*Games of January 22-24*

### EAST DIVISION

#### **Tillisha Givens, G/F, So., Louisiana College**

Louisiana College sophomore guard/forward **Tillisha Givens** (*Monroe, LA / Ouachita Parish HS*) averaged 17 points, 14 rebounds, 4.5 steals and three assists over two conference wins. Givens, who takes the division's top weekly honor for the third time this season, committed just two turnovers and barely missed a triple double in a victory against East Texas Baptist with 16 points, 15 rebounds and six steals. She has six double doubles in her last nine games.

### WEST DIVISION

#### **Mollie Brawner, G, Sr., Hardin-Simmons**

Hardin-Simmons senior guard **Mollie Brawner** (*New Braunfels, TX / NBHS*) averaged 27.5 points – hitting 16 of 23 attempts from 3-point range – and eight rebounds over two conference wins that helped push the Cowgirls' win streak to six games. Brawner, who added a combined two steals and one block, tied the ASC record for 3-pointers in a game with nine against Sul Ross State. She now shares the mark set by HSU's Lauren Harris (2003-04 season) and LeTourneau's Sara Vestfals (2002-03). Brawner also had a career-best nine rebounds to help halt a six-game losing streak to Howard Payne.

### LOUISIANA COLLEGE

It became public last week that LC head coach Janice Joseph-Richard is battling cancer last week. Richard, who had to take a medical leave from her head coaching position at San Jose State three years ago to battle breast cancer, will continue her coaching duties as her health allows her to. Over the next couple of weeks, she will receive daily treatments. She received her first treatment Thursday afternoon and coached the Lady Wildcats to a win over ETBU later that night...Sophomore guard Christy Pantallion continues to be a spark off the bench. Last Week she averaged 11 points per game and sparked LC on runs each time she came in...Also sophomore forward Taylor Henderson, who battled through injuries most of the first half of the season, seems to be getting on track now as she has averaged 13.25 points per game over her last four contests.

### EAST TEXAS BAPTIST

Junior F Satara Harrell's 10-point, 10-rebound effort Thursday against Louisiana College was her seventh double-double of the year.

### MCMURRY

The McMurry women went 2-0 last week in ASC West play with wins over Sul Ross State and Howard Payne. McMurry has won seven in a row as they remain in first place in the ASC West standings. McMurry's 61-50 win over Howard Payne on Saturday snapped a six-game losing skid to the Lady Yellow Jackets. It had been nearly two years since McMurry had beaten Howard Payne as the previous last victory for McMurry over the Yellow Jackets was a 61-60 home victory on Jan. 27, 2007. McMurry is 13-3 overall and 10-2 in conference play. McMurry returns to action at 5:30 p.m. on Thursday when they head to Belton to take on Mary Hardin-Baylor in ASC West action. UMHB is tied for second place in the ASC West as they are 10-6 and 9-3.

### CONCORDIA TEXAS

Concordia women's basketball picked up two ASC wins over the week to Schreiner and Texas Lutheran. Senior Cassandra Bills averaged 22 points and 9 rebounds for the Tornados. Point guard Whitney Clancy pitched in with 24 total points and 12 assists. Concordia will now host Hardin Simmons and McMurry at The Fieldhouse starting on Thursday. This will be an important series for Concordia as they are fighting for a position in the ASC rankings.

## *ASC Student-Athlete Advisory Committees' Third Annual "Make a Change in 14 Days" Underway!*

RICHARDSON, Texas — For the third consecutive year, Student-Athlete Advisory Committees from all 15 American Southwest Conference member institutions are set to join together in "Make a Change in 14 Days," a service project collecting loose coins to raise funds for a local charitable organization.

Arrangements are in place to collect change at local campuses over the 14-day period of January 26 through February 7 – coinciding with the turn of the conference divisional basketball schedule.

The conference-wide project is also designed as a friendly challenge among the ASC campuses. The member SAAC collecting the most funds will be honored by the conference as well as the top-earning division group:

*--Concordia University Texas, Hardin-Simmons University, McMurry University, University of Mary Hardin-Baylor*

*--Mississippi College, Louisiana College, University of the Ozarks, University of Texas at Dallas*

*--East Texas Baptist University, LeTourneau University, University of Texas at Tyler*

Last year, the 15 conference SAAC groups combined to raise \$8,138.88 for charity. In two years, over \$10,000 has been raised to benefit 24 different organizations.

Louisiana College was the top-earning member SAAC in 2008 with \$3,323.81 going to Cabrini Cancer Center and Rapides Regional Life Center, both of which focus on breast cancer treatment. LC was also part of the winning division group along with Mississippi College, LeTourneau University and East Texas Baptist University. McMurry University won the inaugural title in 2007 and made its donation to the Children's Miracle Network.

"Make a Change in 14 Days has become one of the most visible opportunities for the ASC student-athletes to become involved with their local communities," ASC Commissioner Amy Carlton said. "We as a conference are proud of the work done by our 15 Student-Athlete Advisory Committees in supporting organizations within their local communities."

### **MARY HARDIN-BAYLOR**

The Cru women moved into a tie for second place in the ASC West with a 2-0 week. UMHB will host McMurry and Hardin-Simmons this week in a pair of crucial ASC West showdowns. Lauren Reece scored a career-high 14 points in the victory over Schreiner and she averaged 10 points per game while shooting 70 per cent this week. Landie Thompson averaged 15 points and six rebounds per game during the week.

### **TEXAS-DALLAS**

The Comets have won eight straight and are still the only ASC team with an undefeated league record, heading into this weekend's showdown with second-place Mississippi College. UTD needs just one more win to tie its all-time program record for most wins (16). Comets got double-figure scoring from five different players in 85-77 win over UT-Tyler last week, shooting over 50 percent from the field as a team.

### **MISSISSIPPI COLLEGE**

The Lady Choctaws have won eight consecutive games, matching their win total from last season with 15 victories. MC shot 51% combined over the two wins, while holding LeTourneau and ETBU to only 29% shooting. The Lady Choctaws are a perfect 11-0 in the Golden Dome this season with home games against Ozarks and UT-Dallas on Thursday and Saturday. Head Coach Paul Allen Duke will shoot for his 250th win on Thursday against the Eagles.

### **OZARKS**
