CO-HITTERS

Chris Biguenet, 2B, Sr., Texas-Dallas

Texas-Dallas senior second baseman **Chris Biguenet** (*Plano, TX / Plano Senior HS*) homered in four straight games – all wins – and drove in a combined 10 runs against Texas Wesleyan and East Division opponent LeTourneau. Biguenet, who batted 8-for-18 on the week and scored five times, drove in at least two runs in each game.

Joe Towns, 1B, Sr., Texas-Tyler

Texas-Tyler senior first baseman **Joe Towns** (*Carrollton, TX / Newman Smith HS*) went 10-for-17 with three home runs, two doubles and seven RBIs over four straight wins. Towns, who also scored nine times, went deep twice in a win over East Division opponent Louisiana College. He had two hits to lead a 5-4 win over University of Dallas.

PITCHER

Tyler Seaman, RHP, Jr., Mississippi College

Mississippi College junior right-hander **Tyler Seaman** (*Pascagoula, MS / Jones County JC*) threw his second no-hitter of the season with a nine-inning gem that included seven strikeouts in an 11-1 win over East Division opponent Ozarks. Seaman, who tossed his other no-hitter on March 16 against Louisiana College, walked just two batters and allowed one run to cross the plate due to three errors in the first inning. He retired the final seven batters of the game.

Ryan Breeding, OF, Fr., Howard Payne

Howard Payne freshman outfielder **Ryan Breeding** (*Blanco, TX / BHS*) went 8-for-11 with two triples and a double over a three-game West Division series against McMurry. Breeding scored seven times, drove in two runs and was hit by a pitch. He went 3-for-3 and scored the winning run in an 8-7 win in the finale.

PITCHER

Stephen Szkotak, RHP, Sr., Concordia Texas

Concordia Texas senior right-hander **Stephen Szkotak** (*Dripping Springs, TX / DSHS*) picked up two saves against West Division opponent Mary Hardin-Baylor to help the Tornados stay alive in the race for the ASC tournament. Szkotak recorded five strikeouts in two innings of work, including one with two runners on and two outs to seal a 6-4 win in the finale of the three-game series. He threw a perfect ninth with two strikeouts in the 5-4 Game 1 win. Szkotak now leads the league with seven saves.
