EAST DIVISION

James Morman, F, Jr., East Texas Baptist

East Texas Baptist junior forward **James Morgan** (*Houston, TX / Elsie HS*) averaged 24.5 points, 5.5 rebounds and four steals over two conference wins, including snapping Mississippi College's 36-game home winning streak at A.E. Wood Coliseum. Morman, who added two assists and shot 61.3 percent from the floor, poured in a career-high 30 points in a road victory against Louisiana College. He hit a five 3-pointers on the week.

WEST DIVISION

Ralph Turner, G, Jr., Schreiner

Schreiner junior guard Ralph Turner (*Los Angeles, CA / Cal State-LA*) averaged 24.5 points, 8.5 rebounds and five assists over a two-game conference stretch that included the Mountaineers first win over Mary Hardin-Baylor since the 1999-2000 season. Turner, who went a combined 18-for-20 from the free throw line, shot 59 percent from the floor and had two steals, hit the game-winning shot with 1 second remaining against the defending ASC champions. Turner also becomes a two-time winner of the division's top weekly award this season.

AROUND THE RIM

Notes compiled from ASC Sports Information Directors' Reports

MARY HARDIN-BAYLOR

The Cru will host McMurry and Hardin-Simmons for a pair of crucial ASC West Division games this week before turning around and facing those same two teams next week in Abilene. Tim Lytle averaged 10.5 points while going 5-7 on three-point shots this week.

CONCORDIA TEXAS

Concordia Texas men's basketball program split their week picking up a win over Schreiner University at The Fieldhouse and dropping a game to TLU on the road. Junior Brad Walker led all scoring for the Tornados averaging 22.5 points per game. Concordia will be back at home this week to take on Hardin Simmons and McMurry.

LETOURNEAU

The YellowJackets got a split in their final two-game road trip of the season. With the win over LC they picked up their 9th ASC win of the season matching last year's total.

LOUISIANA COLLEGE

ASC East Preseason Player of the Year Josh Johnson was stymied this week by double and sometimes triple teams. Johnson scored only 12 points this week, marking his lowest weekly total in nearly three years...Center Chukwuma Ekeh put together his best back-to-back games as a Wildcat. The sophomore averaged 13 points per game in LC's two games last week...Also, freshmen guard JeLani Mitchell and forward Korey Salmon each scored 10 points against LeTourneau...LC has now lost six games in a row and nine ASC games in a row.

MCMURRY

McMurry remains the hottest team in the ASC as they have now won eight in a row. McMurry went 2-0 in ASC West play last week with wins over Sul Ross State on Howard Payne. McMurry is 12-4 overall and 11-1 in conference play. McMurry is in first place in the ASC West by a full four games as second-place Mary Hardin-Baylor is 7-5 in conference play. McMurry and UMHB will square off at 7:30 p.m. on Thursday down in Belton.

OZARKS

The Eagles are one of the hottest teams in the East Division right now. Ozarks took a 78-66 road victory over Texas-Tyler, its second straight ASC road win and its third in the last four tries. Against Texas-Tyler, Ozarks roared back from a 42-28 halftime deficit behind Chris Williams 14 second half points. Williams nailed all four of his three-pointers and scored 19 points. He is averaging 14.5 points and 9.3 rebounds per game this season. Ozarks has started the same five, four of which are seniors, all season, which has produced 82 percent of the team's scoring.

HARDIN-SIMMONS

Casey Riddle averaged 12 points and 7.5 assists per game. Six Cowboys averaged double figures for the week and 10 players averaged 13 or more minutes per game. HSU scored a season-best 102 points in the win over HPU.

TEXAS-DALLAS

Texas-Dallas still holds a slim one-game lead in the ASC East race, but faces a tough road trip this weekend when the Comets travel to Louisiana College and Mississippi College. UTD has not won a game Mississippi College since 2005, when UTD won the ASC Championship Tournament. UTD's team shooting has slipped a bit in the last couple of weeks, but the Comets are still getting solid contributions from all their starters and 2-3 bench players. Defensively, UTD is still holding opponents to less than 39 percent shooting through 17 games.

