RICHARDSON, Texas — East Texas Baptist University, Louisiana College, the University of Texas at Tyler, Hardin-Simmons University, Howard Payne University and Schreiner University each finished in one of the top three spots in their respective divisions and will battle for the conference title at the 2009 American Southwest Conference Softball Championship Tournament, to be held Thursday-Saturday (April 20-May 2) at Trinity View Park in Irving, Texas.

For the second straight year, all games in the double-elimination tournament will be available for fans through live statistics. Saturday's championship game will again be broadcasted with live audio. All links can be found on the conference's website, www.ASCsports.org.



No. 1-ranked East Texas Baptist (35-5) and Hardin-Simmons (30-10) each received first-round byes because of winning division titles and will wait until Friday to play. Head coach Janae Shirley's Lady Tigers went 21-3 to claim their fourth all-time East Division title and enter the tourney as winners of 19 of their last 21 ballgames. ETBU, which has won five ASC championships, features the league's top pitching staff with a 0.87 ERA and only 42 walks in 250 innings. Head coach Rita Jordan's Cowgirls (30-10) also went 21-3 in ASC play to win their third West Division title in the last five years. HSU, which won ASC titles in 2006 and 2007, leads the

EAST HITTER

Reagan Jackson, Jr., OF, Mississippi College

Mississippi College junior outfielder **Reagan Jackson** (*Grenada, MS / GHS*) went 8-for-20 with two triples and two doubles to guide the Lady Choctaws to a 6-0 week. Jackson also drove in four runs, scored five times and stole one base to help MC end the season on a 10-game winning streak.

PITCHER

Erin Garcia, RHP, Fr., East Texas Baptist

East Texas Baptist freshman right-hander **Erin Garcia** (*Navasota, TX / NHS*) went 2-0 with one save to help the top-ranked Lady Tigers seal their first East Division title since 2004. Garcia defeated No. 2-ranked Louisiana College, tossing seven shutout innings with three hits and nine strikeouts. Garcia also threw a complete-game shutout against Ozarks and picked up a save in a 2-1 game with LeTourneau. On the week, she had 21 strikeouts and walked just one batter in 17 2/3 innings.

WEST HITTER

Lyndsie Travis, 1B, Sr., Schreiner

Schreiner senior first baseman **Lyndsie Travis** (*Helotes, TX / O'Connor HS*) went 8-for-12 with a home run, four doubles and seven RBIs to help the Mountaineers lock up a spot in the ASC tournament for the first time since 2003. Travis also scored two runs and had two sacrifice flies.

PITCHER

Sarah Shurbet, Fr., RHP, Hardin-Simmons

Hardin-Simmons freshman right-hander **Sarah Shurbet** (*Pittsburg, TX / PHS*) went 2-0, allowing no earned runs over two complete games to help the Cowgirls clinch the outright West Division title. Shurbet, who takes the division's top weekly pitching award for the second time this season, scattered eight hits and struck out six over 14 innings of work on the road against Mary Hardin-Baylor.

league in triples with 14 and has won 23 of their last 26 games – including a program-record run off 17 straight from March 20-April 9.

ETBU will open at 11 a.m. against Thursday's 6 p.m. tilt between West No. 2 seed Howard Payne (29-9) and East No. 3 seed Texas-Tyler (31-7). Howard Payne makes it fourth straight postseason trip, while 2008 runner-up and sixth-ranked UT Tyler is in the tourney for the second straight year since becoming eligible for postseason play after serving as an NCAA provisional for three seasons.

HSU will begin Friday at 11 a.m. against the victor of Thursday's 6 p.m. game between East No. 2 seed Louisiana College (32-6) and West No. 3 seed Schreiner (26-13). No. 2-ranked LC is the defending ASC champion and last year became the first team in conference history to advance to the NCAA Division III Softball World Series. Schreiner, which won the first ASC crown in 1999, makes its first postseason appearance since 2003.

Other start times will be at 2 p.m. and 5 p.m. on Friday. The championship game is slated for 2 p.m. on Saturday, with an "if necessary" game to follow 30 minutes after.

NOTES: This is the first year the ASC tournament will be held at Trinity View Park in Irving, Texas. . . . The East Division has won seven ASC titles, with the West claiming three. . . . Mary Hardin-Baylor will not be at the tournament for the first time in the event's 11-year history. UMHB was the only remaining team in the league to have qualified for every ASC tourney. It is now tied with East Texas Baptist for the most all-time appearances. . . . This year's tourney features a record three teams ranked in the National Fastpitch Coaches Association Top 25 Poll: ETBU, Louisiana College and Texas-Tyler. . . . Admission prices will be: \$5 for adults (age 18 and older), \$3 for students (age 6 through high school) and \$3 for ASC students (with valid ID from an ASC member school). Children under age 5 will not be charged. No complimentary passes will be issued. . . . A limited amount of official tournament T-shirts will be available on Friday only for \$15. . . . Souvenir programs will be available for \$2 each.
