## PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

*Games of January 27-31*

### EAST DIVISION

#### **Becky Taylor, F, Jr., Texas-Tyler**

Texas-Tyler junior forward **Becky Taylor** (*Bullard, TX / New Caney HS*) averaged 19.5 points and 18.5 rebounds to guide two conference wins. Taylor, who takes the division's top weekly honor for the second time this season, added a combined two assists, one steal and one block. She hit 17 free throws and pushed her double double total to 17 in 19 games this season. Taylor leads the ASC in rebounds and is second in scoring.

### WEST DIVISION

#### **Whitney Clancy, PG, Sr., Concordia Texas**

Concordia Texas senior point guard **Whitney Clancy** (*Colleyville, TX / Colleyville Heritage HS*) averaged 19 points, four assists and 2.5 steals over two conference games, including a victory over West Division co-leader McMurry. Clancy poured in a career-high 30 points on 67 percent shooting from the field and hit 4 of 6 attempts from 3-point range in the victory that snapped McM's eight-game win streak. She also added a combined four rebounds and went 8-for-9 on free throws.

#### **Lindsey Newcombe, C, So., Hardin-Simmons**

Hardin-Simmons sophomore center **Lindsey Newcombe** (*Keller, TX / KHS*) averaged 20.5 points, 13.5 rebounds and 2.5 blocked shots over two conference road wins against Mary Hardin-Baylor and Concordia Texas. Newcombe, who takes the division's top weekly award for the third time this season, also chipped in three steals and one assist. She shot 58.1 percent from the floor and committed just three turnovers to help the Cowgirls extend their winning streak to eight.

Concordia University Texas women's basketball program picked up a big win over the weekend at the Concordia Fieldhouse over McMurry University. Senior Whitney Clancy led all scorers with a career high 30 points in the victory and added five steals. Another senior Kassandra Bills, became the 10th person all-time to reach the 1500 career scoring mark in the ASC, during Concordia's loss to Hardin-Simmons. Bills finished the weekend averaging 21 points and 9 rebounds. The Tornados will be on the road this weekend as they turnaround to play Hardin-Simmons and McMurry in Abilene.

### TEXAS-TYLER

The UT Tyler Patriots continued their winning ways by picking up two tough road wins at ETBU and LeTourneau on the week. Junior Becky Taylor pulled down 21 rebounds vs. LeTourneau. The Patriots will close out the home portion of tier schedule next week when they host ETBU and LeTourneau.

### LOUISIANA COLLEGE

LC continues to stay right in the thick of the race for an ASC Tournament berth with an 8-6 ASC record, heading into the last round of divisional play...The sophomore threesome of forwards Tillisha Givens and Taylor Henderson along with guard Christy Pantallion continue to pace the Lady Wildcats. Givens averages a double-double for the year (16.2 ppg/11.3 rpg). Pantallion averages 15.7 ppg, and Henderson averages 9.1 ppg.

**OZARKS**

Olivia Fisher averaged a double-double over the last two games - 12.5 points and 10.0 rebounds. She has pulled down ten or more rebounds in eight games this season. Freshman center Sabrina Goddard matched her career-high with 20 points against Louisiana College Saturday. She was a perfect 6-of-6 from the free throw line. Point guard Ally Goddard has been a steady performer this season, starting in all 19 games. She is the team leader in assists and has hit 33 percent of her three-point attempts.

**MISSISSIPPI COLLEGE**

The Lady Choctaws have won 10 straight games, after handing #18 UT-Dallas their first conference loss of the season on Saturday. The only two losses of the season have come by a combined seven points and were both on the road. MC is now 13-0 in the Golden Dome this season, outscoring their opponents by an average of 27.9 points per game. The Lady Choctaws will hit the road to face Ozarks and UT-Dallas this weekend.

**TEXAS LUTHERAN**

The Bulldogs six wins in 2008-09 equal the six wins by the TLU women's basketball program over the previous three years combined...The Bulldogs have won two of their last three, including a 20-point road win at Schreiner...TLU's narrow 4-point loss to defending national champion Howard Payne was a 50-point turn-around from the previous meeting in Seguin between the two school's...The Bulldogs had a 14-point lead late in the first half against HPU.

**SCHREINER**

The Lady Mountaineers picked up their first win of the season, Saturday, against the Sul Ross Lady Lobos. It has been a tough season for the Lady Mountaineers, but they continue to work hard for Coach McKinney, and they are steadily improving. Xandria White led the way this week recording 49 points, 31 rebounds, and 5 steals. Monica Enriquez contributed with 34 points, 17 rebounds, 8 assists and 10 steals, and Hannah Burleson made her presence felt recording 32 points, 10 rebounds and 4 assists. Latisha Hall and Lia Phillips made noteworthy contributions as well.

Last year, the 15 conference SAAC groups combined to raise \$8,138.88 for charity. In two years, over \$10,000 has been raised to benefit 24 different organizations.

Louisiana College was the top-earning member SAAC in 2008 with \$3,323.81 going to Cabrini Cancer Center and Rapides Regional Life Center, both of which focus on breast cancer treatment. LC was also part of the winning division group along with Mississippi College, LeTourneau University and East Texas Baptist University. McMurry University won the inaugural title in 2007 and made its donation to the Children's Miracle Network.

"Make a Change in 14 Days has become one of the most visible opportunities for the ASC student-athletes to become involved with their local communities," ASC Commissioner Amy Carlton said. "We as a conference are proud of the work done by our 15 Student-Athlete Advisory Committees in supporting organizations within their local communities."

#### **HARDIN-SIMMONS**

The Cowgirls have won eight games in a row, which is the longest streak of the season for HSU. This is the latest in the season the Cowgirls have been in first place in the ASC West since the 2005 season. Mollie Brawner continued her hot play with a 23-point performance at UMHB. She scored five points in the final 1:30 of the game to give the Cowgirls the win. Lindsey Newcombe is tied for the school single-season record in blocked shots with 50.

#### **TEXAS-DALLAS**

Texas-Dallas cracked into the USA Today/ESPN national coaches poll for the first time this season, coming in at No. 23; and moved up to No. 18 in the D3HOOPS.COM poll before Saturday's loss at Mississippi College. UTD tied its alltime season record for wins on Thursday at 16 with a victory at Louisiana College, and should set a new mark with six regular season games left. Freshman Lyndsey Smith, who has been UTD's top scorer in two of the last three games, has now moved into a tie for the team scoring lead with Chelsea Edwards. Both are averaging exactly 13.0 points per game with Lauren Hale right behind at 12.6.

#### **HOWARD PAYNE**

After a three game losing streak, the first since the 2000-01 season for HPU, the Lady Jackets got back to their wining ways with wins over Schreiner and TLU. Hope Hohertz nearly averaged a double-double with 16.5 ppg and 9.5 rpg. Against Texas Lutheran Hohertz had 24 points and 13 rebounds.

#### **MARY HARDIN-BAYLOR**