ASC Student-Athlete Advisory Committees' Third Annual "Make a Change in 14 Days" Underway!

RICHARDSON, Texas — For the third consecutive year, Student-Athlete Advisory Committees from all 15 American Southwest Conference member institutions are set to join together in "Make a Change in 14 Days," a service project collecting loose coins to raise funds for a local charitable organization.

Arrangements are in place to collect change at local campuses over the 14-day period of January 26 through February 7 – coinciding with the turn of the conference divisional basketball schedule.

The conference-wide project is also designed as a friendly challenge among the ASC campuses. The member SAAC collecting the most funds will be honored by the conference as well as the top-earning division group:

- Concordia University Texas, Hardin-Simmons University, McMurry University, University of Mary Hardin-Baylor
- Mississippi College, Louisiana College, University of the Ozarks, University of Texas at Dallas
- East Texas Baptist University, LeTourneau University, University of Texas at Tyler
- Howard Payne University, Schreiner University, Sul Ross State University, Texas Lutheran University



Last year, the 15 conference SAAC groups combined to raise \$8,138.88 for charity. In two years, over \$10,000 has been raised to benefit 24 different organizations.

Louisiana College was the top-earning member SAAC in 2008 with \$3,323.81 going to Cabrini Cancer Center and Rapides Regional Life Center, both of which focus on breast cancer treatment. LC was also part of the winning division group along with Mississippi College, LeTourneau University and East Texas Baptist University. McMurry University won the inaugural title in 2007 and made its donation to the Children's Miracle Network.

"Make a Change in 14 Days has become one of the most visible opportunities for the ASC student-athletes to become involved with their local communities," ASC Commissioner Amy Carlton said. "We as a conference are proud of the work done by our 15 Student-Athlete Advisory Committees in supporting organizations within their local communities."

EAST TEXAS BAPTIST

Over the last week, ETBU has picked up road wins in places that have been traditionally tough for the Tigers — at Ozarks and at Mississippi College. Both victories were just the second for ETBU on the opponents' home floor since the Tigers joined the ASC back in 1998-99. Sophomore PG Jacob Turnipseed averaged 19.5 points and 3.0 assists in ETBU's two wins last week. The Tigers' current three-game winning streak is the team's longest of the season. ETBU has put together its most solid stretch of basketball this season while playing exclusively on the road, going 3-1 over the last four road games with another tough one set for Tuesday night at LeTourneau. The Tigers play five of their final six conference games at home in February.

TEXAS LUTHERAN

TLU snapped its eight-game losing skid with a 79-71 home victory over Concordia Texas...The Bulldogs put five players into double figures in the win over Concordia...The Bulldogs hit 61 percent of their total shots in the second half to defeat Concordia...For the game, against CTX, the Bulldogs shot 56 percent from the floor...TLU had 19 assists in the win over the Tornados...First-year wing Isaac Williams grabbed a career-best nine rebounds in the win over Concordia.

HOWARD PAYNE

Tom Hermann scored 49 points in two games against Hardin-Simmons and McMurry. Hermann shot .640 from the field and averaged 5 assists per game. In the first half against McMurry, Hermann was perfect from the field 7 of 7, 4 of 4 from behind the arc, and 6 of 6 from the free-throw line for 24 points in the half.

MISSISSIPPI COLLEGE

The Choctaws saw their 37-game home winning streak come to an end with a 76-71 loss to East Texas Baptist on Saturday afternoon. The last home loss came to Wesley College on November 20th, 2006. MC pulled off a comeback win over LeTourneau on Thursday night. The Choctaws fell behind by 10 points at the half, storming back for a seven-point win over the YellowJackets. The Choctaws will host Ozarks and UT-Dallas this week in the Golden Dome.
