-81 game versus Mississippi College before picking up a 85-74 win over Louisiana College on Saturday. Freshman Kenny Williams led the Tornados in the loss to MC with 16 points while Junior Brad Walker finished with 21 points against Louisiana College.

The YellowJackets finished competition against the West Division 7-1 in league play.
