EAST DIVISION

Hakeem Kareem, F, Jr., Texas-Tyler

Texas-Tyler junior forward **Hakeem Kareem** (*Houston, TX/George H.W. Bush HS*) averaged 23.5 points on 60.6 percent shooting and 8.5 rebounds over two conference games. He poured in 35 points – a career high and also a single-game high in the ASC this season – in a road win against Ozarks. Kareem added one steal and committed just three turnovers.

WEST DIVISION

Tilmon Gaddy, W, Sr., Mary Hardin-Baylor

Mary Hardin-Baylor senior wing **Tilmon Gaddy** (*Harker Heights, TX/HHHS*) averaged 19 points, five rebounds, 2.3 assists and went 26-for-28 from the free throw line to help the Cru to a 3-0 record against conference competition. Gaddy, who takes the division's top weekly honor for the second straight week and third time overall, scored 32 points – including the last 14 of the game for UMHB – to help fuel a 17-point, second-half comeback against Concordia Texas. He also added four steals and two blocks to help UMHB push its winning streak to a current ASC-high seven games.

CONCORDIA TEXAS

Concordia University Texas men's basketball program finished 2-1 on the week picking up wins over Schreiner and Texas Lutheran and dropping a game to UMHB. Concordia was led by Junior Brad Walker on the week as he averaged 17 points per game and 5.3 rebounds. Senior Joel McDonald shot 40 percent from beyond the arc and finished with 45 points. The Tornados will now host Howard Payne and Sul Ross State at home to finalize the 2008-2009 season.

TEXAS LUTHERAN

The Bulldogs fell out of a tie for third place in the ASC West with two losses last week in the ASC...The Bulldogs play their final two regular season games of the season this week, and both games are at TLU's Memorial Gymnasium...TLU must win both games (vs. McMurry and vs. Hardin-Simmons) to have a chance at an ASC Championship Tournament berth...The Bulldogs have never qualified for an ASC conference basketball tournament, in men's or women's basketball.

SCHREINER

The Mountaineers continued their skid as the season comes to a close. Unfortunately, the men dropped games against Concordia and UMHB. Ralph Turner continued his outstanding play by recording 51 points, 10 rebounds and he finished 7-13 from the 3 point line. Also contributing with stellar play was Riley Battle with 40 points and 12 rebounds. The Mountaineers are still in the thick of the playoff hunt. They will need to win out against Hardin-Simmons and McMurry and receive a little help from other conference opponents in order to make the second season.

HOWARD PAYNE

The Jackets split their games this week defeating Hardin-Simmons and then losing to McMurry on Saturday. Bryan came off the bench for both games this week to average 16.0 per game. Blalock shot .647 pct from the field and was 10 of 11 from the free-throw line.

MISSISSIPPI COLLEGE

The Choctaws finished a four-game road swing undefeated after defeating LeTourneau and East Texas Baptist last week and then defeated Louisiana College at home on Tuesday night. MC has clinched at least the #3 seed in the ASC East and kept its hopes alive to host the tournament. The Choctaws will host UT Tyler on Saturday to close out the regular season.

OZARKS

After winning three of four on the road, Ozarks struggled at home in their last four games. The Eagles got one win in four tries during their home stretch. Ozarks let a 13-point halftime lead slip away against UT-Tyler Saturday. It was the final home game for seniors – Tony Brock, Jeremy Clark and Chris Williams - Saturday. Another senior, Tony Daniels received a season-ending injury Thursday night. Those four, along with Andre Williams, have started in nearly every game this season.

HARDIN-SIMMONS

The Cowboys need eight 3-pointers to break the school record of 193 on the season. Rob Yeatts has moved to ninth on the single season charts in 3-pointers made. He is fifth all-time in 3-pointers made in a career. The Cowboys will most likely miss the ASC Tournament for the first time in four years.

MARY HARDIN-BAYLOR

The Cru men have won seven straight games and are 16-4 since starting the season 0-3. The UMHB men will close out the regular season with a pair of home games this week. Tim Lytle had 19 points on 7-13 shooting in the win at Texas Lutheran. Ervin Johnson averaged 14.5 points and 8.5 rebounds per game in the wins over Texas Lutheran and Schreiner. He posted season highs in points and rebounds in each of those games. The Cru men have already clinched an ASC Tournament berth and will be no worse than the #2 seed from the ASC West.

