EAST DIVISION

Anthony Reese, G, Sr., Texas-Tyler

Texas-Tyler senior guard **Anthony Reese** (*Longview, TX / LHS*) averaged 18 points, 11 rebounds and two steals over two conference games. Reese, who takes the division's top honor for the second straight week, also added three assists and shot 60 percent from the floor. He turned the ball over just three times. Reese was the only player in games against Louisiana College and Mississippi College to get a double double.

WEST DIVISION

Jonathan Walker, G, Sr., McMurry

McMurry senior guard **Jonathan Walker** (*Dallas, TX / Carter HS*) averaged 28 points, six rebounds and three steals over a 2-0 week. Walker, who takes the division's top weekly award for the second time this season, scored 29 in an overtime conference win against Schreiner. The ASC's leading scorer at 19.1 points per game shot 63.8 percent from the floor and added four assists.

AROUND THE RIM

Notes compiled from ASC Sports Information Directors' Reports

OZARKS

The Eagles came up with their biggest win of the season in a 68-66 win over UT Dallas Monday night. Chris Williams was a catalyst in the game, scoring 23 points, including 12 in the second half. Tony Brock sank a pair of free throws in the waning moments to help secure the win. Seniors Jeremy Clark, Tony Daniels, Brock and Williams have started in all 16 games. The veteran group provides 70 percent of the team's scoring.

LETOURNEAU

The YellowJackets recorded their 10th win of the season with an 80-70 win over Ozarks.

TEXAS LUTHERAN

The Bulldogs have dropped seven games in a row and have yet to win in 2009. TLU's last win came on Dec. 13, 2008 - a 63-61 win over East Texas Baptist. The Bulldogs have dropped three consecutive games at home and four consecutive on the road...TLU leads the ASC in steals per game (10.5) and in turnover margin (+4.85)...TLU is last in the league in three-pointers made and in three-point shooting percentage...TLU sophomore point guard Malcolm Dolson is second in the league in steals per game, at 2.4 per game.

CONCORDIA TEXAS

Concordia dropped two crucial games to Howard Payne University and Sul Ross State over the weekend. Junior Brad Walker led the Tornados in scoring with 28 total. Junior Reza Farahani had a successful weekend with 24 points and 10 rebounds while, shooting 50% from the field including, 4-8 from the three point line. Concordia will be back in action on Thursday (Jan. 22) as they take on Schreiner University.

TEXAS-DALLAS

The Comets' team shooting average dropped below .500 for the first time this season after two sub-par shooting nights. Shooting was also the difference in a pair of tight games. UTD shot just 23.3 percent in the first half before rallying for a 60-59 win over LeTourneau. UTD had to rally from a slow start again with Ozarks, before falling 68-66. Defense has still been effective for the Comets, who are holding opponents to 38.8 percent shooting. Ernie Lowery had 38 points and 14 rebounds in the two Comet wins.

HARDIN-SIMMONS

HSU snapped a seven-game losing streak, its longest since the 2002-03 season. Carlos Singer broke a 81-81 tie with 13 seconds to play against TLU with a shot-clock beating 3-pointer. Casey Riddle scored 13 straight points from the 5:05 mark to the 1:16 mark to help the Cowboys overcome a seven-point deficit.

EAST TEXAS BAPTIST

Junior guard Dennis Jones averaged 15.5 points in the two games last week, including 20 in Saturday's win at Ozarks. Jones scored 15 of his 20 points in the second half of that victory. Sophomore Deba Egharevba had a huge game off the bench Saturday, scoring 12 points in 22 minutes and pulling down a career-high 15 rebounds. Sophomore Josh Chambers blocked four shots Saturday, giving him a league-leading 29 on the season.

HOWARD PAYNE

Tom Hermann averaged a double double in the two games this week. Hermann had 25 points, 7 rebounds, and 4 assists in a win over Concordia (TX) and 16 points and 14 rebounds in a loss to Mary Hardin-Baylor. In both games combined Hermann shot .714 from the field.

MCMURRY

McMurry went 2-0 in ASC West play with wins over Texas Lutheran and Schreiner. McMurry has now won six in a row and holds a three-game lead over second-place Mary Hardin-Baylor.

MARY HARDIN-BAYLOR

The Cru went 2-0 last week as they wrapped up back-to-back road trips. Those were the two longest road trips of the second for UMHB and the Cru men went 4-1 with only an overtime loss to Mississippi College in that stretch. The UMHB men will now return home to host Texas Lutheran University on Thursday night after five straight road games. Jason Wagner and David Ray came off the bench to score 16 points apiece and lead UMHB in the win over Howard Payne.

TEXAS-TYLER

The UT Tyler men's basketball went 1-1 on the week, recording a big win over Louisiana College and suffering a heartbreaking one-point loss to Mississippi College. The week was highlighted by highlight reel performances from seniors Marlon Hill and Anthony Reese. Hill recorded a career-high 29 point against Louisiana on Thursday, while Reese averaged a double-double on the week. This week UT Tyler wraps-up a six-game home stand by host UT Dallas and Ozarks.
