Hardin-Simmons junior guard **Haylee Allen** (*Buffalo Gap, TX / Jim Ned HS*) averaged 21 points, 4.5 steals, four assists and four rebounds over two conference wins. Allen, who poured in a career-high 22 points in 21 minutes against Texas Lutheran, went a combined 8-for-10 from the free throw line and 6-for-9 from 3-point range. She committed just two turnovers.

CONCORDIA TEXAS

Concordia Texas split their road weekend first dropping 74-56, to Howard Payne University then they battled back to finish with a 73-53 win over Sul Ross State University. Senior guard Cassandra Bills led the Tornados in scoring with 26 total points while senior point guard Whitney Clancy finished with 23 points and 7 assists. Concordia will be back at the Concordia Field House to take on Schreiner University on Thursday (Jan. 22).

LETOURNEAU

The YellowJackets improve to 3-3 on the road in conference play this year with a win over Ozarks.

TEXAS LUTHERAN

The Bulldogs have dropped four games in a row, all on the road. TLU continues its road swing with a 5:30 p.m. game Thursday at Mary Hardin-Baylor. The contest against the Crusader's will be TLU's seventh consecutive road game...The Bulldogs finally play a home game in 2009 with Saturday's 1 p.m. contest against Concordia Texas... TLU is second to the University of the Ozarks in total three-pointers made (98 to 100) and second only to Concordia Texas in three-pointers made per game (7.0 to 7.1)...Courtney Haskell is sixth in the conference in rebounding, at 9.4 boards per contest. Tamisha Timpson is 10th at 7.1 per game...Haskell is third in the league in blocks per game (2.4).

TEXAS-TYLER

The UT Tyler women's basketball team wnet 0-2 on the week, lossing to Louisiana and Mississippi Colleges. This week the Patriots will close out a six-game homestand by hosting UT Dallas and Ozarks.

UTD put together three dominating wins last week to improve to 14-2 overall, just two wins away from the most in program history. The Comets rallied from a tight game with ETBU to race to an 87-65 victory, then used a combined 83-30 first-half edge to post 40-plus-point victories over LeTourneau and Ozarks. Lauren Hale has scored in double figures for six straight games, raising her average to 12.7 points and 6.4 rebounds per game. With a team-best 215 points through the first 16 games this season, junior Chelsea Edwards became UTD's alltime leading scorer with 884 career points and is on pace to surpass 1,000 points by the end of the season. UTD got a lift from freshman reserve point guard Samantha Jackson, who scored 19 points in the second half vs. LETU. Still undefeated in ASC play, UTD moved up to No. 22 in the weekly d3hoops.com national poll.

HARDIN-SIMMONS

HSU has won 8-of-9 games and are within one game of the lead in the ASC West. HSU can move to at least a tie for second-place with a win over Howard Payne on Thursday. It is currently tied for third but, just one game behind McMurry for first and a half-game behind Howard Payne. HSU is looking to snap a five-game losing streak to HPU. Bo Warm and Haylee Allen each have 55 assists for the season. HSU has 236 assists on 405 made baskets this season. All five Cowgirl starters shoot better than 70 percent from the free throw line and all have taken at least 30 free throws this season.

OZARKS

Ozarks looks to halt a three-game losing skid after winning two in a row. Lacey Phillips has ten games in which she has hit at least two three-pointers. Forward Olivia Fisher has snagged 10 or more rebounds in four of the last five games. She has averaged 13.0 boards over that stretch. Guard Ally Goddard has hit a pair of threes five times this season.

HOWARD PAYNE

Brittany Zamora led the Lady in a blowout win over Concordia on Thursday with 18 points. Zamora had four three-points versus the Lady Tornados. The Lady Jackets home win streak of 42 games came to an end Mary Hardin-Baylor hit a three-point at the buzzer. The home win streak was one of the longest in the nation.

MCMURRY

McMurry went 2-0 in ASC west play with wins over Texas Lutheran and Schreiner. They are on a five-game winning streak and are in sole possession of first place in the West Division.

MARY HARDIN-BAYLOR

The Cru women went 2-0 after wrapping up back-to-back road trips, the longest two road trips of the season. Landie Thompson averaged 11.5 points and 5.5 rebounds per game for the Cru. The UMHB women held opponents to 31 per cent shooting from the field last week. The UMHB women will host Texas Lutheran Thursday night after playing the last five games on the road.

EAST TEXAS BAPTIST

Junior forward Satara Harrell also had a nice two-game road swing last week, averaging 16.0 points and 10.0 rebounds in the two games. The Lady Tigers snapped a five-game losing streak with Saturday's win at Ozarks. The win was ETBU's fifth straight over the Lady Eagles in Clarksville, Ark.
