PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Games of Dec. 29-Jan. 5

EAST DIVISION

Chelsea Edwards, PG, Jr., Texas-Dallas

Texas-Dallas junior point guard **Chelsea Edwards** (*Friendswood, TX / FHS*) averaged 16.7 points, 5.6 rebounds, 4.3 assists and two steals over three games, including wins over McMurry and Hardin-Simmons to make the nationally-ranked Comets the first ASC East Division team to sweep the road trip to Abilene, Texas. Edwards went 14-for-15 from the free throw line in those two conference games – 11-for-11 against McMurry – and narrowly missed a triple double against HSU (16 points, 10 rebounds, seven assists). She had a team-high 12 points in a loss to NCAA Division I Texas State.

WEST DIVISION

Lindsey Newcombe, C, So., Hardin-Simmons

Hardin-Simmons sophomore center **Lindsey Newcombe** (*Keller, TX / KHS*) averaged 23 points, 16 rebounds and three blocks over two games. She set a school record by pulling down 22 boards in a win over Ozarks. Newcombe, who takes the division's top weekly honor for the second time this season, was a combined 73.9 percent shooting from the field and went 12-for-14 from the free throw line. She added one assist and one steal.

Louisiana College G **Christy Pantallion** averaged 22.5 points and eight rebounds over two wins. . . . Ozarks G **April Young** averaged 11.5 points off the bench over two games. . . . Mary Hardin-Baylor F **Kellie Thomas** averaged 13.5 points, four rebounds and 2.8 blocks over a 2-2 week. . . . Texas Lutheran F **Courtney Haskell** averaged 10.5 points and 11 rebounds over two games and set a school record with nine blocks in a game.

TEXAS LUTHERAN

On Monday, the Bulldogs (4-6) also received 15 points, seven rebounds, three assists and three blocks from freshman Tamisha Timpson. After going winless in the 2007-08 season, Texas Lutheran has won three of its last four games in 2008-09. The TLU freshman point-guard tandem of Amy Doyle and Jocelyn Langford recorded a combined 12 assists on Monday. Doyle dished out seven assists with just one turnover, and Langford registered five assists.

TEXAS-DALLAS

The Comets' season of firsts continued after becoming the first ASC East Division team ever to travel to Abilene and pick up back-to-back road wins over longtime powers McMurry and Hardin-Simmons. UTD is the only team with an unbeaten ASC record and holds a two-game edge in the East Division race. The Comets also cracked the d3hoops.com Division 3 national poll for the first time in program history this week, coming in at No. 25. Freshman Lyndsey Smith continues to draw defensive attention after erupting for 25 points at McMurry and adding 17 more against HSU. The trio of Smith, Edwards and Lauren Hale are averaging 38.9 points per game for the Comets.

CONCORDIA TEXAS

The Concordia University Texas women's basketball program came off the Christmas break strong picking up an ASC win over UMHB and taking Wheaton College into overtime although falling to them 77-74. Seniors Cassandra Bills and Lori Lee Beck led the Tornados to their ASC victory each finishing with 17 points. Beck was 4-4 from beyond the arc in the win. Against Wheaton Whitney Clancy finished with a season high 21 points. Concordia will now be on the road to take on Mississippi College and Louisiana College.

HARDIN-SIMMONS

HSU has lost two of its three games this season by one point. The Cowgirls have four players that average over 12 points per game. HSU will close ASC East play this weekend at ETBU and LeTourneau.

MARY HARDIN-BAYLOR

The Cru is 5-5 overall and will close out cross-over play with road games at Louisiana College and Mississippi College this weekend. The Cru women will then turn around and make another long road trip to Alpine and Brownwood next weekend. Stacie Urbina averaged 10.2 points per game last week and scored a UMHB career-high 17 against Baldwin-Wallace.

OZARKS

Ozarks has shot well from the three-point line all season, hitting 33 percent of their shots from beyond the arc. Ozarks went 11-of-20 against Hardin-Simmons, with Kayla Quertermous nailing 3-of-5. Alison Villines and Lacey Phillips each hit a pair of three's in the game also. Phillips is 19-of-52 from long-range to lead Ozarks in that category. Freshman April Young provided a spark for the Lady Eagles off the bench during the week. Young hit 3-of-6 from the three-point line during the week. She scored 14 points against Hardin-Simmons Saturday and 9 points against McMurry Monday night.
