EAST DIVISION

Lyndsey Smith, G, Fr., Texas-Dallas

Texas-Dallas freshman guard **Lyndsey Smith** (*Gunter, TX/GHS*) averaged 20 points, 7.5 rebounds and three assists to pace conference wins against Louisiana College and fellow nationally-ranked Mississippi College. Smith, who also added four steals and one block, also helped the Comets take a two-game lead in the division race. She was 11-for-14 from the free throw line and committed just two turnovers in 66 minutes of action.

WEST DIVISION

Lindsey Newcombe, C, So., Hardin-Simmons

Hardin-Simmons sophomore center **Lindsey Newcombe** (*Keller, TX/KHS*) averaged 26.3 points, 12.3 rebounds and 3.7 blocks over three conference games. Newcombe, who takes the division's top weekly honor for the fourth time this season, scored 33 points – tied for the highest single-game total in the ASC this season – in a win over Concordia Texas. She added five assists, one steal and went 13-for-15 from the free throw line. She committed just two turnovers.

EAST TEXAS BAPTIST

Candy Vallo had another strong week last week as ETBU's leading scorer, with 21 points in each of two games against LeTourneau and UT Tyler. Vallo was 8 of 15 from the floor, including 3 3-pointers, with 8 rebounds, 4 assists, 2 blocks and a steal in Tuesday's win over LeTourneau, and she followed that with 21 points, 5 boards and 5 assists in a loss at UT Tyler on Thursday.

TEXAS LUTHERAN

The Bulldogs completed the season sweep of Sul Ross State with a win Thursday...TLU now has seven more wins than last season and more wins in this season than in the previous three seasons combined (7 to 6).

HARDIN-SIMMONS

HSU is closing in on 20 wins for the season and it would be the 11th straight season with 20 wins. The Cowgirls will close the season with four straight games on the road. Lindsey Newcombe set the school record for blocks in a season with 56.

SCHREINER

The Lady Mountaineers had a tough time on the road picking up two losses, but it was not for a lack of effort as players continue to step up for the team. Hannah Bursleson led the way with 38 points, 12 rebounds, and 4 assists. Xandria White continues to put forth a solid effort as she recorded 13 points, and 9 rebounds; and Monica Enriquez contributed with 17 points, and 5 assists. The team will host Concordia this week and will go on the road to play UMHB.

Freshman guard Lacey Phillips averaged 18.5 points and shot 70 percent from the three-point line during Ozarks two-game stretch over the weekend. Ozarks then dropped a home game against division-leader Texas-Dallas on Modnay. Phillips hit all five of her three-point shots against Louisiana College Saturday. Phillips is hitting 34 percent of her three-point attempts. Olivia Fisher averaged 14.0 points and 8.0 rebounds over the weekend. Fisher has collected 786 career rebounds, fifth-most at Ozarks. Fisher is also closing in on 1,000 career points. She now has 980.

TEXAS-DALLAS

Texas-Dallas has now not only won the most games in program history at 19-3, but is closing in on its first potential East Division title. The Comets have a commanding two-game lead in the race with just three games remaining. UTD avenged its only ASC loss of the season over the weekend by rallying from a 10-point early deficit to beat second-place Mississippi College, 61-54, and avoid a loss that would have had tiebreaker implications. Freshman Lyndsey Smith has taken over the UTD scoring lead at 13.4 ppg after scoring in double figures 11 of the last 13 games. Junior Lauren Hale (12.2 ppg) has done the same in 10 of the last 12 games and is leading the team with a 6.1 rebounding average.

LOUISIANA COLLEGE

LC continues to play .500 ball on the road. Last week the Lady Wildcats were 1-1 on the road, making them 4-4 for the season...Sophomores Christy Pantallion and Tillisha Givens continue to lead the Lady Wildcats, scoring 16.2 and 16.1 ppg respectively.

MARY HARDIN-BAYLOR

The Cru women dropped three games since last week to see their losing streak reach five in a row. UMHB is tied fourth place in the ASC West as the Cru women look to stretch their school-record streak to four ASC Tournament berths in a row. Kellie Thomas has averaged six rebounds over the last three games.

TEXAS-TYLER

The UT Tyler women's basketball team went 2-0 on the week and extended its winning streak to five games. The Patriots closed out the home portion of their slate with convincing wins over East Texas Baptist and LeTourneau, placing them firmly in third in the ASC playoff race. UT Tyler will now embark on four game road trip to end the regular season. The Patriots will play at UT Dallas on Thursday and at Ozarks on Saturday.

MCMURRY

McMurry remains in sole possession of first place in the ASC West by going 3-0 last week with wins over Hardin-Simmons, Mary Hardin-Baylor and Concordia Texas. McMurry is now 17-4 overall and 14-3 in conference play.

MISSISSIPPI COLLEGE

The Lady Choctaws received their first ever ranking on d3hoops.com when they were placed 22nd in the latest poll. MC proceeded to go to Ozarks and pick up a 77-61 win over the Lady Eagles. The Lady Choctaws then traveled to UT-Dallas, where their 11-game winning streak came to a halt with a 61-54 loss to the #25 Comets. The Lady Choctaws will stay on the road to face LeTourneau and East Texas Baptist, looking to secure at least the #2 seed heading into the conference tournament.

CONCORDIA TEXAS

Concordia University Texas women's basketball defeated Mary Hardin-Baylor on Tuesday night to snap a two-game road skid that included losses to Hardin-Simmons and McMurry. The win also gave the Tornados a season-sweep of UMHB, a team it is currently tied with for the fourth spot in the West Division. Senior Cassandra Bills amassed 64 points, 14 steals and 22 rebounds over the last three games.

HOWARD PAYNE

The Lady Jackets continue to lead in several defensive categories in the ASC as they poise themselves to defend their ASC championship. Elaine Hobbs scored a career high 18 points in a win over Schreiner this week. Hobbs was 4 of 6 from the three-point line and 9 of 10 from the free-throw line this week.
