First Round Series of ASC Baseball Tournament Set

RICHARDSON, Texas — Mississippi College, the University of Texas at Tyler, Texas Lutheran University and Hardin-Simmons University will each serve as first round hosts of the 2009 American Southwest Conference Baseball Championship Tournament Series, to be held April 24-25, after locking up one of the top two seeds from their respective divisions.

The winners from the four, best-of-3 series (also featuring the University of Texas at Dallas, University of the Ozarks, McMurry University and the University of Mary Hardin-Baylor) will advance to the championship round, a double elimination format to be held May 1-3 at the site of the top remaining East Division seed. The ASC champion will earn the league's automatic berth into the NCAA Division III Baseball Championship.

For the second straight year, live statistics and live audio will be available for all first round games. They can be linked to from the conference's website and the athletics websites of all host institutions.

HITTER

Cody Ross, 3B, Sr., Texas-Dallas

Texas-Dallas senior third baseman **Cody Ross** (*Austin, TX / Bowie HS*) went 14-for-27 with five home runs, three doubles and eight RBIs to pace a 5-0 week that included a series sweep of East Division team East Texas Baptist. Ross also scored 11 times to help the Comets cap a 25-win regular season.

PITCHER

Reed Prewitt, RHP, Sr., Mississippi College

Mississippi College senior right-hander Reed Prewitt (*Clinton, MS / Hinds CC*) tossed 2 1/3 innings of shutout ball with two strikeouts to pick up two saves on the road against Texas-Tyler. Prewitt's performances helped the Choctaws take the series and clinch a share of the East Division title and earn home field advantage throughout the ASC tournament because of the head-to-head tiebreaker. Prewitt also went 10-for-17 at the plate with two home runs and 10 RBIs.

WEST

CO-HITTERS

R.B. Garza, 2B, Sr., Mary Hardin-Baylor

Mary Hardin-Baylor senior second baseman **R.B. Garza** (*Katy, TX / Cinco Ranch HS*) went 8-for-12 with five doubles and four RBIs to help the Cru secure the final ASC tournament berth from the West Division with a series sweep over Howard Payne. Garza, who also tossed eight solid innings on the mound to get the win in Game 2 of the series, drove in four runs, scored three times and walked once in the series. He also stole two bases.

Tom Williams, OF, Sr., Concordia Texas

Concordia Texas senior outfielder **Tom Williams** (*Austin, TX / AHS*) went 7-for-13 with two home runs, two doubles, a triple and 11 RBIs in a West Division series sweep against Schreiner. Williams also hit for the cycle against the Mountaineers in the opener, going 5-for-5 with eight RBIs and six runs scored. He scored eight runs on the week and also stole two bases and walked once.

PITCHER

Michael Johnson, RHP, Jr., Concordia Texas

Concordia Texas junior right-hander **Michael Johnson** (*Bellaire, TX / BHS*) struck out 15 batters, allowed just two hits and walked one over seven complete innings to defeat West Division opponent Schreiner. Johnson, who takes the division's top pitching award for the third time this season, allowed only two runners to reach second base – one came on an error.
