EAST DIVISION

Bryan Johnson, F, Sr., Mississippi College

Mississippi College senior forward **Bryan Johnson** (*Jackson, MS / East Central CC*) averaged 26.5 points on 70 percent shooting to lead the Choctaws to a 2-0 week in conference play, including a road win over nationally-ranked and East Division leader Texas-Dallas. Johnson, who takes the division's top weekly award for the second time this season, also averaged 5.5 rebounds and chipped in three assists and one steal. He hit 10 free throws and scored 31 points against Ozarks.

WEST DIVISION

Tilmon Gaddy, W, Sr., Mary Hardin-Baylor

Mary Hardin-Baylor senior wing **Tilmon Gaddy** (*Harker Heights, TX / HHHS*) averaged 19 points, eight rebounds and two assists over two conference victories, including one on the road that capped a season-sweep over West Division leader McMurry. Gaddy, who becomes a two-time winner of the division's top weekly award this season, also chipped in two steals and one block. He went 18-for-20 from the free throw line.

AROUND THE RIM

MCMURRY

McMurry went 2-1 last week with wins over Hardin-Simmons and Concordia Texas and a loss to Mary Hardin-Baylor. McMurry remains in first place in the ASC West with a two and a half game lead over second-place UMHB. McMurry is 15-6 overall and 14-3 in conference play.

TEXAS LUTHERAN

The Bulldogs have jumped into the ASC West playoff picture after winning Saturday at Howard Payne. The Bulldogs swept the season series against HPU and moved into a fourth-place tie in the ASC West standings. TLU plays three of its last four regular-season games of 2008-09 in Memorial Gymnasium...TLU reserve forward Drew Smith came off the bench Saturday to grab a career-best seven rebounds and score a caree-best tying seven points in the road victory.

CONCORDIA TEXAS

Concordia University Texas men's basketball has dropped three games to Hardin-Simmons, McMurry University and Mary Hardin-Baylor since last week. Junior Reza Farahani led the Tornados with 58 total points.

LETOURNEAU

The Jackets picked up their 12th conference win of the season against UTT. This marks the highest single-season ASC win total for LETU.

SCHREINER

The Mountaineers had a tough week as they saw their winning streak end at 4. They came close to splitting the week, but lost a tough one in overtime against Sul Ross. Ralph Turner led the team with a double-double against Howard Payne. Riley Battle continues to put up good numbers as he recorded 26 points, 7 rebounds, and 3 steals on the week. David Flannery (23 points on the week), Trevor Connor (14 points), and Chris Jones-Conyers (16 points) all contributed offensively on the week. This week the Mountaineers are at home against Concordia and play on the road against UMHB. The Men sit in a 4 way tie for fourth place in the West Division.

OZARKS

Ozarks took a step backwards in their quest for a playoff spot after dropping a pair of home games over the weekend and then falling to UTD on Monday. As of now, the Eagles are battling UT-Tyler for the fourth spot, a team Ozarks beat on the road in January. Forward Chris Williams averaged 21.5 points and 6.5 rebounds over two games last weekend. Williams nailed 6-of-10 from beyond the arc. Williams has become a potent three-point shooter, hitting 29-of-53 (54%) on the year. He is leading the team in scoring (15.1), rebounding (8.7) and steals (1.8).

EAST TEXAS BAPTIST

Jacob Turnipseed had a solid all-around week for ETBU, including scoring 18 points on 6 of 13 shooting in an overtime win against LeTourneau on Tuesday. In the OT game against LeTourneau, Turnipseed played 44 of the 45 minutes of the contest. He followed that performance with a team-high 20 points, including 3 3-pointers, in 33 minutes of a loss at UT Tyler on Thursday.

MARY HARDIN-BAYLOR

The Cru went 3-0 and completed a season sweep of McMurry and Concordia Texas. UMHB also clinched an ASC Tournament berth over the weekend and can be no worse than the West Division #2 seed in the tournament. The Cru men have only missed the ASC Tournament once since joining the league. Tim Lytle had 13 points in seven minutes in the victory over McMurry. Carter Tynes came off the bench to score a season-high 12 points in just 17 minutes in the win at Hardin-Simmons. Tilmon Gaddy poured in a season-high 32 points in the win over CTX on Tuesday night.

LOUISIANA COLLEGE

LC snapped a nine game losing streak with a 93-75 win over the Ozarks last Saturday. In that win, LC shot 50 percent (11-22) from beyond the three point arc.

SUL ROSS STATE

Filiberto Torres combined for 31 points in ASC wins over Texas Lutheran and Schreiner. He posted 12 point in a 78-74 overtime time victory against Schreiner on Feb. 7 and was a board shy of a double double in an 81-74 win over TLU.

HOWARD PAYNE

The Yellow Jackets picked up a win over Schreiner University last Thursday. Tom Hermann averaged a double-double foe the week in games against Schreiner and Texas Lutheran. Hermann's 13.5 ppg and 11.5 rpg for the week follows up last week when he passed 1,000 points and 500 rebounds in his career.

TEXAS-DALLAS

Texas-Dallas had two different types of games over the weeknd - running away with a lopsided, 82-43 win over Louisiana College; then battling back in a tough 76-66 loss to Mississippi College. The 39-point win was UTD's largest winning margin of the season. The Comets hit 11 3-pointers against LC, their most since the season opener. After a road win over Ozarks on Monday, the Comets still hold a slim, one-game lead in the East Division race, but must finish the season with two of their last three games on the road. UTD has, however, just one road loss this season.

MISSISSIPPI COLLEGE

The Choctaws picked up two, much-needed road wins over Ozarks and UT-Dallas. MC came from behind to defeat the Eagles, 95-80 on Thursday night, before taking down the ASC East-leading Comets, 76-66 on Saturday. In the two wins, the Choctaws shot 54% from the floor and outrebounded their opponents by an average of 11 boards per game. The Choctaws will stay on the road to face LeTourneau and East Texas Baptist as they try to clinch a spot in the ASC Tournament.

TEXAS-TYLER

The UT Tyler men's basketball team ended its five game losing streak on Thursday with a 76-69 home win over ETBU, but had its second half rally halted against LeTourneau, as the Patriots fell 65-55. UT Tyler has now completed its home slate and will hit the highways for a four game road trip to end the regular season. The Patriots will enter the trip in sole possession of the fourth and final ASC East playoff spot. UT Tyler will take on UT Dallas on Thursday and play at Ozarks on Saturday.