SUL ROSS STATE

Sul Ross State bumped their winning streak to games last week with conference wins over McMurry and Hardin-Simmons. The Lobos pulled off a stunning 59-56 upset over visiting McMurry Thursday night as Andy Hulseley led Sul Ross shooters with 11 points. Hulseley collected 15 more points in SRSU's 82-71 win over Hardin-Simmons on Saturday.

EAST TEXAS BAPTIST

Turnipseed led ETBU to a 1-1 record last week with back-to-back strong games against Louisiana College and Mississippi College. The sophomore guard scored 19 points with 8 rebounds and 4 assists in an 82-59 win over LC Thursday night, then played all 40 minutes and scored 14 points with 9 rebounds and 3 assists in a 67-64 loss to MC on Saturday.

TEXAS-TYLER

The UT Tyler men's basketball team went 1-1 on the week as it began four road games to end the season. The Patriots fell 55-48 on Thursday night and then rallied from a 13 point halftime deficit to beat Ozarks 71-55 on Saturday. Junior Hakeem Kareem scored a career-high 35 points vs. Ozarks, with 29 of those points coming in the second half. This week, UT Tyler will close out the regular season with two pivotal ASC East games at Louisiana and at Mississippi.

TEXAS-DALLAS

Texas-Dallas clinched at least a tie for the ASC East Division crown with a win over UT-Tyler Thursday, assuring its first co-championship since 2004. The Comets could win their first outright title and host the ASC Championship Tournament with just one more win, but face a tough road trip to East Texas Baptist and LeTourneau to finish the regular season. UTD's offense may have slipped a bit, but the Comets are still playing airtight defense. Comet opponents are shooting just 39.2 percent from the field for the season and scoring just 59.2 points per game.

ASC Student-Athlete Advisory Committees Team Together to Raise Record \$8,761.14 For Charity

RICHARDSON, Texas — Student-Athlete Advisory Committees from the 15 American Southwest Conference campuses combined to raise a record \$8,761.14 for local community organizations in the third annual "Make a Change in 14 Days" loose coin collection project.

Fifteen different organizations received support through the local campus fundraising efforts held from January 26-February 7.

"The student-athletes of the American Southwest Conference continue to display a willingness and enthusiastic spirit to be involved in supporting organizations within their communities," ASC Commissioner Amy Carlton said.

In the three years of the conference-wide community service campaign, nearly \$20,000 has been raised to benefit 31 different charitable organizations in ASC campus communities. The 2009 total bettered last year's record by \$622.26.

"I am impressed by this year's record-setting level of support for the conference-wide community service project," added Carlton.

The two-week SAAC event is also designed as a challenge among the ASC member campuses and is scheduled during the turn of the conference Division basketball schedule. Louisiana College, University of the Ozarks, Mississippi College and University of Texas at Dallas claimed the 2009 division pool title with a combined collection of \$3,674.09.



Louisiana College, located in Pineville, La., was the top-collecting ASC institution for the second straight year, raising \$2,211.08. LC again will split its funds raised between two local breast cancer treatment facilities, Cabrini Cancer Center and Rapides Regional Life Center. The two organizations were selected by the Louisiana College SAAC by recommendation of Lady Wildcats women's basketball coach Janice Joseph-Richard, who is undergoing treatment for a recurrence of breast cancer. The coach learned of the return of her cancer a week before the Make a Change in 14 Days campaign began.

"That really jump-started it," said Louisiana College SAAC President McCaslin Carson, a senior All-American softball player. "We did what we could for (Coach Joseph-Richard). So many people helped out – it wasn't just the SAAC."

LC collected the bulk of its funds at H.O. West Fieldhouse on January 29 and 31 as the Wildcats took on Texas-Dallas and Ozarks, respectively, in conference basketball action. In two years, Carson and SAAC Advisor Donnie Broussard have guided the collection of \$5,534.89, all directed toward breast cancer research.

"It has all been for a really good cause," Carson said.

The student-athlete advisory committees at McMurry University and Ozarks each raised more than \$1,000, while Schreiner University, Concordia University Texas, Texas Lutheran, University of Texas at Tyler, Sul Ross State University and East Texas Baptist University also posted their best "Make a Change in 14 Days" total in the three-year campaign. UT Tyler made its donation to Relay for Life in honor of Joseph-Richard.
