## PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

*Games of January 8-10*

### EAST DIVISION

#### **Olivia Fisher, F, Sr., Ozarks**

Ozarks senior forward **Olivia Fisher** (*Mountain Home, AR/MHHS*) averaged 15.5 points, 18.5 rebounds and three steals over a 2-0 week in conference play. Fisher grabbed 23 rebounds – the most in a single game in the ASC since the 2002-03 season when Lady Eagle Jenna Corbell pulled down 25 – in a come-from-behind win over Texas Lutheran. Only five other players in the nation have reached 23 rebounds in a game this season. She went a combined 9-for-11 from the free throw line and added three assists and one block.

### CO-WEST DIVISION

#### **Tamisha Timpson, F, Fr., Texas Lutheran**

Texas Lutheran freshman forward **Tamisha Timpson** (*San Antonio, TX/Roosevelt HS*) averaged 20 points, 8.5 rebounds and three assists over two conference road games. Timpson, who added a combined three steals and two blocks, had a double double of 18 points and 11 boards – both game-highs – in a loss to nationally-ranked Texas-Dallas. She was good on 6 of 10 tries from 3-point range.

#### **Bo Warm, PG, Jr., Hardin-Simmons**

Hardin-Simmons junior point guard **Bo Warm** (*Garden Ridge, TX/New Braunfels Canyon HS*) averaged 16.5 points, 3.5 assists, 3.5 rebounds and two steals while committing just one turnover over two conference road wins. Warm shot 50 percent from the floor and was 4-for-4 from the free throw line. She scored a career-high 25 points against East Texas Baptist.

## AROUND THE RIM

### TEXAS-DALLAS

Texas-Dallas finished off its first-ever sweep through the ASC West Division and takes a two-game lead into the ASC East Division schedule. The Comets' secret to success this season has been a balanced attack and stout defense. UTD has three players - juniors Chelsea Edwards and Lauren Hale along with freshman Lyndsey Smith - averaging in double figures with three others averaging over seven points a game. Defensively, UTD is holding opponents to 38.9 percent shooting per game and winning the rebounding battle, 40.6-35.4 per game.

### OZARKS

Ozarks has won two straight and have easily surpassed last season's win total. The Lady Eagles are actually averaging less points than a year ago, but are holding their opponents to 13 fewer points a contest. Olivia Fisher came within three rebounds of breaking the school's single-game rebound record on Saturday. She did surpass her previous best of 18 set last season against Texas Lutheran. The school record is 25 set in 2002 by Jenna Corbell. Saturday's game against Texas Lutheran saw a combined 145 shots from the field, the most of the season for Ozarks. Freshman guard Lacey Phillips has hit two three-pointers six times this season. She has nailed a three in all but two games. Freshman guard Alison Villines scored a career-high 14 points Thursday night. She has reached double figures three times this season.

### MARY HARDIN-BAYLOR

The Cru women just wrapped up the longest road trip of the season and will now turn around and hit the road again for Alpine and Brownwood this weekend. UMHB held Louisiana College to just 26 per cent shooting from the field in a 47-43 victory last Thursday.

**HARDIN-SIMMONS**

HSU finished play in the ASC East with a record of 5-3 it is the first time that the Cowgirls have lost more than one time to ASC East teams in the regular season. Lindsey Newcombe has double-doubles in 10 of the Cowgirls 12 games. Freshman Jasmine Lewis scored a career-best 14 points in the win over LeTourneau, freshman Kara Looten had a career-best 10 points in the win over ETBU.

**TEXAS LUTHERAN**

TLU leads the American Southwest Conference in overall rebounding (48.8 per game), defensive rebounds, and three-point field goals made per game (6.9)...The Bulldogs are second in the ASC in offensive rebounding and in team blocked shots (5.3 per game).

**MISSISSIPPI COLLEGE**

The Lady Choctaws picked up two wins over Concordia (TX) and Mary Hardin-Baylor to stay in a tie for second in the ASC East heading into East play. MC shot 52% (12-23) from the three-point line in the two wins. The defense also stepped up, holding the two ASC West opponents to 37% shooting from the floor and 27% shooting from the arc. MC will head to Louisiana College on Tuesday and UT Tyler on Saturday.

**LOUISIANA COLLEGE**

LC's two leading scorers at just sophomores (Christy Pantallion - 16.4 ppg, and Tillisha Givens - 16.2 ppg), and three of their four leading scorers are sophomores. In a loss Thursday to UMHB, LC shot only 13.5 percent from the field in the second half and scored a total of 43 points, which was their lowest point total this season. Three of LC's four losses have come to ASC West teams that were ranked in the top 25 at the time that they played them.

**CONCORDIA TEXAS**

Concordia Texas women's basketball program dropped two ASC match-ups against Mississippi College and then Louisiana College over the weekend. Kassandra Bills posted 27 points in the loss to MC. Concordia will be back on the road for another weekend against Howard Payne and Sul Ross State.

**MCMURRY**

McMurry went 2-0 last week as they knocked off LeTourneau and ETBU in ASC crossover road contests. McMurry is now 9-3 overall and 6-2 in conference play, which puts them tied for first place with Howard Payne (when considering the conference loss totals) in the West Division.
