Chris Williams, F, Sr., Ozarks

Ozarks senior forward **Chris Williams** (*Forrest City, AR / FCHS*) averaged 20.5 points and eight rebounds over two games, including a road victory against Hardin-Simmons. Williams, who added a combined six steals, four assists and one block, scored 25 points in the victory against HSU. He went 12-for-16 from the free throw line and hit all three of his 3-point attempts.

WEST DIVISION

Tilmon Gaddy, W, Sr., Mary Hardin-Baylor

Mary Hardin-Baylor senior wing **Tilmon Gaddy** (*Harker Heights, TX / HHHS*) averaged 19.5 points on 60 percent shooting and 8.8 rebounds over a 3-1 week that included scoring 31 points in a win over nationally-ranked Wisconsin-Whitewater. Gaddy also added a combined eight assists, seven blocks and five steals. He went 29-for-33 from the free throw line.

AROUND THE RIM

Notes compiled from ASC Sports Information Directors' Reports

MARY HARDIN-BAYLOR

The Cru is 5-5 on the season and 3-3 in ASC play. The UMHB men lost just four games overall last year and had just two conference losses. The Cru won the Cru Holiday Classic for the third straight year and UMHB is 6-0 all-time in that tournament. Jason Wagner averaged 12.0 points per game and led the Cru with a season-high 19 points in the victory over Lake Forest. UMHB will close out cross-over play with road games at Louisiana College and Mississippi College this week before turning around and hitting the road for another long road trip to Alpine and Brownwood next week.

CONCORDIA TEXAS

Concordia picked up a big win over Worcester Polytechnic Institute over the break. The 86-85 victory was led by senior Joel McDonald who finished with 21 points. After the win over WPI Concordia was back in ASC action taking on the University of Mary Hardin Baylor. The Cru picked up the 92-77 win after going on an early run in the second half that the Tornados couldn't recover from. Concordia will be back in action this week as they travel to take on Mississippi College and Louisiana College.

TEXAS LUTHERAN

The Bulldogs have dropped three straight games. All of the losses have come at home...In the loss to Anderson, first-year guard Michael Flores and sophomore wing Brad Howard added 15 and 13 points, respectively. Senior guard Nate Walton scored 11...The Bulldogs had six blocks against Anderson. Tyler Wanek, Howard and Isaac Williams each had two blocks.

HARDIN-SIMMONS

Terrence Willis set career highs with 23 points and 16 rebounds in the loss to Ozarks. HSU has had only two of its 10 games be decided by less than 10 points. The Cowboys are on a four-game losing streak and they have not had a streak of five since the 2003-04 season, when it had two five-game losing streaks.

TEXAS-DALLAS

UTD fell from the ranks of the unbeaten in its showdown with West leader McMurry Saturday. The Comets failed to score in the game's final 3:26 of a defensive battle and lost, 63-61. It was also one of the first game's this season that UTD had shot less than 48 percent from the field. The loss dropped the No. 23-ranked Comets from first place in the ASC East race. UTD did finally break loose from a tight game with Hardin-Simmons, finishing off the game with a 22-4 run to claim a 79-62 win.

LETOURNEAU

LETU starts the 2009 conference season 8-3 overall and a perfect 6-0 in league play. The YellowJackets are the only team in the ASC without a league loss.

OZARKS

Forwards Chris Williams and Tony Daniels each collected double-doubles in a come-from-behind win against Hardin-Simmons. Williams and Daniels were instrumental in helping the Eagles overcome a 20-point second half deficit. Williams scored 19 of his 25 points in the second half, while Daniels pumped in 14 of his 20 points. Williams ended the game grabbing 11 rebounds and Daniels pulled down 10. It was Williams fifth double-double of the season. He is second in the ASC in rebounding at 8.9 boards per contest. Daniels has scored 15 or more points in three straight games, and has shot 7-of-20 from the three-point line during that stretch. Ozarks has four of the top 25 scorers in the ASC – Jeremy Clark (3rd), Williams (13th), Daniels (14th) and Andre Williams (24th). Clark is averaging 17. points per game. All four scorers are benefitting from the play-making ability of guard Tony Brock, who ranks second in the ASC in assists per game (5.9).
