Concordia Texas senior outfielder **Tom Williams** (*Austin, TX/AHS*) went 5-for-11 with one home run, one triple and one double to pace a 2-1 week that included a 5-3 road win over nationally-ranked Texas-Tyler. Williams drove in three runs and struck out just once. He scored four times.

Texas Lutheran junior right-hander **Travis Staggs** (*Elmedorf, TX/Southside HS*) tossed six shutout innings, allowing just two hits and one walk to beat Austin College. Staggs struck out four batters.
